

Ryan Courneen of 1-3 Waynesburg averaged 18.0 points per game ... Ryan Gibson and Andy O'Keefe of Grove City each earned All-Tournament honors at Bluffton ... The Jackets didn't seem phased by the defeats when they traveled to Kentucky to resume PAC play against Thomas More, as they raced to a 27-10 lead less than eight minutes into the game ... However, the Saints turned it around and dropped the visitors by the final of 92-69 ... Junior G Ryan Courneen was the model of consistency during the four-game stretch, leading the team in scoring three times and never scoring less than 15 in a contest.

Last year, which was the first time the two teams had met since the 1989-1990 season, the Jackets dropped both meetings.
