Sophomore **Logan Kowcheck** also broke 90, as he finished with 88 (46-42) and senior **Kris Simmons** came in at 90(43-47) ... The Bison return to the links Monday with a match at Westminster.



Grove City Wolverines

The Grove City men's golf team opened the spring portion of the schedule Saturday at Greene County Country Club by placing sixth out of eight teams at a PAC match in Waynesburg ... Senior **Tyler Fitch** tied for 10th with an 82 while freshman **Matt Landin** finished 19th with an 86 ... Grove City's men will compete at Westminster Monday and at John Carroll on Saturday ... The women's team will open the spring season this weekend at Capital University.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Bearcats opened the 2008 season with a strong second-place showing at the Waynesburg/PAC Invitational on Saturday afternoon, as SVC finished two strokes behind reigning 2007 PAC champ W&J ... As a team, the Bearcats had a score of 320, led by **Doug Mehall's** 78, which placed him second individually ... Teammate **Jeffrey Varga** tied for third place honors individually, with a score of 79, while **Matt Broknar** shot an 80, tying for sixth ... **Devin Gmitter** tied for 14th with a score of 83, while **Adam Agin** finished right behind him with an 84.



Thiel Tomcats

Thiel finished eighth at the Waynesburg PAC Invitational with a team score of 389 Saturday at the Greene County Country Club ... Junior **Keith Pero** led the Tomcats, tying for 29th place with a score of 93 (49-44).



Thomas More Saints

The Saints opened the 2008 season by placing third at the Waynesburg Invitational, firing a four-man total of 331. Leading the way for Thomas More was **Marty Arzen**, who tied for third place after firing a 79, three shots behind the medalist ... Other TMC scores included **Jacob Bowman** and **Brandon Dulle** each with 82 (good for a 10th-place tie), **Joe Ruzick** with 88 and **David Clifford** with 96.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J won the Waynesburg Invitational Saturday at the Greene County Country Club ... The tournament counts as a part of this year's PAC Championship ... Junior **Marc Fillari** earned medalist honors after posting a round of 76 to win by two strokes ... Senior **Michael Grasso** claimed third place with a 79, while classmate **Dave Richards** also collected a top-ten showing after placing sixth with 80 ... W&J placed 19th of 26 squads at the Jekyll Island Invitational (Mar. 21-23) to open the spring season ... Fillari led all W&J golfers with a 19th-place showing (227—74-75-78) ... The women's squad also competed at Jekyll Island and placed 21st of 26 teams ... Junior **Allison Lazorchak** was W&J's top finisher in 50th place with 260 strokes (88-87-85).



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

In its first action of the spring season, Waynesburg shot a 341 and finished tied for fourth place at its home event on the Greene County Country Club ... Junior **Tommy Rohanna** led Waynesburg with an eight-over par 80 (40-40) to finish in a tie for sixth place ... Senior **Ryan Heilman** shot a 12-over 84 (42-42) for a tie for 16th place ... Fellow senior **Ryan Reilly** carded a 13-over 85 (41-44) to finish in 18th place ... Junior **Sean Call** rounded out the Yellow Jacket scorers with a round of 20-over 92 (45-47) ... Senior **Tim Drakeley** made his collegiate debut on the links at the event, finishing fifth for Waynesburg with a score of 104 (47-57).



Westminster Titans

The Westminster men's golf team competed in its first event of the spring semester Saturday at the Waynesburg University Men's Golf Invitational held at the Greene County Country Club ... The Titans tied the host Yellow Jackets for fourth place in the eight-team event with a team total of 341 ... Junior **Nick Marzo** shot a team-low 80 (41-39) for a sixth-place tie overall ... Classmate **David Horn** holed an 86 (45-41) for 19th, sophomore **Matt Hoover** shot an 87 (43-44) for 21st, and junior **Ravi Amina** carded an 88 (41-47) for 23rd ... The Westminster women's team's event at Mount Union was canceled.
