## PAC Men's Basketball Player of the Week

## **ROB STRCULA**

Waynesburg College 5-10 Senior Guard Vienna, W.Va./Parkersburg Catholic H.S.

Strcula averaged 24.5 points, 4.5 assists, 4.0 rebounds and 2.0 steals per game last week, as the 2-0 Yellow Jackets posted road wins at Medaille (86-81) and Ohio-Eastern (116-111). In the win over Ohio-Eastern, Strcula led Waynesburg with 36 points including nine three-pointers made.

Also nominated was senior guard **Nevada Smith** of Bethany, senior forward **Pat Roberts** of Grove City, junior forward **A.H. Davis** of Thiel, and sophomore forward **Scott Chodor** of Washington & Jefferson.

## PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

#### **Bethany Bison**

The Bison shot just 35 percent and were outrebounded 49-29 in dropping an 87-72 decision to the Apprentice School Friday night ... After going 9-15 from behind the arc in the first half, Bethany hit just one of 10 attempts in the second half ... Guard **Nevada Smith** drilled a threepointer with 16 minutes left in the first half to surpass 1,000 points for his career. He is just the 15<sup>th</sup> player in Bethany history to reach that milestone ... Smith totaled 18 points in the loss, shooting 4-5 from the arc, and is now shooting 51 percent from the three-point line this season.

#### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J dropped both non-conference contests this past week, falling at Oberlin on Monday, 76-75, and to CMU on Saturday, 94-66 ... The Presidents held a 75-73 lead in the final seconds at Oberlin, but Julius Hill canned a three-pointer at the buzzer to give the Yeomen the dramatic one-point victory ... Nolan Larry led four W&J scorers in double figures with 19 points ... On Saturday, CMU jumped out to an early 30-13 lead and never looked back in the 94-66 triumph ... the Tartans forced 29 W&J turnovers (19 in the first half) and collected 20 steals ... Scott Chodor led the way with 15 points on 6-of-9 shooting, while Larry added 11 markers ... Heading into last week, Larry was second in Division III in scoring at 27.2 ppg.

#### Grove City Wolverines

The Wolverines have won six of their last seven games and are off to their best start since 1994-95 ... Grove City posted a pair of victories last week as sophomore Jim Fetzner fired in a career-high 21 points in a 30-point win over Medaille and senior Pat Roberts led four Wolverines in double figures with 18 points in a 12-point triumph over Penn State Altoona ... Sophomore Tanner Prosser contributed 14 points and 11 rebounds at Altoona, while freshman Nate Mauer recorded 12 points and a career-high 15 boards ... Mauer made his first collegiate start, replacing sophomore center Phil Bushre who suffered a concussion against Medaille ... Bushre could miss up to four weeks.

#### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Guards **Rob Strcula** hit nine three-pointers for 36 points and junior **Ray Robinson** added 25 points as the Jackets defeated Ohio University-Eastern 116-111 ... The Jackets will open PAC play this Wednesday against Grove City College.

#### Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats are in the midst of a twogame winning streak after defeating Hiram 97-70 on Jan. 9 and Hilbert 81-51 on Jan. 12...They shot a season-high 55 percent from the field in the two lopsided victories over Hiram and Hilbert...**A.H. Davis** paced the Tomcats in both wins as he scored a game-high 27 points on 12-of-18 shooting and grabbed six boards in the Hiram win ... Davis finished 9-of-11 from the floor for 23 points and four steals against Hilbert ...Thiel is outrebounding its opponents 517-514 so far this season.

#### Westminster Titans

Westminster went 1-2 last week, falling at #24 Wooster (67-58) on Monday and at NAIA member Geneva (80-72) on Thursday before topping NAIA member Mount Aloysius (71-68) on Saturday ... Junior F Joe Wilson posted a team-high 14 points against Wooster, but missed the next two games with swelling in his knee ... A pair of freshman guards posted career-highs in points in the final two games of the week: Chris Hatch scored a career-high 23 points (including three three-pointers) in the loss at Geneva, while Craig Bohyer tallied a career-best 18 points (including four three-pointers) in the win at Mount Aloysius ... The Titans have now completed their 2001-02 non-conference schedule.
