PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2011-12 - Week 6 Conference Notes

RING IN 2012: The start of the new year means the re-start of the conference basketball schedule this week, as the PAC will feature a full slate of games of Wednesdays and Saturdays over the next seven weeks ... 2012 begins with familiar faces at the top of the league standings, as 2011 PAC regular season champion Thiel (4-0) and 2012 tournament champion Bethany (3-0) are the lone remaining unbeaten teams in conference play, with Thomas More right behind at 3-1.

NEWS & NOTES: Geneva senior G **David Phillips** became the program's 36th 1,000-point scorer in a loss at Cal Lutheran ... W&J freshman G **Mike Resnik** drained a game-winning three-pointer as time expired vs. Denison ... Senior G **Brett Matson** led 1-1 Grove City to a 1-1 mark at the Bluffton Tournament by averaging 17.5 ppg, 6.5 rpg, 4.0 apg and 3.0 spg ... Junior SF **Phil Feinberg** averaged 18.3 ppg and 7.7 rpg as Thomas More went 1-2, including a 66-64 loss to #7-ranked Williams.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Bethany junior G **Reece Mabery** poured in a career-high 31 points in a Bison loss to Illinois Wesleyan ... Senior G **Dennis Bassich** scored 25 in a Saint Vincent win over Plattsburgh in Miami ... Senior G **Larry Alexander** averaged 11.0 ppg and 6.0 rpg to earn CWRU All-Tournament honors for 1-1 Waynesburg ... Junior G **Anthony Harvey** earned All-Tourney honors at Wooster for 0-2 Thiel ... Junior G **Doug Smith** averaged 18.3 ppg for 0-3 Westminster over the break.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (11-1, 3-0 PAC)



The Bison's only action during the holiday break was at the Staten Island Tournament, where BC finished in third place ... In the first round, Bethany battled traditional power Illinois Wesleyan to the wire before falling for the first time this year 63-60 ... **Reece Mabery** carried the Bison offense as he hit 6 three-pointers and finished with a career-best 31 points ... **Brady Pacific** was the only other Bison to reach double digits with 10 ... In the consolation game, BC's bench had more points (54) than Vaughn College in an 84-38 Bethany blowout victory ... **Ray Neal** led the way with his first career double-double (14 points, 12 rebounds), **Ryan Summers** hit for a career-high 12 and **British Alexander** tallied 11, all in the first half.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (3-8, 2-2 PAC)



During the Christmas break, the GTs traveled across the country to participate in the California Lutheran tournament ... The Golden Tornadoes brought back, along with a tan, an 0-2 record ... Geneva dropped decisions to Carthage and California Lutheran on its trip ... Despite the loss to California Lutheran last Friday, senior G **David Phillips** became the 36th member of the 1000 point club ... Phillips was named to the All-tournament team mainly due to his 21-point performance in the loss to Cal Lutheran in the consolation game ... The Golden Tornadoes will travel to 19th ranked Wooster Wednesday before getting back into PAC play on Saturday with a matinee against Thiel College ... The men's team doesn't return home until January 11th for a date with Saint Vincent.

Grove City Wolverines (5-6, 1-3 PAC)



Grove City placed second at the McDonald's of Bluffton Tournament December 29-30 ... In the semifinals Thursday night, GCC erased a 30-29 halftime deficit in topping Muskingum, 75-59 ... Grove City took command of the game with a 22-8 run in the second half ... **Brett Matson** led the Wolverines with 22 points, six assists and five steals ... **Kris Verderber** added 16 points on 6-of-8 shooting ... Matson recorded a 13-point, 10-rebound double-double in Friday's championship game vs. Bluffton ... **Christian Durbin** also fired in 13 points and Verderber contributed 10 points ... Matson and Verderber both earned All-Tournament recognition ... Grove City resumes conference play this week by visiting Westminster Wednesday night ... Saturday night, GCC concludes the non-conference schedule at Penn State-Beaver.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (8-4, 1-2 PAC)



The Bearcats took their talents to South Beach over the holidays for the Adidas Holiday Slam Tournament in Miami, Fla. ... SVC opened the tournament with an 86-63 win over Plattsburgh State (N.Y.) in the tournament's first game ... Senior **Dennis Bassich** led all scorers with 25 points off the bench on 9-of-15 shooting and four-of-eight from long range ... Three other Bearcats finished in double-figures led by junior **Armani Fountain's** season high of 14 points ... As a team, SVC shot 51.6 percent (33-of-64) from the field in the win ... On New Year's Eve, Saint Vincent played Messiah in the tournament's championship game ... After trailing by just two points, 28-26, at halftime, SVC fell to the Falcons, 60-45 ... Senior **Tauvon Pettiford** was the only player in double-digits for SVC with 10 points.

Thiel Tomcats (7-4, 4-0 PAC)



The Tomcats dropped a pair of matches at the "Mose" Hole/Kiwanis Classic tournament hosted by the College of Wooster ... Thiel dropped the first game of the tournament to the host, and #19 ranked Fighting Scots 78-68 ... Junior G **Anthony Harvey** and senior G **Devon Adams** led the way for the Tomcats with 17 points apiece and junior **Blair Rozenblad** added 10 rebounds ... In the second contest, Thiel once again fell, this time 89-75 to Hiram College ... Junior **Chace McKinney** was the high-point scorer for the Tomcats as he posted 17 points ... For his efforts over the weekend, Harvey was named to the all-Tournament team.

Thomas More Saints (8-4, 3-1 PAC)



Thomas More went 1-2 over the last two weeks as it defeated Cincinnati-Clermont, 78-70, but fell to Spalding, 83-73 and No. 7-ranked Williams, 66-64 ... The Saints had two players averaged in double-figure scoring in the three games as junior SF **Phil Feinberg** averaged 18.3 points per game and senior C **Colt Stafford** averaged 14.0 ppg ... Stafford led the team on the boards with 8.0 rebounds per game, while junior PG **Ryan Hamm** led the team in assists with eight and Feinberg led the team in blocked shots with four ... For the season, Feinberg leads the team in scoring and rebounding as he averages 14.5 ppg., and 7.3 rpg ... Through 12 games, the Saints have a +8.5 scoring margin as they average 76.2 points per game and hold the opposition to 67.8 points per game.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (5-7, 1-2 PAC)



Washington & Jefferson freshman G **Mike Resnik** closed out 2011 with a three-point, buzzer-beater to help the Presidents defeat Denison 64-62 on New Year's Eve ... Resnik finished the game with 10 points and six rebounds ... Senior G **Uchenna Okocha** dished out a career-high eight assists, while junior **Zach Bellhy** poured in a game-high 15 points ... Bellhy posted his fifth 20-point game of the season two days earlier with 22 points in a 79-64 loss to Kenyon ... Bellhy continues to lead the PAC in scoring at 19.3 points per game.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (3-9, 0-3 PAC)



The Waynesburg University men's basketball team snapped out of a six-game losing streak by beating Regis (Mass.) at the Bill Sudeck Holiday Tournament, which was hosted by Case Western Reserve this weekend ... The Yellow Jackets picked up the 64-56 overtime victory over the Pride after scoring the first nine points in the extra period to build a 58-49 advantage ... Freshman F **Jason Propst** led Waynesburg to the win by pouring in a team-high 13 points over just 18 minutes off the bench ... Senior G **Larry Alexander** recorded his first double-double on the season with 10 points and 10 rebounds ... The Jackets opened their two-day run in Cleveland with a 69-51 loss to the host Spartans.

Bethany hosts Waynesburg Saturday and looks to continue a long win streak against the Yellow Jackets ... The Bison lead the series 61-38, including 18 consecutive victories dating back to the 2002-03 season ... Last season, BC swept the two meetings by scores of 87-59 at home and 73-52 at Waynesburg behind a school-record 12 steals by **Reece Mabery**.
