Bethany's PAC Tournament hopes were kept alive down to its final game Saturday, but a Saint Vincent victory, coupled with the Bison game one loss at Thiel, ended their chances ... In game one of the Thiel series Friday, BC scored two runs in the eighth inning to break a 6-6 tie and claim an 8-6 victory ... **Derek Miller** and **Anthony Packer** had two hits and two runs each and Dan Weller drove in two ... Big innings sunk the Bison on Saturday, as Thiel scored seven in the sixth inning to pull away for an 11-0 game-one win ... Miller and **Juls Leto** had two hits each in the game ... In game two, the Tomcats scored six in the fifth inning and a BC rally came up short in a 9-7 setback ... Packer had two more hits and Miller scored twice, while **Nate Tieman** had his 100th career hit.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (15-21, 9-15 PAC)



Geneva's baseball team ended the 2012 campaign with an overall record of 15-21 which included a 9-15 record in the PAC ... **Mike Jeffreys** was once again on his game on the mound in helping Geneva to a 4-3 victory over Waynesburg in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader ... Braving frigid temperatures and dodging snowflakes, the Golden Tornadoes managed a split against the Yellow Jackets ... A group of seven seniors played their final games for Geneva on Saturday ... The senior class of 2012 including **Tad Forsythe**, **Mike Suluva**, **Joel Gatti**, **Adam Scheiderer**, **Mike Trn**, **Jon Bushmire** and **Noah Medich** have each played significant role for the Golden Tornadoes over the past four years.

Grove City Wolverines (7-29, 5-19 PAC)



Grove City concluded the 2012 season last week by earning victories over two of the four PAC tournament participants ... Monday, the Wolverines rallied for an 11-9 win over W&J ... **Randen Schleiden** doubled twice while **Max Vickerman** threw a complete game for the win ... Friday, Grove City dropped a 12-11, 10-inning decision at Saint Vincent ... It marked Grove City's first extra-inning loss in league play since 2004 ... DH Zach Struharik went 4-for-6 ... Saturday, the Wolverines closed the season by splitting with Saint Vincent ... GCC earned a 7-3 win in game one as Vickerman threw another complete game ... Schleiden went 3-for-4 in the win ... Vickerman finished the season with a team-high four wins, along with a save ... Senior **Andrew Krull** led the pitching staff with 15 appearances.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (23-17, 12-12 PAC)



The Bearcats clinched their first appearance in the PAC tournament by virtue of winning the season series against Grove City to close the regular season with a 12-12 conference mark ... Junior LHP **Jared Haller** earned a pair of wins against the Wolverines this weekend, earning the victory in relief during the Bearcats 12-11 win in 10 innings on Friday, in a game that saw SVC rally from an 11-1 deficit, and tossing a complete game in a 4-3 victory on Saturday ... On Friday, the lefty tossed 2.0 no-hit innings with two strikeouts before going the distance in Game 2 on Saturday with seven hits three runs (two earned) and seven strikeouts to improve to 9-3 on the season ... In the big comeback Friday, junior **Grant Krally** rapped a three-run homer while junior **Andrew Kozusko** went 2-for-3 with a pair of doubles.

Thiel Tomcats (18-22, 10-14 PAC)



After watching Bethany jump out to a 5-0 first inning lead and hold on for an 8-6 win Friday, the Tomcats responded by sweeping Saturday's doubleheader at Tomcat Park, winning 11-0 and 9-7 to close out their 2012 campaign ... **Phil Double** proved to be the catalyst for Thiel in the sweep, finishing 3-for-6 with four RBIs and a pair of runs scored ... In his final start for Thiel, Brad Bates was terrific on the mound in game one, allowing just six hits in the complete-game shutout ... Bates, closing out his senior campaign with a 4-6 record, also recorded a pair of strikeouts in the victory ... **Doug Farley** and **Dan Gainey** each added two hits, two RBIs and a run, while Double and **Ryan Dixon** chipped in with two RBIs and a run scored ... **Bobby Hillier** improved to 3-2 after surrendering six runs (five earned).

Thomas More Saints (25-14, 13-11 PAC)



Thomas More went 0-3 last week against 18th-ranked Washington & Jefferson ... Junior SS **David Kennett** led the Saints at the plate with a .444 batting average as she was four-for-nine with two runs scored ... Junior P **Mike Hager** led the Saints on the mound as he had a 0.00 ERA as he pitched three shutout innings and gave up only one hit ... For the season, Kennett leads the team at the plate with a .416 batting average with two triples and 10 doubles, while freshman P **Tim Baldrick** leads the team on the mound with a 5-2 record and a 3.88 ERA as he has pitched 51.0 innings and has gave up 27 runs (22 earned) on 54 hits ... Thomas More enters the PAC tournament as the No. 3 seed ... The Saints have made the PAC baseball tournament all seven years they have been in the conference.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (33-6, 21-3 PAC)



Washington & Jefferson completed its regular season with a 7-1 final week ... W&J will be the No. 1 seed and host for the PAC Tournament beginning Thursday ... The Presidents set school records with 33 regular-season victories and 21 conference wins ... W&J claimed back-to-back walkoff wins in games against 20+ win teams, Mount Union and Thomas More ... Senior SS **Aaron Klinec** collected a game-winning single against the region's No. 5 team Mount Union and junior **Scott Brady** had a walkoff base hit versus two-time defending PAC champion Thomas More ... Sophomore **Josh Staniscia** set a single-season W&J record with eight triples ... Senior **Dave Trushel** tied W&J's single-season benchmark with his eighth complete game and tied another school single-season record with his ninth victory.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (22-18, 11-13 PAC)



The 2012 season came to an end for the Waynesburg University baseball team this weekend with a three-game sweep at the hands of Westminster ... The Yellow Jackets entered the three-game series in fourth place in the PAC standings, which was the final spot for the playoffs, but were eliminated from the postseason by the Titans ... Junior 1B **Bobby Hartman** led the Jackets at the plate by hitting .556 (five-of-nine) with a double, a triple, an RBI and a run scored ... Senior LF **Nick Berdine** and junior SS **Kyle Sasala** scored a team-high two runs each, while Berdine posted a team-high two RBI.

Westminster Titans (25-15, 16-8 PAC)



The Titans are riding on a four-game winning streak going into the 2012 PAC Tournament ... Westminster, the second-seed, will play the third-seeded Thomas More on Thursday ... The Titans are vying for their first PAC Championship since 2005 ... Earlier in the season, Westminster swept the Saints in a doubleheader, 5-4 and 6-1, before losing in extra innings, 10-9, in a nine-inning contest ... Last week, Westminster topped Saint Vincent 8-4 on Monday before sweeping Waynesburg in a three-game series; 10-2, 3-2, and 7-4 ... Three Titans batted .500 or higher: senior **Tim Wiand** (.563) and juniors **Kyle Allen** (.533) and **Justin King** (.500) ... Wiand and Allen led the team with six RBIs each ... Seniors **Justin Prejsnar** and **Vince Iosue** each earned a complete-game win with ERAs of 1.00 and 1.29, respectively.
