Bethany Bison

The Bison took fifth out of six teams at the Thiel Invitational last Monday, held at the Greens of Greenville ... Senior **Kris Simmons** turned in the best score by a Bethany player this spring by shooting 79 (42-37) to finish in sixth place

... His back nine score of 37 was tied the second-lowest among the 33 golfers ... Senior **Brandon Tonkovich** finished in a tie for seventh place with a score of 80, as he went out in 38 and came back in 42 ... Also playing that day for BC was **Dom DeCarlo** and **Brad Burkhart**, who both shot 97, and **Jason Straw**.



Grove City Wolverines

The GCC women hosted the four-team Grove City Invitational Thursday and placed second ... Sophomore **Renee Ward** took second overall with a 95 ... As a team, Grove City accumulated 444 strokes ... The

women's team will compete in a PAC match at New Castle Country Club Monday ... On the men's side, Grove City finished fourth out of six teams at Thiel last Monday ... Two Wolverine rookie golfers finished in the top five ... Freshman **Troy Demmer** took second with a 75 while **Matt Landin** took fifth with a 78 ... The annual Grove City "MBA" Invitational has been rescheduled for April 28 at Grove City Country Club.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Bearcat men finished 12th of 15 teams at the two day Mid-Atlantic Regionals, led by **Devin Gmitter's** two-round score of 158 ... The squad regrouped to take the team title at the Carnegie Mellon Invitational ... **Jeff Varga** took second individually with a one-over 71, one

stroke behind the leader ... **Doug Mehall** finished fourth with a three-over 73, while **John Lutzka** finished seventh (75), and **Matt Bronkar** eleventh (79) ... The Lady Bearcats opened 2008 with a second place finish at the W&J Invitational Monday ... **Natalie Caratelli** led SVC with a score of 94, good for third place ... **Taylor Bianco** finished in fourth (97), while **Marlie Strosnider** took eighth. Thursday, SVC took the team title at the Grove City Invitational, led by Bianco, who earned the individual title with a career low 83.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcat men finished sixth (358) at the Thiel Invitational Monday while the women picked up a 506-599 dual victory over Notre Dame on Monday before finishing fourth (518) at Wednesday's Grove City Invitational ... Junior **Keith Pero** was the top Tomcat scorer on Monday, finishing tied for 12th place (40-

43-83) ... Junior **Adam Daubspeck** finished 16th (42-46-88) ... On the women's side, freshman **Ashley Ahrens** was the top performer against Notre Dame, finishing with a 99 ... At the GCC Invitational, senior **Nancy Nunnally** led the Tomcats with her 10th place finish (54-60-114) while Ahrens finished tied for 11th (60-57-117).



Thomas More Saints

Thomas More finished 15th of 15 schools in the Emory Spring Invitational ... Sophomore **Marty Arnzen** led the Saints with a 47th place finish shooting 77-81-158 ... **Jacob Bow**-

man carded 81-80-161 ... Joe Ruzick was third with a 85-78-163 ... Brandon Dulle carded a 87-84-171 and Kyle Hoover shot a 89-91-179.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

The W&J men finished in a third-place tie with Allegheny College at Hershey last week ... The Presidents were led by senior **Michael Grasso** who tied for fifth place with 150 strokes (77-73) ... Grasso's round of 73 Monday tied for the third-lowest round of the day ... Junior **Marc Fillari** and freshman **Brad Cieslinski** both tied for 13th

place with 154 ... Sophomore **Leslie Walker** earned medalist honors with a round of 85 to help W&J win its own women's golf invitational Monday ... The Presidents posted a score of 375 to run away with the tournament by 78 strokes ... W&J had three of the top five finishers in the 22-golfer field led by Walker's individual title ... Walker placed third Saturday in an 81-golfer field at Ohio Northern after shooting 82 (40-42).



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Waynesburg men's team opened the week with a second-place showing at the six-team Thiel College Invitational ... Senior **Ryan Heilman** shot team-best round of 80 (39-41) to finish in a tie for seventh-place

overall ... On Thursday, Heilman again led the team with a season-best round of six-over 76 (39-37) to finish in fifth place ... The Waynesburg women's golf team opened their season on Monday with a fifth-place finish at the Southpointe Invitational ... Sophomore **Maddie Oltman** led the team with a round of 135 (62-73).



Westminster Titans

The Westminster men's and women's golf teams each competed in two events last week including the men placing third out of six teams (340) at Thiel and fourth out of five (318) at Carnegie Mellon, while the women took third out of five (462) at Wash-

ington & Jefferson and third out of four (454) at Grove City ... For the women, senior **Danielle Adams** led the Titans with a ninth-place score of 112 at W&J, while senior **Katie Molchan** placed third overall for Westminster with a 103 at Grove City ... For the men, junior **Nick Marzo** tied for third with a 77 at Thiel and junior **Ravi Amina** tied for eighth with a 76 at Carnegie Mellon.
