Grove City Wolverines

The Grove City men captured first place at Greenville Country Club Thursday, winning by 10 shots ... **Brad Dutton** took third overall with a 79 while **Alex Intihar** was fourth, one stroke back ... **Jeremy Plaisted** added a round of 84 ... Grove City was just one of two D-III schools at IUP Invitational Wednesday ... **Justin Tulk** tied for sixth with a 73 while **Jeff Mohrman** took 41st with an 82 ... Sophomore **Mary Brown** led the Lady Wolverines with a 46 at Thiel Thursday, helping Grove City finish second ... **Danielle Balliet** carded a 54 while fellow junior **Betsy Hollo** shot a 57.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Waynesburg men (339) placed second Thursday at the PAC Invitational hosted by Thiel College at the Greenville Country Club, 10 strokes behind firstplace finisher Grove City ... Jeff Lilley had the best round for Waynesburg with an 83 ... Mark Strosnider finished second on the team with an 84, followed by Mike Vukmanic who shot an 85 ... Jamie White finished fourth on the team with an 87 ... The two Waynesburg women's golfers competed as individuals for the event ... Stephanie Basey had the top score for Waynesburg with a 54, four strokes behind the fifth-place finisher from Thiel ... Jody Hanes shot a 65, as Waynesburg's only other women's competitor.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel hosted their annual PAC Invitational last Thursday ... The men finished third with a team score of 352, while the women came in fourth with a round of 239 ... The men's team traveled to Sugar Bush Golf Club over the weekend and captured both the team and individual titles at Hiram College's Spring Invitational ... Thiel finished with a two-round score of 697, 42 strokes ahead of second-place Oberlin College (739) ... Freshman Lucas Munson, who tied for third place with a 79 at the PAC Invitational on Thursday, won the four-team event with a two-round score of 168 (85-83)... Freshman Julie Stevens carded a 50 at the PAC Invitational which was good for fifth place.

Junior Lynne Szarnicki won the PAC Women's Golf Invitational last week at the Greenville Country Club by two shots ... Szarnicki, who was the only President to compete in the invitational, fired a ninehole round of 44 to claim medalist honors ... The W&J men's squad placed third of four teams at the Longue Vue Invitational on Thursday ... The Presidents finished just five strokes behind tournament winner Carnegie Mellon ... Sophomore Bob Waters placed third overall after carding a round of 79 ... Sophomore A.J. Zubaty and junior Rob Dunn notched W&J's second-best individual finishes, both firing an 82 ... The Westminster women's golf team captured the first team title in the program's two-year history Thursday, as the Lady Titans finished in first place at the threeteam Thiel College Invitational ... On the men's side, three Titans competed as individuals at the event, with freshman John Matune capturing medalist honors for the first time in his collegiate career. firing a 41-35-76 ... The Lady Titan linksters fired a four-person total of 210 to finish ahead of Grove City (221) and host Thiel (239) ... Leading the way for Westminster was senior Jodi Grissett, who placed third in individual competition with 47, and junior McKenzie Crowell, who finished fourth overall with a 48.
