The Grove City men's team took 11th out of 16 teams at the Mid-Atlantic Invitational in Hershey last weekend ... Grove City entered the two-day event as the 12th seed ... Sophomore **Tyler Fitch** led Grove City with a 14th-

place finish ... Fitch shot 79-80 159 on the par-71 course ... Freshman **Dan Statler** and senior **Tony Zanotti** tied for 53rd with 170 while freshman **Tyler Sorensen** took 55th at 171 ... 163 (80-83) ... Freshman **Marc Fillari** earned CMU medalist honors at the Links at Spring Church after firing a two-day score of 146 (74-72) ... Grasso tied for second with 149 strokes (76-73), while Richards tied for 12th with 156 (81-75) ... Sophomore **Allison Casoli** led the Presidents to the Thiel Invitational Championship Thursday after earning medalist honors with a round of 89 (45-44) ... Casoli topped her teammate, freshman **Alison Lazorchak**, by five strokes.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg placed just one stroke behind Notre Dame (Ohio) to finish in second place at the 2005 Thiel Invitational ... Junior **Kellen Haines** led a group of four Yellow Jackets with top-10 finishes at the five-team invitational ... Haines and his second-place finish (38-40-78, +6) paced the Yellow Jackets to the second spot on the leader board

with a score of 317, 29-over par ...
