#### PAC Player of the Week

#### BLAIR ROZENBLAD Thiel

6-4 Sophomore G Youngstown, Ohio Kennedy Catholic H.S.



Rozenblad aver-

aged 18.0 points and 9.0 rebounds per game for the 3-0 Tomcats last week, as Thiel swept PAC foes Bethany (60-58), Waynesburg (72-66) and Grove City (59-47) to remain in a tie for first place in the conference. He opened the week with a 20-point, 14-rebound double-double (his seventh of the season) against the Bison, before adding 19 points in the Waynesburg win and 18 vs. Grove City. It is the third PAC weekly honor this season for Rozenblad, who leads the league in both scoring (18.5 ppg) and rebounding (9.6 rpg.

Also nominated was sophomore F Nick Wilcox of Bethany, junior G Dennis Bassich of Saint Vincent, senior SG Aaron Miller of Thomas More, senior G Brian Felker of Washington & Jefferson, junior F Jeff Young of Waynesburg, and junior F Rob Briggs of Westminster.



#### PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2010-11 - Week 7 Conference Notes

**CO-LEADERS TO BATTLE:** The race for the 2010-11 PAC regular season basketball titles is underway, with Thiel and Thomas More taking the early lead in the standings ... The Tomcats recorded a perfect 3-0 week vs. PAC foes to improve to 5-0 in league play and 9-1 vs. D-III opponents this season, while the Saints rallied from a loss at Geneva to top W&J and Waynesburg and move to 4-0 in league play ... The two PAC co-leaders meet in Greenville this Saturday at 3 p.m. **NEWS & NOTES: Brandon Sopko** registered 15 assists for Geneva in its win over Thomas More, the fourth-highest single-game total in GC history ... Thomas More senior SG **Aaron Miller** posted a double-double with 26 points and 12 rebounds in a win at Waynesburg ... Sophomore F **Ladell Trotty** posted his first career doubledouble for Thiel with 10 points and 10 boards at Waynesburg ... Senior G **Brian Felker** averaged 18.3 ppg and 5.7 rpg last week for 2-1 Washington & Jefferson. AROUND THE LEAGUE: Junior G Dennis Bassuch averaged 18.0 ppg and 3.3 rpg for 2-1 Saint Vincent last week ... Sophomore F Nick Wilcox averaged 19.7 ppg, 6.7 rpg and 5.0 spg for 1-2 Bethany last week ... Grove City senior G Brett Matson tied the GCC school record with six three-pointers in a PAC loss at Bethany ... Waynesburg junior F Jeff Young averaged 11.3 ppg and 9.0 rpg for the 1-2 Yellow Jackets ... Junior F Rob Briggs averaged 12.5 ppg and 8.5 rpg for 0-2 Westminster.

## PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

#### Bethany Bison (9-5, 3-2 PAC)

Bethany went 1-2 in three PAC games last week, with both losses

coming in the final seconds ... Thiel hit a jumper with two seconds left for a 60-58 victory over BC Monday ... **British Alexander** recorded his first double-double of the year with 13 points and 11 rebounds ... **Nick Wilcox** scored a career-high 23 and Alexander made it two double-doubles in a row (11 pts., 12 rebs.) to lead Bethany to a 75-50 triumph over Grove City Thursday ... Wilcox set a career-high for the second straight game with 25 points and Alexander went for 18 points and eight rebounds, but a free throw by Saint Vincent with 1.5 seconds left gave the Bearcats a 71-70 victory, which was the Bison's first loss at home this season.

#### Saint Vincent Bearcats (9-5, 2-2 PAC)



The Bearcats went 2-1 on the week, recovering from a 71-

69 setback at W&J on Monday by defeating Geneva (Thurs.) and Bethany (Sat.) ... The W&J contest featured seven ties and 17 lead changes and wasn't decided until a W&J bucket with 20 seconds left ... BJ McGill scored 17 points and Dennis Bassich 16 to lead SVC ... At home vs. Geneva, SVC got off to a blistering start, shooting 53 percent from the floor and hitting six treys in the first half, before holding off a second half Geneva rally ... Bassich and McGill shared game-high scoring honors with 22 points apiece, with McGill adding eight boards and six assists ... Saturday at Bethany, Bassich hit a game-winning free throw with 1.5 seconds left ... Dillon Stith scored a careerhigh 22 points, going 8-for-10 from the floor, while Bassich added 16.

#### Washington & Jefferson Presidents (5-10, 2-3 PAC)



W&J won its first PAC game of the season Monday with a 71-69 victory over Saint Vincent

at the Henry Memorial Center ... Sophomore F Ben Cecchini scored a basket with 21 seconds left to lift the Presidents to the victory ... Washington & Jefferson couldn't overcome early deficits and fell 57-52 at Thomas More on Wednesday ... The Saints never trailed after scoring the first five points ... Senior G Brian Felker led W&J with 15 points, while senior Paul Matthews notched a double-double with 11 points and 10 rebounds ... W&J bounced back on Saturday with a 71-68 victory at Westminster ... The Presidents trailed 63-52 with 5:45 remaining, but ended the game with a 19-5 run ... Matthews laid in a basket after two Westminster free throws to put the Presidents up for good.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (9-4)



In one of the most impressive performances **GOLDEN TORNADOES** in recent memory,

Geneva jumped all over Thomas More last Monday and ran away to a 102-73 victory ... By halftime, the Golden Tornadoes held a 47-15 lead ... By game's end, David Phillips had scored 23 points, including six three-point field goals ... Lambros Svingos added 20 points and Brandon Sopko posted a career best 15 assists, which was the fourth-highest single game total in school history ... What a difference a few days can make as Geneva could not get the offense going Thursday night in a 73-65 loss at Saint Vincent ... Despite the loss, Richard Colick scored 21 points and Phillips added 20 against the Bearcats ... Geneva sits at 9-4 on the season as it awaits long time friends Grove City and Westminster this week.

#### Thiel Tomcats (9-4, 5-0 PAC)

Thiel had an impressive week as they got back into

their PAC schedule with a trio of wins ... In the first game of the week the Tomcats defeated Bethany 60-58 ... Sophomore F Chace McKinney scored the go-ahead bucket with two seconds left to give the Tomcats the win ... Sophomore G Blair Rozenblad led the team with 20 points and 14 rebounds... Game two saw the Tomcats defeat Waynesburg 72-66 ... Rozenblad once again paced the Tomcats with 19 points and seven rebounds ... Thiel rounded out their week holding Grove City to just 47 points en route to a 59-47 victory ... Rozenblad, Trotty, and sophomore F Aundra Jones all scored in double figures ... Jones also picked up a double-double as he had 11 points and 12 rebounds on the day... The Tomcat current PAC win streak is at five games.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (5-9, 2-3 PAC)



Waynesburg went 1-2 in

PAC play this past week and played well enough to nearly pull a pair of PAC upsets ... After beating Westminster 75-69 to open the week Tuesday and end a four-game skid to the Titans, the Yellow Jackets either led or were within a basket of pulling ahead in the second half of games vs. Thiel and Thomas More, the top two teams in the PAC ... Both contests ended with Waynesburg losing by single-digit deficits ... Four different Waynesburg hoopsters averaged nine points or better during the week, including senior G Erik Noone, who led the way with 13.7 ppg ... Junior F Jeff Young nearly averaged a doubledouble with 11.3 ppg and 9.0 rpg, and senior G Steven Iser went for 10.0 ppg ... Freshman PG Nick Herman averaged 9.3 points and tallied a team-high 11 assists.

Grove City Wolverines (4-9, 1-4 PAC)



Grove City endured a tough week as the Wolverines went 0-3, including a pair of road setbacks ... Tues-

day at Juniata, freshman G Charlie Thomas made his first career start and scored a gamehigh 14 points, including four three-point goals ... Kris Verderber (12), Cody Fleeger (11) and Luke Tomaselli (11) also reached double figures ... Thursday at Bethany, Brett Matson tied a single-game school record with six three-

tied a single-game school record with six threepoint goals as part of a 19-point outing ... Saturday vs. Thiel, Grove City committed a season-low nine turnovers ... The Wolverines trailed 8-0 early but eventually took the lead early in the second half ... Matson led GCC with 13 points and Thomas added 10 ... Nine different Grove City players have started a game this year ... Luke Tomaselli and Cody Fleeger have started all 13 games.

#### Thomas More Saints (8-6, 4-0 PAC)



Thomas More went 2-1 last week as it fell to

Geneva to open the week, but then defeated W&J and Waynesburg to remain unbeaten in the PAC at 4-0 ... In the three games last week the Saints had four players averaged in doublefigure scoring as senior SG Aaron Miller averaged 17.7 points per game, freshman PG Spencer Berlekamp averaged 11.3 ppg., freshman PG D'Carlo Haves averaged 11.0 ppt., and senior C Brian Muse averaged 10.7 ppg. ... Miller led the Saints on the glass with 7.3 rebounds per game, while Berlekamp led the team in assists with 11 and Muse had seven blocks ... For the season the Saints are led in scoring and rebounding by Miller, who is averaging 15.6 points per game and 7.4 rebounds per game.

#### Westminster Titans (3-11, 0-5 PAC)

Each team won on their opponents' home floor during the regular season, starting with TMC's 90-88 win at Bethany on a Daniel McKeehan putback at the buzzer ... The Bison shot 58 percent from the floor in the rematch in Kentucky and Nick Wilcox compiled 17 points, seven rebounds, six steals and five assists in a 91-75 Bethany win ... In the rubber match in the PAC semifinals, BC had a 39-34 halftime lead, but Thomas More shot 67 percent in the second half to storm back for an 88-73 win, despite 14 points from Wilcox and 11 from Ryan McFaddden.



Waynesburg enters Saturday's matchup looking to end a two-game slide after losses to Thiel (72-66) and Thomas More (86-78) at home last week ... The Presidents have won the last 10 regular-season matchups between the two programs.
