Bethany Bison

Bethany saw its six-game winning streak stopped, but ended the week by sweeping a wild twinbill from Waynesburg ... Seton Hill snapped BC's victory run with a 5-1 decision, then the Bison, who had taken a 4-3 lead on a

homer from **Milton Joyner** in the top of the 9th, gave up two in the bottom to lose the opener to Waynesburg ... In Saturday's first game, the Jackets built a 3-0 lead, but Bethany turned the tables with two in the bottom of the seventh to pull it out ... Joyner hit an RBI single that evened the game and then a fielder's choice that featured two WC errors allowed the winning run to score ... The nightcap saw **Aaron Meadows** go 2-for-3 with three RBIs and three runs scored, as BC scored five in the sixth inning to claim a 10-5 victory.



Thiel Tomcats

Thiel finished the week 3-1 ... After suffering a 14-6 loss at Mount Union Monday, the Tomcats recorded a 10-9 come-from-behind win at Hiram Wednesday and swept a home doubleheader against Oberlin Sunday, winning 5-1 and 6-2 ... The Tomcats scored all 10 of its runs in the final

three innings against Hiram, coming back from a 5-0 deficit after six innings ... Freshman 1B **Eric Boylan** finished 4-for-5 at the plate with a pair of home runs and five RBIs ... Senior 3B **Bob Flukas** went 2-for-4 with a home run, while senior DH **Mark Nightingale** went 3-for-5 with three runs scored ... In the game one win against Oberlin, senior SP **Rich McNeal** picked up the complete-game victory, allowing one run on six hits with six strikeouts.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J can clinch the No. 1 seed and hosting rights for the upcoming PAC Tournament with two victories this weekend over Waynesburg ... The Presidents posted a 3-3 record this week with two wins vs. Penn State-Altoona and one against Thomas More ... In game two vs. Altoona, junior 3B **Shaun Pfeil** doubled home the game-tying run with two

outs and scored the winning run on junior RF **Ron Mitko**'s single in the bottom of the seventh ... Freshman P **Dan Vietmeier** tossed his first career complete game and improved his overall record to 4-0 after limiting the Lions to two runs on four hits in game one ... Pfeil collected four hits and junior P **Sam Mann** struck out eight, while tossing a complete game as W&J defeated Thomas More Sunday ... Junior LF **Nate Hopkins** recorded a three-run double.



Westminster Titans

The Titans dropped two of three games in a weekend PAC series with Grove City, eliminating Westminster from contention for the PAC baseball tournament ... The Blue & White scored four times in the bottom of the eighth to overcome a 7-6 deficit and post a 10-7 home win over the Wolverines Friday ... Sophomore P Andrew Robison earned the win in relief after allowing no runs and one hit in the final 4 1/3 innings ... Sophomore OF Don Womeldorff was 2-for-4 with a home run and two RBIs ... GCC swept the Titans 10-1 and 11-3 in

Grove City Saturday ... Freshman C **Sean Henderson** doubled and scored the team's run in game one ... Senior 3B **Mark Francazio** and junior 2B **Dan Conti** were each 2-for-4 in the nightcap.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City wrapped up PAC play Saturday with a sweep of Westminster ... The wins secure the Wolverines' ticket to the PAC Championship Tournament ... Sophomore 3B **Bryan Pierrot** went 6-for-8 with two doubles

and five RBIs against Westminster in Saturday's twinbill ... Senior RF Jerry Ott helped seal GCC's nightcap win with a three-run homer in the fifth ... Sophomore Chris Bowser earned his first win of the year, allowing one run in 5 1/3 innings ... In the opener, senior Ryan Carr fired a complete game three-hitter to earn his sixth win of the year ... Senior SS Mike Ritter homered while Pierrot doubled twice ... Sophomore C Ray Mertz and freshman 2B Ben Wilson both had two singles ... Mertz went 3-for-5 at Westminster Friday.



Thomas More Saints

The Saints kept their PAC tournament chances alive by winning 2-of-3 from Washington & Jefferson ... In addition

to their two wins over the nationally-ranked Presidents, Thomas More defeated regionally-ranked Ohio Wesleyan earlier in the week ... Senior **Brad Thoma** broke two career records – runs scored and hits – the latter coming on a home run ... For the week, Thoma hit .500 (7-for-14) with four doubles, a home run and six RBI ... He had an on-base percentage of .611 after being issues four walks – two of which were intentional ... Sophomore **Adam Sargent** recorded his first collegiate win ... The lefty appeared in two games, going 3 1/3 innings of two-hit relief ... Sophomore **Brad Ketterer** had a .462 average, while sophomore **Marc Price** drove in five runs.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets opened their season against Bethany with a dramatic come-from-behind 5-4 victory on Friday before dropping both ends of Saturday's doubleheader to the Bison ... On Friday, SS Ryan Group drove in the game-winning run in the bottom of the ninth and starting P Landon Sinclair registered a career-best 11 strikeouts in

the complete game ... The Bison took a 4-3 lead in the top of the ninth on solo home run before WC tied it on a wild pitch in the bottom of the inning ... Group then hit a double, scoring the game winner ... In both games on Saturday, Waynesburg surrendered early leads to Bethany ... 1B **Chad Litten** led the Yellow Jacket offense in the doubleheader, going 3-for-5 with four RBI.
