

PAC BASEBALL NOTES



Bethany Bison

Bethany extended its win streak to three with a 10-8 victory at Capital to start the week ... DH **Brent Owens** (who drove in four RBIs), 1B **Chris Leasure** and C **Josh Lawrence** all had three hits, while **Brett Bartholomew** pitched two innings of scoreless relief for the win ... The Bison were eliminated from PAC Tournament contention over the weekend with three losses to Thiel ... After an 11-2 loss to open the series Friday, BC fell by narrow 3-1 and 3-2 scores in Greenville Saturday ... **Aaron Brest** and **Justin McBee** both threw complete games in the DH losses ... Owens walked in the first game and had singles in both ends of the twinbill to make it 22 straight games reaching base, the longest stretch since **Jeff Weekley** reached base in 29 straight in 1996.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City's hopes of making a return trip to the PAC Tournament took a hit over the weekend as W&J swept the Wolverines ... For GCC to qualify for the tournament, the Wolverines must sweep Thiel, and Bethany must sweep Westminster ... Grove City opened the week with a sweep of Waynesburg Tuesday ... Junior DH **Pat Messner** went 4-for-4 in the opener ... **Chris Bowser** pitched four innings to earn the win while senior **Eric Hull** earned his first save, a three-inning effort ... Junior CF **Brian Moran** tripled twice in the nightcap while freshman 3B **Mark Scriven** and senior 1B **Dan Bartkowiak** both went 2-for-3 ... Freshman **Mike Herringshaw** worked six innings for the win ... Saturday, a bases-loaded walk in the seventh gave W&J a 4-3 win.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats set a new school single-season wins mark over the weekend after capping off a three-game sweep of Bethany ... The Tomcats enter the final week of regular-season play with a record of 24-12 overall, 9-6 in the PAC, and have clinched the #3 seed for the PAC Tournament ... Junior SP **Eric Wadowsky** led the Tomcats in their first win over Bethany last week, tallying nine strikeouts in the process ... Sophomore DH **Eric Boylan** went 8-of-16 last week (.500) with three runs scored and six RBIs ... He owns a .306 average and leads the Tomcats with 26 RBIs ... SS **Chad Ulogar** went 9-of-16 last week with four runs scored and an RBI ... Thiel closes PAC play this weekend with a three-game series against Grove City.



Thomas More Saints

Thomas More set up a key series with Washington & Jefferson by sweeping Waynesburg this past weekend ... The Saints will travel to W&J in a winner-take-all three-game series ... **Pat Berndsen** capped the sweep of the Yellow Jackets with a three-run walk-off home run in the bottom of the eighth inning ... Sophomore **Bryan Farrell** played a huge part in the sweep, appearing in two games in relief and earning the victory in the third game ... Junior **Brad Ketterer** had a huge week, hitting .500 with six RBI and six runs scored, along with a slugging percentage of .813 ... During the Waynesburg series, Ketterer hit .625 with five RBI ... Junior **Marc Price** broke out of his slump, hitting .412 with three doubles and a solo home run.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J, ranked 23rd in the ABCA poll, won all five of its games last week to set up a showdown with Thomas More this weekend for PAC Tournament hosting rights ... The Presidents swept a weekend series from Grove City, outscoring the Wolverines 16-5 ... Senior **Sam Mann** won his 24th career game on the mound Friday, while senior 3B **Shaun Pfeil** notched two hits, including the 200th of his career, and two RBI ... Senior RHP **John Astfalk** earned the win in the first game Saturday ... Pfeil drew a bases-loaded walk in the seventh for the game-winning run ... Senior RHP **Mike Trumpower** recording his best outing of the season after firing a five-hit shutout in the second contest ... Mann and senior SS **Nick Fiorilli** both had 3-for-3 days at the plate in the win.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets struggled in a full week of games last week, losing seven straight contests with three doubleheader sweeps ... Waynesburg managed a close 15-12 loss to Shenandoah to open the week before being shutout in the nightcap, 13-0 ... The Yellow Jacket pitching staff surrendered 20 runs in a doubleheader sweep to Grove City Tuesday before Waynesburg was swept in a three-game weekend series at Thomas More ... Over the seven games, three Yellow Jacket regulars boasted averages over .400, including senior C **Jon Conn** ... Conn posted a career week with a .429 average (9-for-21) with three home runs, 10 RBI and six runs scored ... For the week, Waynesburg pitchers were roughed up for 79 runs in 47.2 innings and a 12.08 team ERA.



Westminster Titans

Westminster was 2-3 against Pitt-Greensburg and Saint Vincent ... The Titans (14-16) split a doubleheader at UP-G Friday, losing 11-5 and winning 15-6 ... The Titans also split a home doubleheader Saturday against Saint Vincent (8-22), winning 5-4 and losing 7-3, before falling at Saint Vincent Sunday, 15-6 ... The highlight of the weekend came in the first Saint Vincent game Saturday as the Titans rallied in the bottom of the seventh inning to score three runs ... Sophomore **John Izzo** hit a walk-off RBI double scoring classmate **Mike Busin** for the game-winner ... Izzo was 9-for-20 over the weekend ... In the other Westminster win of the weekend, junior **Donnie Kirkwood** went 4-for-5 with three runs scored as the Titans earned a split by winning the second Pitt-Greensburg game.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Bearcats took two of three games in a series with PAC rival Westminster over the weekend ...
