Lorello earned his second PAC weekly honor of the season after shooting an incredible 82 percent (18-of-22) from the field in a pair of PAC contests for the 1-1 Golden Tornadoes, averaging 20.0 points, 6.5 rebounds and 4.0 assists per game on the week. He posted team-high totals of 21 points, eight rebounds and four assists on 9-of-13 shooting from the field in a 90-76 loss to Saint Vincent, then was a perfect 9-for-9 from the field in an 81-74 victory over W&J, posting 19 points, five boards and four assists. For the season, he leads the PAC in field goal percentage at 62.7% (96-of-153).

Also nominated was junior F **Nick Wilcox** of Bethany, freshman G **Mitch Marmelstein** of Grove City, sophomore F **Dillon Stith** of Saint Vincent, junior F **Phil Feinberg** of Thomas More, junior G **Zach Bellhy** of Washington & Jefferson, senior F **Lou Galante** of Waynesburg, and junior G **Doug Smith** of Westminster.



PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2011-12 - Week 8 Conference Notes

HALFWAY POINT: The 2011-12 PAC men's basketball schedule reaches its midway point following Wednesday's slate of games, with the second half of league action opening up on Saturday ... Thiel is in the driver's seat following the Tomcats' 69-57 road win over 2011 PAC champion Bethany Wednesday, with the Bison close behind in second place followed by Saint Vincent and Thomas More ... Bethany hosts Saint Vincent in a key PAC matchup this Wednesday night.

NEWS & NOTES: Junior G **Zach Bellhy** averaged 26.0 points, including 33 vs. Grove City (scoring the game-winning bucket with 4.3 seconds left) for 1-1 Washington & Jefferson ... Geneva junior F **Matt Lorello** shot 82 percent (18-of-22) from the field for the 1-1 Golden Tornadoes last week ... Bethany junior F **Nick Wilcox** averaged 20.5 points, 5.0 rebounds and 4.5 steals for the 1-1 Bison ... Junior SF **Phil Feinberg** averaged 17.0 ppg and 8.0 rpg last week for 1-1 Thomas More.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Grove City freshman G **Mitch Marmelstein** tied a school single-game record with six three-pointers in a loss to W&J ... Thiel junior F **Blair Rozenblad** posted his fifth double-double with 10 points and 15 boards at Bethany ... Saint Vincent sophomore F **Dillon Smith** averaged 17.0 ppg, 8.0 rpg and 3.0 bpg for the 2-0 Bearcats, who have won four straight ... Junior G **Doug Smith** averaged 17.5 ppg for 0-2 Westminster ... Senior F **Lou Galante** averaged 15.0 ppg and 5.0 rpg for 0-2 Waynesburg.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (14-2, 6-1 PAC)



The Bison lost a first place showdown with Thiel but bounced back to knock off Westminster Saturday ... The Tomcats took a 19-5 lead to start the game and Bethany shot just 30.3 percent, its lowest in more than 3 years, in dropping a 69-57 decision ... **Nick Wilcox** tallied 20 points and with 5 steals, moved into second place all-time at the school ... The Bison extended their winning streak to nine games against Westminster with a 76-66 triumph Saturday ... The Titans were as close as three in the closing minutes, but **James Barton** scored 15 of his 20 in the second half and BC went 6-for-6 from the foul line in the last 31 seconds to close out the win ... Wilcox had 21 points and four more steals to go to 183 in his career and **British Alexander** notched 16 points and 13 rebounds.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (4-11, 3-4 PAC)



After falling to Saint Vincent 90-76 last Wednesday, the Geneva men took a five-game losing streak into Saturday's match-up with Washington & Jefferson ... The Golden Tornadoes trailed only twice in the game and managed to hold off the Presidents down the stretch by converting 11-12 free throws in the final two minutes ... **David Phillips** scored a game high 24 points while **Matt Lorello** added 19 points on a perfect 9-9 shooting effort from the field ... The Golden Tornadoes put an end to their losing streak and vaulted into a fifth place tie in the Presidents' Athletic Conference ... Geneva is 4-11 overall and has a 3-4 record in conference play as it takes to the road for a pair of PAC games this week.

Grove City Wolverines (7-8, 3-4 PAC)



The young Grove City men's basketball team continues to be fired in the kiln of conference play as each of the Wolverines' last five PAC games have been decided by four points or less ... The Wolverines went 1-1 in a pair of tight battles last week, falling at home to W&J, 67-66, but rebounding for a 56-53 win at Waynesburg ... At Waynesburg, **Kris Verderber** led the way with 15 points and **Brett Matson** added 10 points, nine rebounds and five assists ... GCC held the Yellow Jackets to 35 percent shooting from the field ... Against W&J Wednesday, Grove City rallied from a 20-point deficit to take a 66-65 lead with 20 seconds left on **Nate Rambacher's** layup ... **Mitch Marmelstein** led the Wolverines with 23 points ... Matson had 14 points and **J.T. Schwartz** handed out six assists ... The Wolverines are 6-5 away from home.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (12-4, 5-2 PAC)



Saint Vincent used a balanced scoring attack to earn two league wins this week, at Geneva, 90-76, and against Thomas More, 86-71 ... Senior **Dennis Bassich**, junior **Chris Klimchock** and sophomores **Dillon Stith** and **Isaac Turner** both scored in double figures in each game, while senior **Tauvon Pettiford** reached the mark against Thomas More ... Bassich averaged 18.5 points to lead the way ... Stith averaged 17.0 points and 8.0 boards to help lead SVC ... The Bearcats shot the ball extremely well all week, against Geneva, SVC shot 60.0 percent from the floor and 52.6 percent against Thomas More.

Thiel Tomcats (10-4, 7-0 PAC)



The Tomcats avenged a loss to the Bison in the PAC championship last season, by defeating Bethany 69-57 in a battle between the two top teams in the conference Wednesday ... **Blair Rozenblad** led the Tomcats, notching his fifth double-double of the season, scoring 10 points and registering a season high 15 rebounds ... **Devon Adams** continued his hot streak shooting the rock, as he notched fifth straight game in double figures, registering 19 points ... Junior F **Chace McKinney** was the only other Tomcat in double figures as he scored 13 in the win.

Thomas More Saints (10-6, 5-3 PAC)



Thomas More closed out the first half of the PAC schedule by going 1-1 last week as it defeated Waynesburg, but fell to Saint Vincent ... Junior SF **Phil Feinberg** led the team in scoring and rebounding last week as he averaged 17.0 points per game and 8.0 rebounds per game ... For the season, Feinberg leads the team in scoring and rebounding as he averages 14.5 ppg., and 7.4 rpg ... Through 16 games, the Saint have a +6.5 scoring margin as they average 74.9 points per game and hold the opposition to 68.4 points per game ... Thomas More is shooting 46.2 percent from the field on 411-of-889 shooting from the floor.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (6-10, 2-5 PAC)



W&J split a pair of conference games last week ... Junior **Zach Bellhy** netted the game-winning shot with 4.3 seconds left against Grove City ... Bellhy scored a career-high 33 points on 11-of-17 shooting ... He also added eight rebounds and four steals ... Freshman **Andy Carter** was the only other President in double figures with 11 points ... W&J led by as many as 21 but had to withstand a late rally by the Wolverines ... W&J fell to Geneva 81-74 on Saturday ... The Presidents lost despite shooting 49 percent (25-51) from the field and 90 percent from the free throw line (18-20) ... Bellhy led W&J with 17 points, while Carter added 16 markers ... Freshman **Mike Resnik** contributed a career-best 15 off the bench.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (3-13, 0-7 PAC)



The Waynesburg University men's basketball team suffered a pair of heart-breaking PAC losses this past week ... The Yellow Jackets trailed by just two points at halftime before falling 70-62 at Thomas More ... The Jackets followed that up by grabbing a 50-48 lead over Grove City late in the second half at the Rudy Marisa Fieldhouse Saturday ... Unfortunately, Waynesburg couldn't hold on to the advantage and fell 56-53 as a last-second three-point try rimmed out ... Senior G **Larry Alexander** and senior F **Lou Galante** powered the Waynesburg offense by averaging 16 and 15 points per game, respectively ... Alexander poured in a game-high 21 points in Kentucky, before Galante piled up a contest-best 20 points on 8-of-11 shooting, including four three-pointers made against the Wolverines.

Westminster Titans (2-13, 1-6 PAC)



After a pair of losses last week, Westminster is on the verge of tying a team record with 10 consecutive losses (1925-26) ... The team's current nine straight losses stands tied for second (1998-99 and 1974-75) all-time in school history.
