Thomas More's loss at W&J Saturday opened the door for defending PAC champion Bethany, which took over the top spot at 3-1 following a 76-72 home win over Grove City ... Saint Vincent improved to 12-2 overall after posting two PAC wins this week.

WHO'S HOT: Billy Bains averaged a double-double (20.0 ppg, 10.0 rpg) to lead 2-0 Saint Vincent last week ... Freshman G Lance Beckwith averaged 14.0 points, 5.3 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game for 2-1 Bethany ... Freshmen David Phillips (25 points) and Lambros Svingos (18 pts., 13 rebs.) led Geneva to an 80-60 PAC win over Waynesburg ... Junior G Ryan Courneen averaged 17.0 points per game for 1-1 Waynesburg.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Thomas More set a new school record with 14 three-pointers made in an 80-48 PAC victory over Grove City ... Washington & Jefferson is 4-1 in its last five games ... Bobby Glass scored a career-high 19 points for Westminster in an 88-82 PAC loss at Waynesburg ... Joe McCoy scored 20 points for Grove City in an 81-72 non-league win at Juniata ... Junior Sean Devinney averaged 13.0 points per game for 0-2 Thiel.

BC was tied with Saint Vincent with 6:24 to play but a 13-0 SVC spurt sent the Bison to a 75-59 loss ... Petre Petkovski finished with 17 points and eight rebounds in the contest ... Bethany opened last week by holding off a late Denison charge for a 71-64 triumph ... Beckwith, who went 6-for-6 from the foul line in the final 45 seconds to secure the win, tallied a game-high 18, while Testa dropped in 14 and Petkovski totaled 13.

Earlier in the week, Geneva dropped a 24 point decision to long-time former NAIA rival Malone College in Canton, Ohio ... Junior transfer Brandon Harvey scored a team best 18 points despite the loss ... The Golden Tornadoes were struggling through the worst start since a 1-23 season back in 1981-82.

A pair of SVC players recorded doubledoubles, as Billy Bains scored 17 points with 12 rebounds, and Mike Medved 13 points and 14 boards ... Bains led the Bearcats in their 80-50 win over Thiel Saturday, as the senior scored 23 points with eight rebounds ... Tre'sor Kalambay added 12 points, while Medved and BJ McGill each added 10 ... The Bearcats outrebounded the Tomcats 46-35.

Wednesday, Thiel burst out of the gate against Washington & Jefferson, but faltered down the stretch as the Tomcats fell, 77-62, at home ... Thiel led by as many as nine points twice in the first half ... The Tomcats committed just 14 turnovers - their second-fewest of the season ... In the setback at W&J, the Saints had two players in double-figures as sophomore P Brian Muse and sophomore W Daniel McKeehan had 12 and 11 points, respectively ... McKeehan is leading the Saints in scoring through the first 14 games with 11.8 points per game, and he and senior F Mark Tinklenberg lead the team on the boards as they both average 4.6 rebounds per game.
