Bethany Bison

Bethany ended their season on a positive note, claiming an 11-3 victory over Westminster to salvage a split of Sunday's PAC twinbill ... The Bison scored seven times in the fifth inning to erase a 3-2 deficit to win their regular season

finale for the fourth time in the last five years ... 2B **Anthony Talotta** went 4-for-4 in the game and 7-for-8 in the doubleheader, while DH/RF **Chris Leasure** was 3-for-4 in the victory and 5-for-8 in the twinbill ... Senior **Ryan Simmons** went the distance in his final game as a Bison, allowing three runs, two earned, on five hits while striking out a career-high five ... Earlier in the week, C **Brent Owens** extended his streak of reaching base to 23 games, longest since **Jeff Weekley** reached in 29 straight in 1996, but it was snapped in the second Behrend game.



Thiel Tomcats

The Thiel Tomcats will take part in this week's PAC Tournament for the first time since 2004 ... Thiel enters the tournament riding a three-game wining streak that includes a 7-3 win over No. 30-ranked and defending national champion Marietta College on Sunday ... Thiel, who set a

new school single-season wins mark with 27, was led last week by SS Chad Ulogar, who went 9-of-16 (.563) at the plate with five runs scored, nine RBIs, one double and two home runs ... Junior RHP Eric Wadowsky picked up his seventh win of the season Sunday and took over first-place on the Tomcats' single-season wins list ... Wadowsky allowed just one earned run with five strikeouts as he lowered his seaon ERA to 2.06.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

The Presidents clinched the No. 1 seed and hosting rights for the PAC Tournament by taking 2-of-3 games with Thomas More at Ross Memorial Park ... Four W&J pitchers combined to hold TMC to only five hits in Saturday's doubleheader sweep ... The Presidents rallied with two runs in the bottom of the sixth to earn the game one win ...

Senior 2B **Chris Varacallo** tied the game with a two-strike, two-out RBI single and senior 3B **Shaun Pfeil** followed with a game-winning RBI single ... Senior **John Astfalk** tossed the final 1 1/3 innings to record his 20th career victory on the mound ... Varacallo was the only player in the game with more than one hit (2-for-3) ... Senior P **Mike Trumpower** did not allow a hit through the first four innings and allowed two unearned runs to earn the game two win.



Westminster Titans

Westminster went 2-2 last week, losing to Pitt-Greensburg (12-7) Tuesday and taking two of three games in a weekend PAC series against Bethany ... The Titans needed just one win against the Bison to clinch a spot in this week's PAC Championship Tournament, and they got it with a 6-2 win at home Friday ... Westminster then split at Bethany Sunday, winning 8-3 and losing 11-3 ... Junior **Donnie Womeldorff** wielded the hot bat for the Titans with a .533 average (8-for-15) during the week ... Womeldorff's best game was a 3-for-4 outing

Friday ... Other notables included junior **Brandon Drespling** hitting a solo home run against Pitt-Greensburg and sophomore **Mike Busin** going 3-for-4 with a two-run home run in the first game against Bethany Sunday.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City wrapped up PAC play by dropping a doubleheader at Thiel Saturday ... The Wolverines opened the weekend series against the Tomcats Friday with an 8-2 victory ... Junior CF **Brian Moran** homered and drove in

three runs, while on the mound junior **Chris Bowser** worked out of several jams for the win, as Thiel stranded 18 runners ... Tuesday, GCC swept D'Youville in a doubleheader at Niagara ... Freshmen **Jeff Baluch** and **Tim Pliska** combined for a three-hit shutout in the opener ... Moran went 3-for-4 with a homer and four runs scored ... In the nightcap, sophomore **Seth Thompson** tripled, singled and scored three runs ... Senior **Neil Hoagland** made his first start in two years and pitched five innings for the win.



Thomas More Saints

Thomas More dropped 2-of-3 on the road at Washington & Jefferson, and will settle for the No. 2 seed in the up-

coming tournament ... With 14 PAC wins, the Saints had a six-improvement in conference play from last season ... Senior **Dustin Brown** set the school's single-season stolen base record with a his steal of third in the final game – giving him 31 for the season ... Junior **Brad Ketterer** drove in five of the Saints' 12 runs this weekend, and was intentionally walked twice with runners in scoring position ... He finished with a batting average of .429 ... Junior **Adam Sargent** earned Thomas More's only win, hurling 2 1/3 innings of relief.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets snapped their sevengame losing streak with an impressive threegame series sweep of Saint Vincent ... In the opener Friday, freshman P **Bryan Leones** tossed a nine-inning complete

game, allowing two runs on four hits with 11 strikeouts ... Five players posted multi-hit games in the 9-2 victory, including SS **Wes White, Jr.**, who went 2-for-3 with two RBIs and a run scored ... In game one Sunday, senior **Adam Sattler** tossed a complete game and allowed three runs on eight hits, as the Yellow Jackets won 6-3 ... LF **Ryan Group** drove in a pair of RBIs, while C **Jon Conn** collected two hits ... Waynesburg finished its season in dramatic fashion, scoring 10 runs in the fifth inning to erase a nine-run deficit and sweeping the series with an 11-10 contest.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Bearcat diamondmen closed the 2007 season by dropping a three-game series to PAC rival Waynesburg ... Senior **Colin Nickerson** went 5-for-7 in the series against Waynesburg, with a pair of home runs ... The weekend boosted his average to a team-high .379 ... He

also had a team-best .603 slugging percentage for the year ... **Dave Russell** ended the year with a team-high five home runs, while **Dave Jones** was successful on 14-of-15 stolen base attempts ... **Abe Weimer** (.360) and **Mike Killian** (.349) performed well at the plate, along with Jones (.316) and **Jared Lapkowicz** (.310).
