Waynesburg (0-0) at Denison (0-0)

Saturday, Sept. 6 - 1 p.m. Piper Stadium (5,000/grass) - Granville, Ohio

Series Record: Waynesburg leads 3-1

Game Notes: Waynesburg opens with Denison for the third consecutive season, its fourth straight year playing the Big Red overall ... The Yellow Jackets will look to increase their all-time record over Denison to 4-1, after last year's 28-7 win at Granville ... The Jackets won the 2001 meeting, 47-42, for head coach Jeff Hand's first win at Waynesburg ... The Big Red return 19 starters including senior WR Josh Jirgens, who caught six passes for 95 yards and the team's lone touchdown in last year's game ... Waynesburg returns 15 starters, including first-team all-PAC QB Jeff Dumm ... Denison finished 2-8 last year, the Jackets 5-4.

Series Record: Westminster leads 3-2

Game Notes: The Titans open their 110th season of football with a non-conference game at former NAIA rival Walsh in the shadows of the Pro Football Hall of Fame ... The Cavaliers have won the last two meetings between the two teams, including a 28-26 decision in New Wilmington to open the 2002 season ... Walsh, 8-3 a year ago, is ranked #21 in the NAIA Preseason poll ... Senior Kevin Huber will get the start at quarterback for the Titans ... Westminster is 3-1-1 all-time playing at Fawcett, going 1-1 vs. Walsh, 1-0-1 vs. Malone and winning the 1989 NAIA Division II National Championship 51-30 over Wisconsin-LaCrosse.

Series Record: Carnegie Mellon leads 28-7

Game Notes: The Tartans spoiled the debut of Bison Head Coach Chris Snyder last year in the opener, as 21 fourth quarter points led to a 31-9 CMU win ... Bethany has lost 13 of their last 14 games against CMU, with the lone win being a 27-16 triumph in 1999 ... A Bison offense that set 14 College-records a year ago will have a new signal caller in 2003 ... Senior RB J.K. Murphy (81 carries, 354 yards in career) steps in as the new running back behind an offensive line that averages 271 pounds per man ... An experienced defense that returns eight starters, including six seniors, is led by LB Steve Ochap, a three-time First Team All-PAC performer.

Series Record: Grove City leads 22-20-1

Game Notes: The Wolverines open the 2003 season Saturday against traditional non-league rival Hiram ... Grove City has not won a season opener at home since 1994, when the Wolverines defeated Kenyon, 21-7 ... Hiram hasn't defeated Grove City since a 26-21 triumph in 1988 ... The Terriers enter Saturday's game on a 15-game losing streak, dating back to 2001 ... Last year, Grove City started Hiram's 0-10 season with a 30-7 victory in the opener at Hiram ... Grove City outgained Hiram 471-64 and did not allow an offensive point ... Current junior Brandon McGlothlin led Grove City with 93 yards in last year's win ... The game is one of six home games for the Wolverines this fall.

Series Record: John Carroll leads 21-7-1

Game Notes: Thiel College returns to the field in 2003 for its 99th season of football and will travel to former PAC rival John Carroll University on Saturday ... The Blue Streaks, who reached the NCAA Division III national semifinals last season, have not faced the Tomcats since 1988 (a 40-7 JCU win) ... The Blue Streaks will be without QB Tom Arth, who before graduating last spring passed for over 10,000 yards in his career ... JCU does return a career 2,000 yard rusher in senior Ryan DeGeorge ... Junior All-American Kennard Davis returns to lead the Tomcats defensively, while senior RB Justin Napotnik comes into the season just 363 yards shy of becoming fifth on the colleges all-time rushing list.
