PAC play gets back underway this week with three scheduled conference dates, starting on Tuesday. **NEWS & NOTES:** In his first action of the season, Westminster preseason All-American **Ryne Murray** averaged 20.5 ppg and 9.0 rpg for the 1-3 Titans, including 36 points in a win at Cal Tech ... Junior G **B.J. McGill** averaged 22.7 ppg, 5.0 spg and 4.0 rpg over the break for 1-2 Saint Vincent ... Grove City senior C **Andy O'Keefe** was named to the Marietta All-Tournament team after averaging 18.0 ppg, 8.5 rpg and 4.0 apg ... With 955 career points, Joe Testa needs 45 more to become the 22nd player in school history to reach 1,000 for his career.
