Second seed Thomas More will face third seed Thiel in an opening round game at noon Thursday, followed by W&J facing the #4 seed at 3 p.m. Grove City will earn the fourth seed with a win over Bethany Monday, while a GCC loss puts Waynesburg in. WHO'S HOT: Thiel Ps Josh Tedesco and Dave Diyorio each posted their eighth wins of the season in a sweep of Saint Vincent ... Thomas More freshman 1B Andrew Thole hit .600 (6for-10) with two doubles and four RBIs for the 4-0 Saints last week ... Sophomore C Marcus Magister hit .583 (7-for-12) for 3-0 Grove City ... Junior 2B Wes White Jr. hit .500 (12-for-24) with six steals and six RBIs for 1-5 Waynesburg ... Bethany sophomore CF Tyler Dillinger hit .600 (6-for-10) for the 0-3 Bison. AROUND THE LEAGUE: W&J junior OF/P Jim Pasquine broke the school's single-season hits record with 72 through last weekend ... Geneva closed the regular season with a 1-3 mark against NCAA D-II Gannon and will host the NCCAA National Tournament on May 20-23 ... CF **Tyler Dillinger** went 4-for-4 with 2 runs and 1 RBI in the 2<sup>nd</sup> game and batted .600 (6-10) with 2 doubles for the week ... LHP **Adam Nyswaner** appeared in his 20<sup>th</sup> game this season against GCC to set a new Bison single-season record.

Jeremy Rodgers went 3-for-3 with two doubles and two runs scored, while teammate Mark Shouey also doubled twice in the losing effort ... Primeaux finished the season as the team's leader in most offensive categories, including hits (46), home runs (5), doubles (13), RBI's (26) and runs scored (29).

Pasquine collected two hits, which catapulted him into the top spot on the single-season hits list with 72, passing current W&J assistant coach Shaun Pfeil ('07) who previously held the record with 71 hits ... Thomchick broke the school record for home runs in a season as he smacked his ninth homer in the loss, which broke Tim Boal's ('78) previous record of eight homers in a season.
