PAC Offensive Player of the Week

BRANDON CHAMBERS Thiel College

Junior wide receiver - 6-0, 165 Farrell, Pa./Farrell H.S.

Chambers caught 11 passes and accounted for a 2004 PAC-high total of 308 all-purpose yards (123 receiving, 144 punt return, 44 kick return) while adding a receiving touchdown in Thiel's 18-12 loss at Buffalo State.

Also nominated was senior SE **Dave DiDonato** (Bridgeville, Pa./South Fayette H.S.) of Grove City, senior WR **Jacob Shields** (Ashville, N.Y./Panama H.S.) of Washington & Jefferson, senior QB **Jeff Dumm** (Charleroi, Pa./Charleroi H.S.) of Waynesburg, and senior RB **Scott Froelich** (Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio/Cuyahoga Falls H.S.) of Westminster.

PAC Defensive Player of the Week

LUKE CUNKELMAN Waynesburg College

Junior cornerback - 5-9, 180 Verona, Pa./Riverview H.S.

Cunkelman posted a season-high eight tackles while adding a 28-yard interception return for a touchdown (his team-high sixth pickoff of the season) for Waynesburg in a 30-19 non-conference home win over Frostburg State.

Also nominated was senior LB **Mike Choby** (North Huntingdon, Pa./Norwin H.S.) of Grove City, senior LB **Andy Shook** of Washington & Jefferson, and senior DE **Don Waldron** (Cortland, Ohio/Lakeview H.S.) of Westminster.

PAC FOOTBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

Carnegie Mellon found the endzone on its first four possessions in a decisive 63-7 victory over Bethany in Pittsburgh Saturday ... The Bethany points came in the fourth quarter on a Mike Yandrick fouryard touchdown run, his first score of the season ... Yandrick finished the game with a team-high 36 rushing yards on 16 carries ... T.J. Parker led the receivers with 73 yards on five receptions, while Milton Joyner had three catches for 20 yards ... Senior QB Brian Wineberg took the majority of the snaps for the Bison and completed 10-of-18 passes for 107 yards ... On defense, junior LB Tim Goetz led the squad with 12 tackles, while Joe Slezak had three tackles, a forced fumble and an interception from his linebacker spot.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

No. 4 W&J became the seventh team in the 113-year history of the program to post an undefeated 10-0 mark during the regular season after defeating Washington (Mo.), 28-6, Saturday at Cameron Stadium ... The Presidents have assured themselves of a Pool B bid to the NCAA playoffs and a possible home game in the first round ... Senior LB Eric Field became W&J's all-time leading tackler after recording 11 yesterday to bring his career total to 325 ... Sophomore PK Kyle Sidebotham booted four extra points to break a single-season record with 51 this season ... Junior QB Chris Edwards threw for 287 yards and two touchdowns in the win ... The President defense notched six sacks and picked off three passes.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City closed the 2004 season with a home loss to Westminster ... It is the Wolverines' first loss on Senior Day since 1998 ... The Wolverines held Westminster to just 212 total yards and forced nine punts ... Mike Choby became Grove City's all-time tackles leader with 350 ... He made 11 stops against Westminster ... Mike Prioletti had 13 tackles and a sack in his final game at Grove City ... Senior Dave DiDonato caught five passes for 63 yards ... Grove City closed the season with five straight setbacks ... It is Grove City's longest losing streak since losing six straight over the 1995-96 season ... Steve Weary tied a school record with three blocked kicks during the season.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg extended its home win streak to 12 straight games following a 30-19 victory against non-conference foe Frostburg State ... The Jackets put the game away with less than two minutes remaining in the game when RB Eric Daniels ran 28 yards for a touchdown ... Jeff Dumm finished the game with 194 passing yards on 20-of-30 attempts, including a touchdown and an interception ... CB Luke Cunkelman recorded his sixth interception of the season and returned it 28 yards for a touchdown, the first of his career, while adding a teamhigh eight tackles in the game ... The Bobcat defense allowed only 132 rushing yards to the Jackets, who entered the game averaging over 200 yards on the ground per contest.

Thiel Tomcats

With Saturday's 18-12 loss at Buffalo State, the Tomcats finished the season with a 7-3 overall record, tying the school's best single-season win total ... The last time Thiel posted seven victories in a season was in 1972 when the squad went 7-2 and won the PAC championship ... Senior QB Darrell Satterfield finished the day 16-of-28 for 225 yards and is now the program's single-season record holder in completions (169) and touchdown passes (16) and is second in passing yards with 1,955 ... Junior WR Brandon Chambers combined for 308 total yards (123 rec., 144 punt ret., 44 kick ret.) and one receiving touchdown ... Junior WR Dane Haskins caught five passes for a career-best 104 yards.

Westminster Titans

Westminster won its second straight game with a 9-6 PAC decision at Grove City ... A 34-yard field goal by freshman K Jason Lundmark with 4:46 to play proved to be the difference ... Senior RB Scott Froelich rushed 30 times for 118 yards, including a 10-yard TD run which gave the Titans a 6-0 lead after three periods ... Sophomore QB J.R. Barley was 4-of-14 passing for 63 yards, while also rushing for 13 yards ... Defensively, senior DB Clint DeLuca made 12 tackles while senior DE Don Waldron had 10 stops and a fumble recovery ... Sophomore DB Joey Tissler recorded his teamhigh fourth interception of the year ... Westminster football clinched its 49th winning season (.500 or better) in the past 53 years.

Waynesburg (6-3, 2-2 PAC) at Westminster (5-4, 2-2 PAC)

Series Record: Westminster leads 35-24-3

Game Notes: For the fourth consecutive year, Waynesburg and Westminster clash in the regular season finale for both teams. The series that dates back to 1910, as Westminster has won eight of the last 10 meetings against Waynesburg ... Last season the Jackets defeated the Titans for the first time since 1986, spanning nine meetings ... The 34-20 victory over the Titans allowed the Jackets to clinch its first outright PAC championship ... In that game, Ryan Abels and Eric Daniels finished with 176 and 133 rushing yards, respectively, as the Jackets combined for 308 rushing yards as a team ... Daniels also returned a kickoff 85 yards for a touchdown, while adding two more on the ground (17, 25) ... With a win against Westminster, Waynesburg would have back-to-back seven-plus win seasons for the first time since the 1966-68 seasons The last meeting between the two squads at Burry Stadium was in 2002, as Westminster overcame an early 16-0 deficit to rally and defeat Waynesburg 33-29 as Scott Froelich rushed for 108 yards and scored three times (two rushing, one receiving) while Brian Ekis caught nine passes for 135 yards and two touchdowns ... Ekis enters the Waynesburg game with 1,939 career receiving yards and needs 123 yards to surpass Matt Dvorsak (2,061 receiving yards from 1995-99) as the all-time leader in receiving yards at Westminster.
