PAC Offensive Player of the Week

CHRIS EDWARDS Washington & Jefferson College

Junior quarterback - 6-3, 215 Uniontown, Ohio/Green H.S.

Edwards led the Presidents to an NCAA Division III record 49 first quarter points in a 76-28 win over Emory & Henry by completing 7-of-8 passes for 241 yards and four touchdowns in the first 12 minutes of the game.

Also nominated was senior SE **Bo Danton** (Pasadena, Md./Chesapeake H.S.) of Grove City; junior WR **Brandon Chambers** (Farrell, Pa./Farrell H.S.) of Thiel, junior WR **Ivan Hawkins** (Parkersburg, W.Va./Parkersburg South H.S.) of Waynesburg; and senior RB **Scott Froelich** (Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio/Cuyahoga Falls H.S.) of Westminster.

PAC Defensive Player of the Week

KENNARD DAVIS Thiel College

Senior free safety - 6-1, 158 Farrell, Pa./Farrell H.S.

Davis posted eight tackles and three interceptions, giving him 20 interceptions in his Tomcat career, to lead the Tomcats to their third consecutive victory with a 28-14 road win at Bethany in the PAC opener for both teams.

Also nominated was senior LB **Mike Choby** (North Huntingdon, Pa./Norwin H.S.) of Grove City; senior LB **Andy Shook** (Louisville, Ohio/Louisville H.S.) of Washington & Jefferson; senior LB **Mark Harnish** (Curwensville, Pa./Curwensville H.S.) of Waynesburg; and senior LB **Ryan Aleski** (McKees Rocks, Pa./Montour H.S.) of Westminster.

PAC FOOTBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

Bethany enjoyed its best offensive performance of the season against Thiel in a 28-14 loss, totaling 409 yards ... Turnovers would be the story, as the Bison threw four second half interceptions while Thiel did not turn the ball over ... Freshman RB Derrick Keith scored from 43 yards out with 7:27 left in the second quarter, then added a one-yard plunge on fourth down with 21 seconds left before intermission. giving Bethany a 14-10 lead at halftime ... Keith ran for 79 yards in the game, but sustained an injury and missed the majority of the second half ... Freshman Milton Joyner enjoyed his best game, hauling in eight passes for 106 yards ... Senior Zack Merz added five receptions for 78 yards.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J set a new NCAA Division III record for most points scored in a single quarter after racing out to a 49-7 lead in the first period Saturday ... The Presidents' 76 points tied for the third-highest total in school history and were the most scored by a W&J squad since a 105-0 thrashing of Dickinson in 1914 ... 772 games have been played by W&J since scoring that many points ... W&J scored 35 points in the first 6:08 of the game ... Sophomore RB Ryan Mendel led 10 different W&J ballcarriers with 50 yards and two scores ... Senior WR Jacob Shields had three catches for 114 yards, including a 73-yard TD ... Junior WR Aaron Krepps scored one minute into the game on a 29-yard passing play and then added a 64-yard punt return touchdown a minute later.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City dropped its second straight game Saturday, falling at Muhlenberg 27-3 ... The Mules held Grove City to just 109 yards of offense and eight first downs ... The Wolverines also turned the ball over four times ... SE Bo Danton and WB Adam Wargo each caught three passes ... Senior LB Mike Choby led the Wolverine defense with 15 tackles and a half sack while DE Richard Welch had 1.5 quarterback sacks ... Bradford Clark, Scott Fichter and Greg Moore all saw time at quarterback ... Grove City trailed 13-3 at halftime ... The Wolverines have lost five straight games when trailing at halftime ... They have won five straight when leading or tied at halftime.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

With 12 seconds remaining in the game, Hanover RB Andrew Padgett scored on a 1-yard dive to give the Panthers a 34-31 win over Waynesburg ... RB Ryan Abels finished the game with 120 yards on 33 carries, including three touchdowns (1, 4, 12) ... WR Ivan Hawkins finished the game with career-highs in receptions (9) and receiving yards (175) and now ranks third all-time in school history with 110 receptions ... Senior QB **Jeff Dumm** threw for a season-high 254 yards on 19-of-24 attempts ... DB Luke Cunkelman posted a pair of interceptions ... A potential game-tying 41-yard field goal attempt was unsuccessful at the final buzzer ... For the third consecutive year Waynesburg starts a season with a 3-1 record.

Thiel Tomcats

Behind 182 yards rushing from freshman TB Steve Minton and three interceptions from senior FS Kennard Davis, the Tomcats opened their 2004 PAC schedule with a 28-14 win at Bethany ... Minton became the first Tomcat back to rush for 100 or more yards in back-to-back games since Curtis Jones in 1995 ... Junior WR Brandon Chambers caught nine passes for 153 yards and two touchdowns ... Senior QB Darrell Satterfield completed 18-of-29 passes for 220 yards and two touchdowns, improving his completion percentage to 63.5% ... Junior OLB Tom Wozniak led the defensive unit with 10 tackles and 3.5 tackles for loss and senior MLB Robert Drake added 7.5 tackles and 2.5 for loss.

Westminster Titans

Senior RB Scott Froelich rushed 35 times for 186 yards and three TDs (1, 14, 22) to lead the Titans to a 23-13 victory at Thomas More ... Westminster trailed 13-7 at the half, but scored 16 unanswered points in the third period ... Froelich posted the 22nd 100-yard rushing effort of his career ... Sophomore QB J.R. Barley left the game due to injury in the second quarter and was replaced by senior Joe Getsy, who was 5-of-13 passing for 77 yards ... Senior LB Ryan Aleski posted 13 tackles in the win (6 solo, 7 assisted) ... Sophomore DB Joey Tissler recorded an interception ... Senior LB Tom Kaminsky, junior DE Adam Hadbavny, and sophomore LB Matt Knight each recorded QB sacks.

Series Record: Washington & Jefferson leads 34-21-2

Game Notes: The 4-0 Presidents invade Alumni Stadium to face the 3-1 Tomcats for Thiel's 2004 Homecoming ... W&J held on for a 17-10 victory over Thiel at Cameron Stadium in 2003 ... Frank Pilato led W&J to the victory last season with five tackles, four pass breakups and two interceptions, including one which he returned 100 yards for a touchdown ... W&J had a 17-0 lead in the contest before the Tomcats came back to nearly tie the game late ... W&J holds a 34-21-2 advantage in the 57-game series between the two schools, winning the last 22 straight ... However, the last two W&J wins have come by a combined 11 points ... The last Tomcat win over the Presidents was a 34-3 victory in 1981 ... Thiel opened its 2004 PAC campaign last Saturday with a 28-14 road win over Bethany ... It was the first time in seven trips to Rine Field the Tomcats returned to Greenville with a win (21-6 win in 1990) ... Senior FS Kennard Davis upped his career interception total to 20 after picking off three Bison passes ... The W&J-Thiel series is the second longest in W&J school history.

Series Record: Grove City leads 34-19-3

Game Notes: Bethany will face Grove City in its 2004 homecoming game ... Grove City leads the all-time series, 34-19-3, and won last year's game 17-3 in Grove City ... Grove City has won seven consecutive games against Bethany by a combined score of 170-81 ... The last Bison win in the series was in 1996 by a score of 17-13 ... In last season's game, Bethany took a 3-0 lead, scoring a field goal on its opening drive ... GCC tied the game late in the second quarter, then took the lead for good on a **Brandon McGlothlin** 50-yard TD run ... LB **Tim Goetz** recorded 12 tackles in the loss for Bethany and recovered a fumble ... Grove City has forced 17 turnovers this year ... The Wolverines did not reach that figure until Week Nine last season.
