during two PAC appearances for the Yellow Jackets last week. He went all eight innings in Waynesburg's 4-3 extra-inning win at Geneva Tuesday, then pitched two innings of hitless, scoreless relief in WU's 12-9 victory at Thomas More Saturday.

Also nominated was junior **Mike Kochman** of Bethany, senior **Mike Herringshaw** of Grove City, freshman **Grant Lewis** of Thomas More, senior **Andrew Bales** of Washington & Jefferson, and freshman **Ty Miller** of Westminster.

**W&J IN COMMAND:** Washington & Jefferson is in the drivers seat in the race for the top seed and hosting rights for the 2010 PAC Baseball Tournament on May 13-15. The #21-ranked Presidents (13-2), ranked #1 in the Mideast region, need just one win or one loss by Thomas More (11-4) to clinch the top spot.

**NEWS & NOTES:** Three teams - Westminster, Waynesburg, and Bethany - all remain in contention for the fourth and final spot in the PAC Tournament. Of the three, the Titans (6-9 PAC) control their own destiny entering the final weekend, courtesy of holding a tiebreaker advantage over both the Yellow Jackets (6-9) and Bison (5-10).

**AROUND THE PAC:** Chris Leasure broke the Bethany single season home run record when he launched his 10th homer of the year against Westminster ... Saint Vincent P **Paul Kubeja** took a perfect game into the bottom of the eighth at Westminster Saturday before suffering a 1-0 hard-luck extra-inning loss.

# PAC BASEBALL NOTES

## Bethany Bison (19-15, 5-10 PAC)



Bethany split their four games last week, grabbing a win over PSU-Fayette and splitting a twinbill with Westminster, while falling in a one-run decision to Saint Vincent ... BC scored seven times in the last two innings to pull away for 13-2 win over Fayette behind **Mike Pegg** (4-for-5, 3 RBIs) and **Brad Kubis** (3-for-6, 3 RBIs) ... Home runs by **Tyler Dillingier** (solo) and **TJ Zarewicz** (two-run) weren't enough in the 10-9 defeat to Saint Vincent ... Another Zarewicz jack, a two-run blast, capped a seven-run 5<sup>th</sup> inning and Kubis earned his 11<sup>th</sup> save as the Bison rallied for a 7-6 win over Westminster ... **Chris Leasure** broke the Bethany single-season HR record with a two-run homer in game two for his 10<sup>th</sup> of the year but the Titans came away with a 7-5 win.

## Geneva Golden Tornadoes (16-20)



The Geneva baseball team closed out its season with a pair of victories on Saturday against Thiel College ... Finishing with a 16-20 overall record, the Golden Tornadoes turned to a pair of seniors on the final day of the season on the mound ... Seniors **Phil Shallenberger** and **Dylan Viehdorfer** each picked up victories in their final Geneva games ... Senior **Justin Acosta** paced the offense with a three-hit, three-RBI effort in an 8-6 victory in game two of the doubleheader ... Senior **Joel Dille** also came up with an RBI in helping Geneva to a 4-1 win in game one of the twinbill ... Geneva's 14 hit attack in the night cap was paced by three hits from **Adam Scheiderer**.

## Grove City Wolverines (16-16, 9-6 PAC)



Grove City clinched a berth in the PAC Championship Tournament by rallying past W&J Saturday, 11-8 ... Junior SS **Andrew Patterson** broke a 6-6 tie with a two-run double in the sixth ... P **Mike Herringshaw** pitched three innings of relief to earn his ninth win of the season ... That ties **Erik Arnesen's** single-season win record set in 2006 ... GCC opened the week with a 6-3 victory at Thiel ... Herringshaw worked eight innings for the win and junior **Cory Metcalf** pitched the ninth for his first collegiate save ... **Butch Kriger's** run-scoring single in the fourth put the Wolverines ahead to stay ... Grove City will host Bethany this weekend in the final series of PAC play ... C **Marcus Magister** has 22 career home runs and is one away from tying the career mark of **Nate Kauffman**, who hit 23 from 1998-2001.

## Saint Vincent Bearcats (18-18)



The Bearcats went 3-2 on the week, moving back to the .500 mark for the season ... Tuesday, SVC came out on top in a back-and-forth affair with Bethany, winning 10-9 ... **Zach Bush** went 3-for-4 with two RBIs, while **Brad Burkardt** has two hits and three RBIs ... **Danny Jackson** tied a school record with his third save of the season, in relief of winning P **Matt Tyson** ... Thursday, the Bearcats took two from PSU-Fayette, winning 11-3 and 6-4 ... In the opener, **Vince Yandura** threw a complete game five-hitter, with five strikeouts ... **Mike Tedesco** picked up his first career win in the nightcap ... Offensively, **Zack Galasso** went 5-for-8 and belted a pair of homers in the twinbill, his sixth and seventh of the season ... Saturday, SVC lost a pair of heartbreakers at Westminster, falling 9-8 and 1-0 in nine innings.

## Thiel Tomcats (13-24, 4-14 PAC)



Thiel compiled a 1-3 record last week, with the unquestioned highlight being a record-setting 23-9 drubbing of Geneva Friday ... The Tomcat offense out-hit Geneva 26-to-11 on the day, led by a 5-for-6 outing from junior CF **Luke Johnson**, who also scored three runs and drove in three more ... Freshman SS **Ryan Dixon** registered three hits in four at bats, including a two-run homer in the second inning ... Dixon also drove in four runs on the day and scored four more, which ties the school single-game mark ... Freshman LF **Eric King** also earned a spot in the single-game record book, tying for the most at bats in a contest with seven ... For the week, Dixon led Thiel with a .571 batting average (8-for-14) with six runs scored, four RBIs and a home run... Three of Dixon's hits went for extra bases.

## Thomas More Saints (24-13, 11-4 PAC)



The Saints went 3-2 last week as TMC defeated Wittenberg, took two-of-three from Waynesburg and fell to W&J ... Senior 2B **Chris Fishburn** led the team at the plate last week with a .650 batting average (13-for-20) with two home runs, a double, eight RBIs and nine runs scored. ... On the mound, freshman **Grant Lewis** went 1-0 as he pitched six innings giving up eight runs (one earned) on nine hits and striking out one ... For the season, the Saints are led offensively by junior LF **Max Robbins**, who is batting .481 (63-for-131) with 17 doubles, 41 RBIs and 38 runs scored ... Sophomore P **Paul Uhl** leads the Saints' pitching staff as he has a 2.15 ERA with an 8-1 record as he has pitched 58.2 innings giving up 21 runs (14 earned) on 43 hits and striking out 51.

## Washington & Jefferson Presidents (27-7, 13-2 PAC)



The 21<sup>st</sup>-ranked W&J baseball team made a historic appearance in the NCAA Mideast Region poll last week as it earned the top spot in the season's first poll ... The 2010 baseball squad is only the third team in any sport at W&J to reach the top spot in a NCAA regional poll ... W&J enters the final week of the regular season in the driver's seat for the PAC's top seed ... One more W&J victory or a Thomas More loss will clinch home field advantage for the Presidents in the 2010 PAC Baseball Tournament (May 13-15) ... The Presidents opened the week with a dramatic 8-6 come-from-behind victory at second-place Thomas More ... Junior CF **Andy Trettel** broke a 6-6 tie in the top of the ninth inning with a two-run homer over the center field fence.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (15-19, 6-9 PAC)



Waynesburg went 3-2 this past week with a sweep of Geneva and a nine-inning triumph over Thomas More to stay in the race for a spot in the PAC playoffs ... The Yellow Jackets were driven by their bats over their five most recent games ... As a team, they hit .395, with five regular starters hitting .462 or higher ... Junior 1B **Bill Hanning** led the charge by hitting .524 (11-for-21) during five starts ... Senior DH **Bryan Leones** went 6-for-12 (.500) at the dish, but sophomore OF **Kenny Grant** had the biggest impact on the team ... Grant drove in a whopping 13 runs, including 11 in a seven-inning doubleheader at Thomas More, while smashing his first collegiate homerun and hitting .471 during five starts.

## Westminster Titans (9-20, 5-8 PAC)



Westminster has now won six of seven games, including a 5-1 record last week ... The Titans swept a non-conference DH at Hiram Wednesday (7-5, 13-10) before splitting a PAC twin bill at Bethany, losing 7-6 and winning 7-5, the latter win clinching the season series with the Bison ... The Titans then took both games of a doubleheader (9-8, 1-0) vs. Saint Vincent at home Saturday ... The third game of the Saint Vincent series was rained out Sunday ... Westminster led 6-0 in the loss to Bethany before the Bison scored all seven runs in the fifth inning ... The 1-0 win over Saint Vincent went to extra innings as the Titans broke up a no-hitter in the eighth inning before sophomore **Justin King** hit a walk-off single scoring senior C **Dan Argiro** ... Argiro led the Titans with eight RBI and two home runs during the week while batting .368 (7-19).
