Triplett allowed one unearned run on just three hits with two walks and seven strikeouts in 6 2/3 innings to earn the win in a 4-1 victory over Pitt-Greensburg.

#### Bethany Bison

After going on a five-game winning streak - including a win over NCAA Division II neighbor West Liberty 3-2 Tuesday, Bethany dropped a pair to Otterbein (4-1, 8-4) and fell to Penn State-Behrend (6-3) ... Bethany's win over West Liberty was in a season-long 13 innings before junior Ryan Simmons ended the game with a run-scoring single into right field ... Before the less-than-memorable week, the Bison had won eight out of nine to cement their second-place finish in the PAC Tournament ... The Bison head to the field this week to bring home their first PAC Conference Championship since 2000 when they take on Westminster at 3:30 p.m., on Thursday at Washington & Jefferson.

#### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J ran its win streak to nine games this week with five-straight wins before falling to Pitt-Bradford, 6-5, in extra innings in the second game of a doubleheader Sunday ... The Presidents cracked the Mideast Regional poll this past week at #5 ... W&J also ran its school-record win total to 28 games heading into Tuesday's regular-season finale with Marietta, who is ranked No. 2 in the Mideast Region ... Sophomore RF Ron Mitko gave W&J all the runs it needed it game one versus UP-G with a grand slam in the first inning ... Mitko scored the game-winning run in the second game after touching home on a single by freshman LF Greg Barton ... Junior P Dan Yokitis allowed two runs on six hits to earn the win against Lake Erie.

Vincent also collected an RBI single for the other run ... He and 2B Brian Gerginski each collected multi-hit games ... The Bobcat bats belted Yellow Jacket pitching for 11 runs on 17 hits in the nightcap, scoring at least a run in each at-bat. ... DH Mike Majetic and 2B Aaron Lillibridge each recorded RBIs for Waynesburg in game two.

#### Thiel Tomcats

Thiel concluded its 2005 last week, splitting a non-conference double header at Oberlin Sunday afternoon ... Thiel claimed game one 8-1 before falling in game two 5-3 ... Senior SP Keith Jackson tossed a complete game one hitter in game one, allowing just a single in the fifth inning to go along with five strikeouts ... Senior C Kevin DeFrancesco went 1-for-3 with a two-run double to pace the offense ... Thiel managed just six hits in the game two loss ... Junior RF Mark Nightingale finished 2-for-3 with an RBI in the loss ... Junior SP Rick McNeal took the loss, allowing four runs on seven hits in 3.0 innings.

#### Westminster Titans

Westminster split a non-conference doubleheader with visiting Pitt-Greensburg Monday, falling 4-3 in game one before salvaging the split with a 4-1 win in the nightcap ,,, At the plate, the Titans were limited to just four hits in the opener ...
