**TOURNEY TIME:** Washington & Jefferson has clinched the top seed and hosting rights for the 2009 PAC Baseball Championship Tournament, which will take place at W&J's Ross Memorial Park Thursday-Saturday beginning at noon each day. Second seed Thomas More will face third seed Thiel in an opening round game at noon Thursday, followed by W&J facing the #4 seed at 3 p.m. Grove City will earn the fourth seed with a win over Bethany Monday, while a GCC loss puts Waynesburg in.

**WHO'S HOT:** Thiel Ps **Josh Tedesco** and **Dave Diyorio** each posted their eighth wins of the season in a sweep of Saint Vincent ... Thomas More freshman 1B **Andrew Thole** hit .600 (6-for-10) with two doubles and four RBIs for the 4-0 Saints last week ... Sophomore C **Marcus Magister** hit .583 (7-for-12) for 3-0 Grove City ... Junior 2B **Wes White Jr.** hit .500 (12-for-24) with six steals and six RBIs for 1-5 Waynesburg ... Bethany sophomore CF **Tyler Dillinger** hit .600 (6-for-10) for the 0-3 Bison.

**AROUND THE LEAGUE:** W&J junior OF/P **Jim Pasquine** broke the school's single-season hits record with 72 through last weekend ... Geneva closed the regular season with a 1-3 mark against NCAA D-II Gannon and will host the NCCAA National Tournament on May 20-23 ... Westminster sophomore P **Tim Lynn** fired a complete game in a season-ending 4-3 loss at Thomas More ... Saint Vincent closed the season with two loss as Thiel, despite **Jeremy Rodgers** going 3-for-3 in the nightcap.

## Bethany Bison (3-31, 2-15 PAC)



Bethany lost three games on the field and lost four to the rain last week, including a twinbill at Franciscan that BC led 10-2 in the 5<sup>th</sup> inning of game 1 ... The Bison opened the week with a non-conference setback to LaRoche, but the 2<sup>nd</sup> game was called because of rain ... Bethany took on Grove City Saturday in a doubleheader and after losing a 5-0 decision in the opener, nearly battled back from a 9-5 deficit in the nightcap ... BC scored 3 times in the 7<sup>th</sup>, but couldn't get the equalizer to drop a 9-8 contest ... CF **Tyler Dillinger** went 4-for-4 with 2 runs and 1 RBI in the 2<sup>nd</sup> game and batted .600 (6-10) with 2 doubles for the week ... LHP **Adam Nyswaner** appeared in his 20<sup>th</sup> game this season against GCC to set a new Bison single-season record.

## Geneva Golden Tornadoes (22-15)



Geneva went 1-3 this week in a four-game series against D-II Gannon University ... Wednesday, the Golden Tornadoes split a doubleheader with Gannon after they stranded 16 base runners in a 10-7 game two loss ... **Matt Baer** picked up his seventh victory of the season after 5 1/3 strong innings in game one ... The **Jurinko** brothers, **Joe** and **Jon** combined for five hits and four RBI's in game one ... Saturday, Geneva said good-bye to four seniors playing their final home game ... **Derek Sumner**, who broke his own single season strikeout record earlier in the week, ended his home career with both the single season and career strikeout records ... Geneva will now play the waiting game as it will once again play host to the NCCAA national tournament in Southern Ohio starting on May 20<sup>th</sup>.

## Grove City Wolverines (15-17, 8-9 PAC)



Grove City extended its win streak to four last week by going 3-0 ... That run sets up a must-win situation Monday afternoon against Bethany ... GCC will clinch the final berth in the PAC Tournament with a win over the Bison ... A loss puts Waynesburg in the tourney ... Monday, the Wolverines rolled past Waynesburg 24-5 ... Grove City pounded out 20 hits ... **Marcus Magister**, **Andrew Patterson** and **Mark Scriven** had three hits each ... **Mike Herringshaw** threw six innings and picked up the win while **Matt Smith** recorded a three-inning save ... Saturday, Grove City swept Bethany, 5-0 and 9-8 ... **Herringshaw** threw a shutout in the opener while **Cory Metcalf** pitched into the seventh of the nightcap ... **Matt Tindall** worked out of a bases-loaded jam in the seventh to notch the save.

## Saint Vincent Bearcats (8-30)



The Bearcats wrapped up the season at Thiel Saturday, dropping both ends of a doubleheader 6-1 and 10-5 ... In the opener, SVC was done in by the long-ball, as starter **Chris Zampogna** went the distance and scattered just six hits, but four cleared the fence ... The Bearcat offense was limited to just four hits, scoring its lone run via a **Kenny Primeaux** homer ... In the nightcap, SVC jumped out to an early 5-1 lead, but saw the Tomcats storm back with nine runs over the final four innings ... **Jeremy Rodgers** went 3-for-3 with two doubles and two runs scored, while teammate **Mark Shouey** also doubled twice in the losing effort ... **Primeaux** finished the season as the team's leader in most offensive categories, including hits (46), home runs (5), doubles (13), RBI's (26) and runs scored (29).

## Thiel Tomcats (26-12, 12-6 PAC)



Junior 1B **Justin Scarpitti** smashed three home runs and racked up seven RBIs to power Thiel to a doubleheader sweep of Saint Vincent Saturday at Tomcat Park ... Thiel has now won seven of its last eight games to continue its late-season tear... The Tomcats got a near-perfect start out of senior LHP **Josh Tedesco** in game one, as the homer-driven offense hung six runs on the board... **Scarpitti** started the scoring in the second with a homer ... Then, with the score tied at 1-1 in the fourth, the junior smashed his second homer – a two-run shot – to give Thiel a lead it would not surrender... Senior DH **Chris Dunham** hit the third Tomcat homer of the game in the next at bat ... In the fifth, senior **Matt Stumpf** went yard ... In game two, **Scarpitti** sparked a five-run frame in the fifth with his third homer of the day – a three-run shot.

## Thomas More Saints (28-10-1, 12-6 PAC)



The Saints were a perfect 4-0 last week as they defeated Miami-Middletown in a non-conference game and then swept Westminster in a PAC three-game series ... Freshman 1B **Andrew Thole** led the team in batting last week with a .600 average, as he was 6-for-10 with two doubles, four RBIs and three runs scored ... Junior SS **Chris Fishburn** posted a .500 average as he was 5-for-10 with a home run, a double, four RBIs and five runs scored, while sophomore 2B **Sam Schmeltzer** also hit .500 as he was 4-for-8 with three RBIs and three runs scored ... Sophomore **Patrick Allen** and freshman **Aaron Carmack** each had 0.00 ERAs last week to lead the Saints' pitching staff ... **Allen** earned the win against Miami-Middletown as he pitched six scoreless innings and gave up three hits and struck out four.

## Washington & Jefferson Presidents (28-11, 13-5 PAC)



Washington & Jefferson clinched the top seed and hosting rights for the 2009 PAC Tournament after defeating Waynesburg by a margin of 11-3 in the first game of a PAC doubleheader Saturday ... The Presidents have been the PAC top seed three of the past four years ... Juniors **Jim Pasquine** and **Mark Thomchick** both broke single-season school records during the three-run loss against Waynesburg Sunday ... **Pasquine** collected two hits, which catapulted him into the top spot on the single-season hits list with 72, passing current W&J assistant coach **Shaun Pfeil** ('07) who previously held the record with 71 hits ... **Thomchick** broke the school record for home runs in a season as he smacked his ninth homer in the loss, which broke **Tim Boal's** ('78) previous record of eight homers in a season.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (18-21, 9-9 PAC)



Though they suffered through a 1-5 week, the Waynesburg baseball team won when it mattered the most as they kept their Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) postseason hopes alive with a big win on Sunday ... Needing to knock off W&J to stay eligible for the PAC tournament, the Yellow Jackets picked up a 5-2 win ... The victory was a true team effort, offensively, as four different Jackets drove in runs and four different Waynesburg players scored runs en route to the victory ... Sophomore hurler **Tim Knight** had one of his best outings of the year as he tossed nine innings of six-hit ball to grab the victory ... He added five strikeouts to the winning effort.

## Westminster Titans (15-25, 6-12 PAC)



Westminster baseball was knocked out of contention for the PAC Tournament as the Titans lost all three games of a weekend series at Thomas More ... The Titans lost both game of a doubleheader on Saturday by scores of 11-3 and 8-1 before losing a 4-3 contest on Sunday ... Seniors **John Izzo** and **Donnie Kirkwood** and junior **Dave Evans** led the Titans during the series by going 3-for-10, including **Evans'** 3-for-4 output in the 4-3 loss ...
