Pasquine led the Presidents to a 3-1 week by hitting .538 (7-for-13) with six runs scored, including setting W&J school single-game records with three home runs and nine RBIs while going 4-for-5 in a 22-18 PAC victory over Waynesburg which clinched the PAC Tournament top seed for the Presidents.

Also nominated was junior OF **Tyler Dillinger** of Bethany, junior C **Marcus Magister** of Grove City, junior CF **Luke Johnson** of Thiel, senior 2B **Chris Fishburn** of Thomas More, senior 2B **Wes White Jr.** of Waynesburg, and senior OF **Dave Evans** of Westminster.

Kochman earned the win in Bethany's 7-6 PAC win over Grove City Friday which put the Bison in the driver's seat for the fourth and final PAC Tournament bid. He entered the game with BC trailing 6-3 and pitched 3 2/3 scoresless innings, allowing just two hits while striking out one, as Bethany rallied for the key PAC win.

Also nominated was freshman **Grant Lewis** of Thomas More, and senior **Jim Pasquine** of Washington & Jefferson.

W&J TO HOST TOURNEY: Nationally-ranked Washington & Jefferson is the top seed and will host the 2010 PAC Baseball Tournament on May 13-15. The Presidents will face the #4 seed - either Bethany or Westminster - in the opening round, while Thomas More plays Grove City in the other first round game.

RACE FOR #4: In the race for the #4 seed in the PAC Tournament, Bethany needs one win in its doubleheader at Grove City to clinch the spot ... If Bethany is swept by GCC on Monday, Westminster will get the final tournament spot by virtue of a better head-to-head record against both the Bison (2-1) and Waynesburg (2-1)

AROUND THE PAC: At 20-20 overall, Saint Vincent posted a 12-win improvement from its 2009 record, marking the biggest one-year jump in 27 years at SVC ... Six PAC diamondmen were named to the CoSIDA/ESPN *The Magazine* Academic All-District baseball teams released on May 6

PAC BASEBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (20-15, 6-10 PAC)



The Bison control their own destiny for the PAC Tournament, as they need one win in Monday's twinbill at Grove City to clinch their first berth in the league playoffs since 2006 ... Bethany put themselves in this position by rallying from an early 5-0 deficit Friday against GCC to post a 7-6 victory ... 1B **Nate Tieman**, DH **Anthony Packer** and SS **Alex Evans** all went 3-for-4, while CF **Tyler Dillinger** had two doubles and scored twice ... On the mound, **Mike Kochman** threw 3 2/3 innings of scoreless relief for the win and **Brad Kubis** tossed a scoreless ninth for his 12th save ... BC also received help over the weekend when W&J swept Waynesburg and Thomas More swept Westminster, leaving the Bison one win away from the PAC Tournament.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (16-20)



The Geneva College baseball team ended its season with an overall record of 16-20.

Grove City Wolverines (16-17, 9-7 PAC)



Grove City wraps up the regular season Monday with a doubleheader against visiting Bethany at R. Jack Behringer Field ... Inclement weather Saturday forced the twinbill to be moved to Monday ... A GCC sweep would give Westminster the fourth seed in the PAC Tournament ... Bethany needs one win to clinch the fourth seed ... The teams opened their series Friday at Bethany with the hosts pulling out a 7-6 victory ... C **Marcus Magister** went 3-for-4 and knocked in three runs ... **Dan Quirk** and **Andrew Patterson** both had two hits ... **Mike Herringshaw** dropped to 9-3 with the setback ... Patterson and Magister both earned CoSIDA Academic All-District honors last week .. Grove City will be the third seed in this week's PAC Tournament ... The Wolverines will face No. 2 Thomas More in the semifinals.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (20-20)



The Bearcats split four games last week, ending the 2010 season with a 20-20 mark, more than doubling their total of wins (8) from the '09 campaign ... The 12-win improvement was the Bearcats' biggest two-year turnaround in 27 seasons ... Wednesday, the Bearcats defeated Westminster 7-2 as **Erik Fichter** went 3-for-4 with two runs, while **Danny Jackson** recorded two hits and threw 1 1/3 of scoreless relief to earn his school-record fourth save of the year ... The Bearcats closed the year by taking one of three from Thiel ... Friday, after dropping the opener 9-6, SVC regrouped to win the nightcap, 5-1, behind a complete-game effort from P **Paul Kubeja**, who scattered just five hits with five strikeouts ... SVC was then defeated 12-6 on Sunday by the Tomcats ... **Joe Aul** went 3-for-5 in the finale.

Thiel Tomcats (15-25, 4-14 PAC)



Junior CF **Luke Johnson** went 6-for-6, scoring three runs and driving in three more, to pace Thiel to a season-ending 12-6 victory over Saint Vincent Sunday ... Thiel ends its season at 15-25 and, with its victorious effort, denied Saint Vincent its first winning record since 2004 ... Johnson – whose six hits tied the program record for hits in a game – finished his outstanding season batting .432 (70-for-162) which is the third highest single-season batting average in school history ... With a two-run double in the seventh inning, senior 1B **Justin Scarpitti** earned one final Thiel record by notching his 599th career at bat ... Scarpitti also owns the program's career records for runs scored (153), runs batted in (166), walks drawn (80) and putouts (1,228) ... Senior P **Cory Borland** earned the win.

Thomas More Saints (27-13, 14-4 PAC)



The Saints swept Westminster in a PAC series last week in New Wilmington ... Senior 2B **Chris Fishburn** led the team at the plate last week with a .545 batting average as he was 6-for-11 with a double, two RBIs and a run scored. ... On the mound, freshman **Grant Lewis** went 1-0 as he pitched six shutout innings giving up five hits and striking out seven ... For the season, the Saints are led offensively by junior LF **Max Robbins**, who is batting .464 as he is 65-for-140 with 18 doubles, 42 RBI and 40 runs scored ... Sophomore P **Paul Uhl** leads the Saints' pitching staff as he has a 2.09 ERA with a 9-1 record as he allowed 24 runs (15 earned) on 46 hits and striking out 55.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (30-8, 16-2 PAC)



W&J concluded its regular season with a sweep of local-rival Waynesburg ... The opening game of the series lasted nearly four hours and featured 40 runs and 48 hits ... Senior LF **Jim Pasquine** led the with a record day at the plate ... He set a school record with three home runs and drove in a career-high nine runs ... Pasquine also became W&J's career RBI leader in the win ... Pasquine then pitched 6 2/3 innings in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader and allowed one run on five hits ... Senior RF **Neil Pascarella** fueled the game two win with six RBI, including a two-run homer in the sixth which proved to be the game-winning runs ... W&J set a program record with 30 regular-season victories and will host the PAC Tournament for the fifth time in the past six seasons.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (15-22, 6-12 PAC)



It was a tough week for the Waynesburg baseball team, as they dropped three hard-fought contests to the nationally-ranked PAC leaders from Washington & Jefferson ... The Yellow Jackets' 50 at-bats, 38 total bases and 26 hits during a 22-18 loss to the Presidents, were the highest such totals for the team since at least 2001 ... In contrast, the two teams combined for just four runs on 12 hits in a 3-1 contest that went W&J's way ... Senior 2B **Wes White, Jr.** shined in his final PAC contests ... He went eight-for-11 at the plate (.727), hit his team-leading fourth home run of the season and led the Jackets in runs scored (five), RBI (five), slugging percentage (1.091), on-base percentage (.733) and stolen bases (3-3) ... He also racked up 12 assists and seven put-outs without an error.

Westminster Titans (14-25, 6-12 PAC)



Westminster lost all four games last week, including 7-2 at Saint Vincent Wednesday and all three games of a PAC weekend series vs. visiting Thomas More, losing 5-3, 8-3 on Saturday and 4-2 Sunday ... The Titans relinquished control of their PAC playoff destiny with the three losses and now must rely on Grove City to sweep both games of a doubleheader vs. Bethany on Monday ... Senior OF **Dave Evans** batted .462 (6-for-13) to lead the Titans last week, including three multi-hit games ... The notable pitching performance was freshman **Kyle Allen** logging his first career complete game while pitching seven innings in the 5-3 loss to Thomas More ... Other hitting notables included sophomore **Tim Wiand** batting .385 (5-for-13), freshman **Tyler Robinson** .300 (3-for-10), and sophomore **Bud Main** .273 (3-for-11) .
