The W&J men opened their spring schedule this past weekend by tying for 11th of 24 teams at the Jekyll Island Invitational in Georgia ... The tournament featured nine of the nation's top 25 ranked schools ... The Presidents posted a three-day team score of 923, 57 shots back of tournament winner Methodist ... During the second day of action, W&J shot 305 which tied for the sixth-best score of the day ... Sophomore **Michael Grasso** was W&J's top individual after tying for 18th place with a score of 223 (+7, 74-73-76) ... The W&J women placed seventh of 10 teams at the Mount Union Invite on Sunday with a team score of 394 ... Capital won the event with 352 strokes ... Freshman **Alison Lazorchak** shot 89 and tied for 11th place overall.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jacket golf teams are scheduled to open the 2006 season on Monday, March 27, at the Westminster Invitational ... After struggling with obtaining a significant number of golfers the last few seasons, second-year head coach **Frank Ferraro** looks to guide a group of 25 players to links in the 2006 spring season.
