complete game two-hit shutout for the Wolverines on Friday in a 5-0 road PAC win at Westminster, walking none while striking out 10 Titan batters. He became the first GCC pitcher ito throw a nine-inning shutout in the past 14 years, while also keeping alive the Wolverines' chances of earning the top seed for the PAC Tournament.

Also nominated was senior **Mike Muklewicz** of Bethany, junior **Aaron Carmack** of Thomas More, freshman **Marc Rizzo** of W&J, junior **Rob Baumgartel** of Waynesburg, and junior **Vince Iosue** of Westminster.

TOURNEY TIME: The 2011 PAC Tournament is scheduled for this Thursday-Saturday, May 12-14, with site and game times still TBA late Monday or early Tuesday ... Grove City can clinch the #1 seed with a DH sweep of Westminster Monday, and would then host the tournament at a neutral site TBA ... If GCC loses one game, Thomas More is the top seed.

NEWS & NOTES: Thomas More senior 3B Sam Schmeltzer set a new program record for career RBIs (160) vs. W&J ... Grove City coach Rob Skaricich (235 career wins) needs one win to tie and two to pass Jack Behringer (236, 1959-88) as the all-time program leader in wins ... Junior 1B Tim Wiand broke the Westminster season record for doubles in a season (16).

AROUND THE PAC: Geneva will face NAIA member Malone in the best 2-of-3 NCCAA East Regional in Canton, Ohio this Wednesday-Thursday, with the winner advancing to the NCCAA National Tournament ... Senior SS Joe Bogdewiecz moved into second place on the W&J all-time hits list with 215 hits following the TMC series.

Anthony Packer, Alex Evans and Matt Paonessa all drove in two ... Dylan Wassel went 3-for-4 with 3 RBIs in game 2, a 16-9 loss ... Eric Fudala had four hits and three RBIs at Franciscan, but nine BC errors were costly in an 8-7 loss ... Bethany won the opener of the Thiel series 11-4 behind strong days from Brad Kubis (4-6, 2 RBIs), T.J. Zarewicz (3-5, 2 RBIs) and Zac Grayson (7 IP, 3 R) ... The Bison were swept by Thiel the next day. despite Nate Tieman posting three hits and four runs in the twinbill.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (20-15)

The Geneva baseball team will continue its GOLDEN TORNADOES season on Wednesday

afternoon when it travels to Canton to face Malone in what will result in a best-of-three series for the right to advance to the NCCAA national tournament ... Geneva and Malone will play a doubleheader on Wednesday and will play game three, if necessary, on Thursday afternoon ... The Golden Tornadoes ended their regular season with an overall record of 20-15 and will be looking for a return trip to the national tournament.

Grove City Wolverines (19-14, 13-6 PAC)

With two wins against Westminster Monday, Grove

City will clinch the No. 1 seed in the PAC Tournament ... Grove City owns a 1-0 lead in the first of the two games to be played Monday, as the Wolverines scored once in the bottom of the second Saturday before rain halted the doubleheader ... Friday, Grove City blanked Westminster 5-0 at Neshannock High School ... Senior Kyle Silk fired a two-hit shutout for Grove City ... He struck out 10 and did not walk a batter in nine innings ... Silk is the first GCC pitcher to throw a nine-inning shutout under head coach Rob Skaricich ... Butch Kriger roped a two-run double in the win to help the Wolverines take command ... Grove City's first win in baseball came in 1884 against Westminster, 4-3 ... GCC can either be the No. 1 or the No. 3 seed in the PAC tournament.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (16-24, 6-15 PAC)

The Bearcats went 1-3 on the final week of the season, with

the lone win a 10-4 triumph over Waynesburg in the opener of the final DH of the year Sunday ... Joe Aul and Mike Hustava each went 8-for-17 in the four games, with Aul going 2for-4 with two doubles and three RBIs in the WU win ... Hustava went 6-for-9 with two RBIs in the twinbill with the Jackets, ending the season on an eight-game hit streak ... Brad Burkardt went 7-for-17 in the final week, with three hits and four RBIs in the opener with Waynesburg ... Burkardt ended his sophomore year with a team-high 53 hits, while Hustava topped the team with 34 RBIs and tied Zack Galasso for the team lead with four homers ... Galasso ended his junior year with 13 home runs, four away from the school's all-time career record.

Three different Tomcats had two RBIs apiece: senior Luke Johnson, junior Brock Porter, and junior Weston Snyder ... Steininger again had a great day at the plate as he went 5-for-5 in the game ... Thiel also took the second game 6-5 ... Once again, three different players each had two RBIs, including Steininger, Snyder, and sophomore C Dan Gainey.

Sophomore SS David Kennett led the Saints at the plate last week with a .500 average (6-for-12) with two doubles. a home run, four RBIs and a run scored ... In Thomas More's 7-0 win over W&J, junior Andrew Thole set the single season home run record with his NCAA D-III-leading15th homer this season ... Junior Aaron Carmack led the Saints' staff last week with a1-0 record and an 0.00 ERA as he pitched his second straight complete game shutout in the Saints' 7-0 win over W&J as he only gave up two hits.
