MIKE DRAHOS **Bethany College**

6-5 Junior Guard/Forward Wheeling, W.Va./John Marshall H.S.

Drahos averaged 24.0 points, 9.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.0 steals while leading the Bison to a 2-0 week, including a team-high 29 points in a 100-68 win at Lancaster Bible. For the week, he shot 75 percent (18-of-24) from the field in the two games.

Also nominated was senior C Phil Bushre of Grove City, junior G C.J. Hunt of Thiel, sophomore G Jon Koch of Washington & Jefferson, junior G Ryan Bujnowski of Waynesburg, and senior G Ed Pagley of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

Bethany went 2-0 last week to stretch its winning streak to nine straight games ... The Bison started the week off on Wednesday by downing Medaille College 80-54 ... Matt Drahos tossed in a gamehigh 21 points while pulling down a gamebest 10 rebounds ... Matt also dished out a team-best six assists against the Buffalo, N.Y.-based school ... Mike Drahos followed closely behind, scoring 19 points and pulling in eight rebounds ... Against Lancaster Bible Friday, the Drahos brothers reversed roles as Mike pulled down game-bests in points (29) and rebounds (10) ... Matt shot an incredible 10-of-11 from the field to finish up the contest as the second-leading scorer with 22 points.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson opened the 2005 portion of its schedule with a 1-2 record last week ... Frostburg State handed the Presidents a 93-69 setback Tuesday as the Bobcats used a 29-7 run in the first half to take command ... Sophomore G Jon Koch led W&J with 16 points and four rebounds, while freshman C Tony Lewis netted a career-high 15 points and also grabbed five boards ... Sophomore G Brandon Studer was the only other President in double figures with 13 ... Sophomore G Anthony Hairston led five double-digit scorers with 13 points, eight rebounds and five assists in a 73-60 win over Hood ... Chowan edged W&J, 88-72, in the championship game Saturday ... Both Koch and Studer were honored on the all-tournament team.

Grove City reversed its six-game losing streak with a pair of wins last week ... Senior F Ryan Eller earned All-Tournament honors at DeSales' Casa Mia Holiday Tournament after a 24-point, 6-assist effort in Saturday's consolation win over Averett ... Eller hit four three-pointers in the win while senior C Phil Bushre added 21 points Saturday ... J.D. Collar added 19 ... Bushre and Eller each had 10 points against Elizabethtown Friday night as the Wolverines could not recover from an early 20-4 deficit ... Five players scored in double figures as Grove City earned its first-ever win at Pitt-Greensburg Tuesday ... Despite being ill throughout the game, Bushre poured in 18 points and grabbed six boards.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets overcame two firsthalf deficits to Penn State branch campuses this week to post a 2-0 record ... Against PS-McKeesport, Waynesburg did not possess a lead until nine minutes left in the game, but escaped with a 73-70 win ... The Jackets scored the critical final three points of the game via foul shots during the final 59 seconds ... Marc Lodovico and reserve swingman Ryan Bujnowski each scored 14 points, a career-high for Bujnowski, who grabbed a team and career-high eight rebounds ... Saturday, the Jackets trailed PS-New Kensington 16 points at halftime, but erased the lead to win 78-71 in overtime ... Bujnowski scored a career-high 18

points and grabbed seven rebounds, four offensive.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel did not begin the new year well, going 0-2 at home ... Juniata posted a 91-87 win at Beeghly Gym Tuesday before Fredonia State knocked down a buzzer-beater to earn a 75-72 win Saturday ... Against Juniata, sophomore F Percy Sweeting finished with 19 points on 7-of-8 shooting ... Junior F Damien Williams added 17 while freshman F Joe Herrmann totaled 15 points and seven rebounds ... Chris Donahue hit a trey with one second remaining to give SUNY-Fredonia the victory Saturday ... Donahue answered a three by Herrmann that tied the game 72-72 with five seconds to play ... Senior G Daryl Moore and junior G C.J. Hunt each had 13 points in defeat while junior F Stephen Laird added 10.

Westminster Titans

The Titans split a pair of non-league games in their final warmup before the start of league play, winning 113-109 at Case Western Reserve Monday before falling at home to Juniata 109-102 Saturday ... Senior F Pat O'Connor led six double-digit scorers with 23 points ay CWRU, followed by senior G Ed Pagley with 17, junior F Dom Joseph with 15 off the bench (along with a team-high nine rebounds), junior G Mark DeMonaco with 13, and both senior G Chris Hatch and freshman G Craig Hannon with 11 each ... Hannon led the way with a team- and career-high 26 points vs. Juniata, including seven three-pointers ... Pagley added 23 points while DeMonaco scored 18 and also recorded team-best totals of seven rebounds and five steals.
