

Geneva ended a five-game losing streak against the Bearcats with a decisive 79-55 victory ... Rich Colick led the way with 16 points as he remains the team's leading scorer ... Colick then posted 14 points in Geneva's 76-59 win over Penn State Beaver on Saturday as the Golden Tornadoes improved to 7-7 on the year ... Bryan Hill continues to work his way back from an injury as he nailed five three-point field goals in the two victories.

Grove City Wolverines (8-6, 3-2 PAC)

Grove City went 2-1 last week. including a pair of home wins

... Monday night, the Wolverines closed the non-conference schedule with a 51-47 win over Juniata ... Brett Matson had 17 points for Grove City while Andy O'Keefe added 14 points ... Grove City limited Juniata to 34 percent shooting from the floor ... Thursday, the Wolverines held Bethany to its lowest point total in seven seasons in a 65-54 win ... O'Keefe (18), Joe McCoy (15) and Jeff Newell (10) all scored in double figures ... Matson and Luke Tomaselli both had seven assists ... Saturday, Grove City fell at Thiel ... O'Keefe (14), McCoy (11) and Tomaselli (11) reached double figures against the Tomcats ... Grove City allowed Thiel to shoot 54 percent from the field in the game.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (5-9)

surpass 1,000 career points (1,008).

After opening the week with a dramatic 71-68 overtime win

over W&J, the Bearcats dropped a pair of PAC contests, falling 79-55 at Geneva Thursdsay and 62-52 to Bethany Saturday ... In the W&J contest, SVC came back from a 12-point halftime deficit by outscoring the Presidents 46-32 over the second half and overtime ... BJ McGill led the charge, posting 22 points and five steals, while Henry Utku and Stephon Berry each posted career-highs with nine rebounds ... In the Geneva loss, the Bearcats went just 30 percent from the field and 17-of-36 from the foul line, with McGill scoring 11 to go with five assists ... McGill was one of three doublefigure scorers for the Bearcats in the Bethany contest, tallying 19 points, while Maurice Hawkins scored a career-high 15 and Ed Wright 11.

Thiel **Tomcats** (6-7, 2-2 PAC)

Thiel won back-to-back games for the first time

since February 2008 as they downed PACfoes Waynesburg and Grove City in convincing fashion at Beeghly Gymnasium last week ... The Tomcats downed the first-place Wolverines, 86-53, behind a 23-point outburst by Devon Adams ... On Thursday, Aundra Jones scored 10 of Thiel's first 13 points to key a game-opening 25-4 run that the Tomcats rode to an impressive 82-68 PAC victory over Waynesburg ... Adams and Blair Rozenblad each scored 19 points in the victorious effort ... Thiel suffered its lone setback of the week on Monday at Bethany, 72-69 ... Rozenblad paced the offense with 24 points ... The freshman also pulled down 10 boards for his second career double-double.

Thomas More Saints (10-4, 3-1 PAC)

Thomas More extended its season-high win

streak to four games as it went 2-0 last week with an 83-81 win at Washington & Jefferson and a 93-67 win at Waynesburg ... Senior PF Daniel McKeehan led four Saints in doublefigures in the win against W&J with 16 points, including the game-winning jumper with 1.8 seconds left in the game ... 15 Saints scored in the win over Wavnesburg as sophomore PG Daniel Whelan led the way with 12 points ... The Saints are shooting 45.6 percent from the field on 426-of-935 shooting and lead the nation in steals with 183 ... McKeehan leads the team in scoring with 13.4 points per game and junior F Aaron Miller leads the team on the boards with 6.1 rebounds per game.

Washington & Jefferson **Presidents** (7-8, 3-1 PAC)



W&J needed three overtimes, but was finally able to pick up its first win of the week Satur-

day afternoon, defeating Westminster 84-83 in the Henry Memorial Center ... Junior G Nick Morelli connected on a putback layup with 13 seconds remaining in the game to seal the win ... Junior G Brian Felker paced the Presidents with 23 points and 14 rebounds ... Prior to the win against Westminster, W&J dropped two nail biters earlier in the week against Saint Vincent (71-68, OT) and Thomas More (83-81) ...
