The women's golf team was scheduled to open their season Monday at the Grove City Invitational.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Washington & Jefferson men's golf team hosted the Second Annual Peter C. Rossin Memorial Collegiate Classic at Southpointe Golf Club in Canonsburg on Saturday and placed second of 12 teams ... Allegheny won the team championship by two strokes ... The Presidents were led by senior **Bob Waters**, who placed second overall after finishing with a 71 (34-37) ... Freshman **Michael Grasso** tied for fourth place after a one-over par round of 73 (35-38), while freshman **Matt Rayman** turned in a score of 76 (35-41) to tie for 13th place ... Junior **Colin Gray** was W&J's next best finisher in 36th place with 82 strokes (39-43) ... Allegheny's **Ben Rathfon** claimed medalist honors after firing a round of 68.
