Grove City Wolverines

Grove City's men's team earned its first title of the season last Thursday in Greenville as three golfers finished in the top five ... **Jon Cameron** tied for second with a 79 while fellow sophomores **Nick Tarasovitch** and **Joe Vansovich** tied for fifth with 81s ... Junior **Alex Intihar** fired an 82 ... Junior **Mary Brown** won the individual title on the women's side, carding a season-best round of 39 ... It is Brown's first title of the season ... Senior **Alanna McEntire** tied for seventh with a 52 ... Both teams will participate in the Waynesburg Invitational Thursday in a final tune-up for next weekend's PAC Championships.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg's men's and women's teams competed in the PAC Invitational hosted by Thiel College on Thursday at Greenville Country Club ... The Yellow Jacket men, with a score of 331, took second place in the three-team field finishing eight strokes behind first-place Grove City (323), while the women's team scored as individuals only in the two-team field won by Westminster ... Sophomore **Matt Gibson** led the entire field as medallist ... Gibson shot a 38 on the back nine to finish with a score of 78 (40-38) for the round ... Senior **Jamie White**, who was tied for second place after the front nine score of 39, placed fourth overall by carding an 80 (39-41) ... On the women's side, senior **Stefanie Basey** carded a 52 while **Bethany Thomas** shot a 59.

Thiel Tomcats

The women's team from Westminster and the men's team from Grove City captured team titles Thursday at the Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) Invitational, hosted by Thiel College and the Greenville Country Club ... Thiel sophomore **Julie Stevens** finished fourth in women's competition with a 48 ... Thiel sophomore **Lucas Munson** and Grove City's **Jon Cameron** tied for second with a 79.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Washington & Jefferson women are competing in the second day of action at the TPC of Virginia Beach Tournament ... on Sunday, W&J totaled 440 strokes and was in seventh place out of eight teams ... Senior **Lynne Szarnicki** was W&J's top finisher in 28th place after a day-one total of 96 (43-53) ... Freshman **Jamie Seka** shot 97 (48-49) and ranked 29th, while senior **Brooke Helfer** shot 109 and sits in 32nd place ... Senior **Teri Daniel** is 38th overall after posting a 138.

Westminster Titans

The Lady Titan golf team captured the Thiel Invitational Thursday ... The Lady Titans have now captured two of three events this spring, as they also won the Grove City Invitational on April 5 ... WC fired a four-player total of 185 in the nine-hole event, topping the host Tomcats (226) ... Westminster posted four of the top six individual finishes, led by freshman **Sara Bonchosky**, who led the team and finished in second place in individual competition with a 40 ... Freshman **Kelly Spisak** finished in third place with a 46, while sophomore **Alicia Zeis** was fifth overall with 49 and sophomore **Kayla Pursifull** finished in sixth place with 50 ... After a week off, the Titan men compete at Grove City on Monday, April 19.
