Grove City's men's team won the Waynesburg Invitational Thursday as freshman Tyler Fitch earned medalist honors with a 72 ... It is his first collegiate title ... Alex Intihar tied for fourth with an 81 ... The Wolverines opened the week with a second-place finish at the Grove City "MBA" Invitational ... Tony Zanotti led Grove City with a 75 while Jeff Mohrman carded a 76 ... Fitch shot 77 ... Grove City's women took second at the Grove City Invitational Thursday behind medalist Mary Brown ... Brown shot a 42 to earn her first individual title of the season ... Brown tied for 10th with a 91 at Westminster's Eckles Invitational.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg finished with a pair of second-place finishes this week, including at its home invitational ... Monday, the Yellow Jackets finished second behind two two-10 finishers at the Grove City Invitational ... Freshman Ryan Heilman finished in a four-way tie for ninth with a 78, joined by sophomore Kellen Haines ... Three Yellow Jacket golfers finished in the top five at the annual Waynesburg College Invitational held at the Greene County Country Club Thursday ... Waynesburg (328) finished in second place, just three strokes behind of firstplace Grove City (325), while Thiel College rounded out the field ... Haines led the Yellow Jackets with a third-place finish (79) ... Heilman and sophomore **Ben** Stuart finished tied for fourth with 81.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel competed in two events last week ... The men finished seventh at the Grove City Invitational Monday and were third at Thursday's Waynesburg Invitational ... The women were seventh at Westminster's Mary Louise Cleland Eckles Invitational Monday before finishing third at Thursday's Grove City Invitational ... Sophomore Michael Wackerly was the top Tomcat performer at Grove City, tying for 18th after shooting an 81 ... Junior Lucas Munson finished in second place at Waynesburg with a 76 ... Sophomore Julie Stevens was Thiel's top performer Monday, finishing tied for 18th place (100) ... Thiel's top player at Grove City was senior Regina Greenly, who finished sixth (60).
