TOMCATS ON TOP: The Thiel Tomcats are unbeaten in league play and in control at the top of the PAC standings as we near the midway point in the 2010-11 conference schedule ... The Tomcats took sole possession of first place with a win over Westminster Wednesday, coupled by a loss by Thomas More to Bethany ... Thiel then solidified its hold on the top spot Saturday with a three-point home win over the Saints, giving the Tomcats a 2 1/2 game conference lead.

NEWS & NOTES: Sophomore G Zach Bellhy and and senior G Paul Matthews scored 20 points apiece for Washington & Jefferson in a 41-point win over local rival Waynesburg ... Senior Rick Colick scored 30 points for Geneva in a home win over rival Westminster ... Sophomore G James Barton hit three three-pointers and tallied 16 points for Bethany in a road win at Thomas More ... Senior SG Aaron Miller averaged a team-high 17.5 ppg last week for 0-2 Thomas More.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Thiel sophomore G Blair Rozenblad averaged a double-double (14.5 ppg, 12.0 rpg) while posting his eighth of the season (15 pts., career-high 18 rebs.) vs. Westminster ... Junior G Dennis Bassich scored 16 points in both of Saint Vincent's wins ... Freshman G Evan Schell fired in a career-high 15 points for Grove City at Geneva ... Sophomore G Doug Smith averaged 15.0 ppg last week for 0-2 Westminster ... Junior F Lou Galante averaged 11.0 ppg last week for 0-2 Waynesburg.

The Bison went on the road in their only outing last week and knocked



off Thomas More 71-66, their second consecutive regular season win in Kentucky ... After suffering through a seven-minute scoreless stretch in the first half, Nick Wilcox scored seven consecutive points to close the half and give BC a 27-26 lead at the break ... The Saints took a 39-33 lead in the second half, but Bethany went on a 12-0 run sparked by a pair of threes from Dustin Opalka and capped by a thunderous dunk by British Alexander to take the lead for good ... The Bison lead grew to 12 with a minute to go and they held off a late TMC charge for the win ... Wilcox posted 19 points and 13 boards and James Barton hit three treys and tallied 16.

Rich Colick, who was held to a career low two points in the 71-59 win over Grove City Wednesday, made up for lost time with a 30 point effort on 12-17 shooting from the field ... Colick got help from Lambros Svingos, who scored 19 points and grabbed eight rebounds ... To make up for Colick's slow night Wednesday, the duo of David Phillips and Bryan Hill combined for 37 points and eight three-point field goals ... Geneva moved to 7-1 on its home floor this season and will now take its act on the road to Waynesburg and Washington & Jefferson this

Grove City Wolverines (4-11, 1-5 PAC)

The new calendar year has not been kind to the Wolverines,

who dropped a pair of games last week in PAC play ... Wednesday at Geneva, freshman G Evan Schell fired in a career-high 15 points, including three three-point goals ... Brett Matson added nine points and six assists ... Bryn Moran pulled in a career-high eight rebounds ... Saturday vs. Saint Vincent, Grove City led 25-20 at intermission but the Wolverines turned over the ball 13 times in the second half ... Junior C Kris Verderber poured in 15 points, while Matson added 12 points and seven rebounds ... Schell made his first collegiate start Saturday ... Nine different players have started for the Wolverines this year ... Grove City continues to boast the conference's top scoring defense (62.7) and top field goal percentage defense (38.7 percent against).

Saint Vincent Bearcats (11-5, 4-2 PAC)

The Bearcats stretched their winning streak to four games,

with PAC victories over Waynesburg and Grove City ... In Wednesday's win over the Yellow Jackets, SVC recovered from a sluggish first half to out-score Waynesburg 45-22 over the second half, shooting 62 percent in the process ... BJ McGill led a trio of doublefigure scorers with 17 points, while Dennis Bassich added 16 and Armani Fountain 12 ... SVC out-rebounded Waynesburg 44-32, and forced 22 'Jacket turnovers ... The story was the same Saturday at Grove City, as SVC was down 25-20 at halftime before out-scoring the Wolverines 38-23 over the final 20 minutes ... Bassich and McGill again led the offensive charge, with the former scoring 16 points, including 12 in the second half, and the latter 14.

Thiel **Tomcats** (12-4, 7-0 PAC)

Thiel took over sole possession of first place in the PAC

with victories last week versus Westminster and Thomas More, extending the Tomcat win streak to five games ... Thiel defeated the Titans of Westminster 77-64 ... Sophomore G Blair Rozenblad led the Tomcats with his eighth double double of the season as he scored 15 points and added a career-high 18 rebounds ... Three other Tomcats scored in double figures: senior F Lance Randall (15), sophomore Ladell Trotty (16), and senior G Devon Adams (10) ... Thiel then took a twogame lead in the PAC with a win over second place Thomas More, 55-52 ... Rozenblad and Randall were the only two Tomcats in double figures as they had 14 points and 10 points, respectively ... The TC defense held Thomas More to 36 percent shooting in the second half.

Thomas More Saints (8-8, 4-2 PAC)

Thomas More fell to Bethany and Thiel last

week in PAC games ... Three Saints averaged in double-figure scoring last week as senior SG Aaron Miller averaged 17.5 points per game, senior SG Brian Muse averaged 14.5 ppg., and junior C Colt Stafford averaged 12.0 ppg., including a career-high 18 points in the Saints' game at Thiel on Saturday ... Miller led the team on the boards last week as he averaged 8.5 rebounds per game, while freshman PG Spencer Berlekamp led the team in assists with seven and Muse led the team in blocks with three ... For the season the Saints are led in scoring and rebounding by Miller, who is averaging 15.9 points per game and 7.5 rebounds per game.

Washington & Jefferson **Presidents** (6-10, 3-3 PAC)



W&J won its only game of the week, crushing Waynesburg 86-45 on Saturday ... Sopho-

more G Zach Bellhy scored 20 points on 8of-14 shooting and added five steals and three assists ... Senior G Paul Matthews scored 20 points and pulled down seven rebounds ... Senior G Brian Felker narrowly missed a double-double, dropping in 16 points and grabbing nine rebounds ... The Presidents held the Yellow Jackets to 29.1 percent shooting, W&J's lowest percentage allowed all season ... Eleven different players scored for the Presidents and W&J held a commanding 54-28 edge on the glass ... The 41-point win was the largest victory for W&J since a 90-45 win over Thiel on Jan. 31, 1981 ... The win extended the Presidents' winning streak over Waynesburg to 13 games.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (5-11, 2-5 PAC)



It was a rough week for the Waynesburg University men's basketball team, which went 0-2 against PAC opponents Saint Vincent and Washington & Jefferson ... Though his team struggled, junior F Lou Galante had a solid two games off the bench ... He averaged a team-high 11 points and 3.5 rebounds per game ... Junior F Jeff Young averaged nine points per contest, while another junior F, James Allenby, pulled down a team-best 5.5 rebounds per game.

Westminster **Titans** (3-13, 0-6 PAC)

midst of a five-game losing streak and a 16game road losing streak after two losses last week at first-place Thiel, 77-64, Wednesday and at Geneva, 93-80, Saturday ... Sophomore G Doug Smith led the Titans with 15.0 points per game including 17 points at Thiel and 13 points off the bench at Geneva ... Freshman G Anthony Thomas came back from a two-game absence from injury and averaged 14.0 points last week including 16 points, a team-high five rebounds and a team-best fiveassists at Thiel ... Freshman G Christian Shea led the Titans with 14 points at Geneva, including 4-8 shooting from 3-point range ... Westminster shot well from 3-point range at 33.3 percent (22-66), but overall from the floor Geneva and Thiel outshot the Titans 56.4 percent (62-110) to 37.4 percent (52-139).
