Grove City Wolverines

The men's team placed runner-up to Waynesburg on Wednesday as the host Yellow Jackets won their own invitational by six strokes ... Senior Nate Miklos and junior Jeremy Plaisted carded rounds of 74 and 75, respectively, to pace Grove City ... The Lady Wolverine golf team and top freshman Mary Brown were the leading D-III finishers in the field at Waynesburg Invitational ... Brown fired a 39 to place third overall and help Grove City place second in the six-school field ... The Lady Wolverines won the fiveschool Westminster Invitational at New Castle Country Club Monday as Brown fired a team-low 50 to place fourth in the field of 33, while junior Kristin Costanzo took fifth with a 51.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Jacket men captured their second consecutive team championship, winning their home Invitational by six strokes over Grove City College (300-306) ... The Jackets will travel Monday to Grove City to face the Wolverines (and other teams) in their home event.
