Senior Nate Miklos shot an 83 to tie for seventh overall as Grove City tied for fifth out of nine schools at the Bethany Invitational, held Thursday at Oglebay's challenging Speidel Golf Course ... Junior Dan Sumner fired a team-best 81 at the New Castle Country Club on Monday as Grove City opened its 2002 men's golf slate with a fifth-place finish at the twelveschool Westminster Invitational ... Freshman Mary Brown carded the low score in the Lady Wolverines' first three events last week ... Brown placed 10th overall in the 48-player field at the Capital University Invitational, held at Foxfire Golf Club in Lockborne, OH as GCC placed seventh out of nine schools in the final team standings.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Sophomore Jaime White and freshman Scott Bedillion finished in four-way tie for third place in the Bethany Tournament ... Each player shot an 82 to finish five shots behind tournament champion Chuck Thatcher from Pitt-Greensburg ... Sophomore Stephanie Basey shot a 46 to finished tied for seventh in the Bethany College Women's Invitational.

#### Thiel Tomcats

Freshmen Julia Maraccini and Regina Greenly finished tied for 13th at the GCC Women's Golf Tournament on April 1st, each shooting a 56 through nine ... On April 4 Greenly shot a 53 at the BC Women's Golf Invitational, but could not be scored because the team did not field enough competitors for the invitational ...
