Bethany Bison

Bethany's last outing before this week's PAC Championships came last Thursday at the Saint Vincent Invitational ... The Bison placed 14th out of 18 teams, which included finishing in front of PAC schools Grove City and Thiel ...

Senior **Kris Simmons** posted the team's lowest score for the third consecutive match, carding an 81 to tie for 19th place out of 89 golfers ... Senior **Brandon Tonkovich** (86) and sophomore **Logan Kowcheck** (88) also came in under 90, while senior **Dom DeCarlo** fired 97 ... Bethany will be aiming to improve upon last year's sixth-place finish at conference championships.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Bearcat men opened the week at the two-day IUP Invitational, finishing in seventh of 12 teams (604) ... **Jeff Varga** posted a 71-69 (-2) to finish second ... **Doug Mehall** took 24th individually with 77-75 ... SVC then captured the 2008 Saint Vincent Invitational at Latrobe

Country Club Thursday with a team score of 309 ... Mehall finished sixth overall (76), while **Devin Gmitter** finished right behind him (77) ... **Matt Bronkar** and **Adam Agin** each posted 78 ... The men participated in the Saint Vincent Invitational Thursday and finished 16th overall ... **Matt Landin** led Grove City with a 44th-place finish, carding an 88 ... Grove City's annual McBride-Behringer-Allen "MBA" Invitational has been moved to April 28 at Grove City Country Club.
