PAC GOLF NOTES

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City men competed in a pair of tournaments last week, winning at Seton Hill and taking second at Waynesburg ... Justin Tulk (76), Jon Cameron (77) and Jeremy Plaisted (78) took second through fourth at Waynesburg as Grove City collected 319 total strokes ... Senior Dan Sumner fired a 59 going out but rebounded with a 37 on the back nine ... Cameron earned medalist honors at Seton Hill with a 74 while Tulk added a round of 77 ... Grove City accumulated 322 strokes, seven better than host Seton Hill ... The Grove City College women's team was idle last week ... Both teams are playing Monday in a final tuneup for the conference championships at the end of the week.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Waynesburg men placed third as host of the 2003 Waynesburg Invitational at the Greene County C.C. ... The women's team competed as individuals as Stefanie Basey captured medallist honors, winning the title after shooting a 44 in nine holes ... Basey shot a 49 Monday at New Castle to place fourth in the Mary Louise Cleland Eckles Women's Golf Invitational hosted by Westminster ... In its only action of the week and only home event of the season, the Waynesburg men's team (336) finished third behind Grove City (319) and Washington & Jefferson (315) ... The Jackets' Jeff Lilley and Jason Augenstein tied for seventh, as they shot 83, while Jamie White finished in ninth by shooting an 84.

Thiel Tomcats

The men's golf team had two finishers in the top ten at the Waynesburg Invitational last Wednesday ... Freshman **Lucas Munson** and senior **Dan Heckert** tied for 10th place after carding an 85 at the Greene County Country Club in Waynesburg ... Freshman **Julie Stevens** fired a 49 at the 2nd Annual Mary Louise Eckles Invitational Women's Golf Invitational last Monday ... Her 49 tied her for fourth place in the 20-player field.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The men's golf team won the Waynesburg Invitational on Thursday, defeating Grove City by four shots ... Senior Mark Hazen was awarded medalist honors after firing a season-best round of 71 ... He won the tournament by five strokes ... Freshman Scott Heyl finished fifth (79), while senior Rob Dunn was sixth (80) ... Sophomore Bob Waters placed 10th with 85, tying for 10th place ... The women's golf squad competed on an individual basis at the Westminster and Waynesburg Tournaments ... Junior Lynne Szarnicki led the W&J competitors at Westminster by placing ninth (54) ... Junior Brooke Helfer carded a 60 to place 17th ... Szarnicki then earned a runner-up finish at Waynesburg with a nine-hole score of 52.

Westminster Titans

The Westminster women's golf team ran its win streak to three invitationals this week, captruing both the Eckles Invitational on Monday and the Waynesburg Invitational on Wednesday ... Senior senior Jodi Grissett led the way on Monday, placing second in individual competition with a 48 ... On Wednesday, three Lady Titans placed in the top five ... Junior Rena Paroz and sophomore Katie **Etzel** tied for third place with each shooting a 55, followed by freshman Kayla Pursifull, who finished fifth overall with 57 ... The Titan men placed sixth at the 15-Team Mid-Atlantic Regional last weekend ... The top Titan finisher was sophomore Scott Voelker, who finished in a tie for eighth place in individual competition with a 79-75-154.
