Murray earned his second PAC weekly honor in the past three weeks by averaging 19.5 points, 11.0 re-

bounds, 4.0 steals, 3.5 assists and 2.0 blocks - all team-highs - in the Titans' PAC wins over Thiel (80-63) and Bethany (80-78). He scored 11 of the team's final 13 points to finish with 29 points and 14 rebounds in the win over the Bison, which lifted Westminster into a first-place tie with Thomas More.

Also nominated was senior F Petre Petkovski of Bethany, senior G Joe McCoy of Grove City, sophomore W Daniel McKeehan of Thomas More, senior F Wahab Owolabi of Washington & Jefferson, and senior G Dan Happe of Waynesburg.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2008-09 - Week 7 Conference Notes

JUMBLE AT THE TOP: The PAC standings remain completely jumbled at the top through games of January 18, as five of the seven schools eligible for the 2009 PAC title are tied in the loss column with two conference defeats apiece. Currently, Thomas More and Westminster are tied for the league lead, each with a 4-2 PAC mark, followed by Bethany, Grove City and Washington & Jefferson each a half-game behind at 3-2 in league play as we near the halfway point in the PAC schedule.

WHO'S HOT: Saint Vincent won its 22nd consecutive home game with an 81-70 win over Grove City Saturday ... W&J senior F Wahab Owolabi averaged a double-double (14.5 ppg, 10.0 rpg) for the 2-0 Presidents ... Sophomore W Daniel McKeehan of Thomas More posted 18 points and eight rebounds in a 92-74 PAC win over Geneva ... Senior F Petre Petkovski averaged 17.5 points and 7.0 rebounds per game for 1-1 Bethany ... Senior G Joe McCoy averaged 15.0 ppg for 1-1 Grove City.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Westminster and Geneva face off for the 200th time in history Wednesday, with the Titans leading the series 116-83 ... The brother combination of Justin and Emilio Nardi combined for 36 points for Geneva in an 88-71 PAC victory at Thiel ... Waynesburg senior G Dan Happe averaged 13.0 points and 4.5 rebounds per game for the 0-2 Yellow Jackets last week ... Thiel went 0-2 against PAC competition last week and has now dropped 12 straight contests.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (9-7, 3-2 PAC)

The Bison went 1-1 overall last week, battering Franciscan 93-56



before dropping an 80-78 nail-biter at Westminster ... BC shot a blistering 60 percent (18-30) in the first half to build a 50-25 halftime lead and all 12 players who saw time scored by the end of the night ... Joe Testa, Dakota Matz and Lance Beckwith all had 12 in the victory ... Bethany led Westminster 70-53 midway through the second half, but scored just eight points the rest of the way as they fell out of first place in the PAC ... Petre Petkovski had a career-high 27 points and grabbed 10 rebounds for his first career double-double and Tobi Akinsola went 6-for-7 from the floor for a career-high 13 markers.

Geneva Golden **Tornadoes** (4-11)

The GTs finally picked up their first road victory GOLDEN TORNADOES of the season after start-



ing the season with eight consecutive losses away from Metheny Fieldhouse ... Geneva got an 88-71 decision at Thiel Saturday on the strength of outstanding long distance shooting ... Geneva was 11-of-21 from three-point range, including eight treys in the first half ... Prior to that victory, Geneva had dropped games to Penn State-Beaver and Thomas More earlier in the week ... The loss to PS-B was the first in eight meetings ... Geneva watched a 16-point second half lead evaporate against the Lions in the loss ... Thomas More opened up a six-point halftime lead to pull away in the final 20 minutes ... Brandon Harvey was 4-of-7 from three-point range and finished the game with 16 point.

Grove City Wolverines (8-6, 3-2 PAC)

Grove City is among five teams in a battle royal for first place in

the PAC with a 3-2 record ... Wednesday, the Wolverines charged past Waynesburg 80-68 ... It is Grove City's fifth straight win over Waynesburg ... Joe McCoy paced GCC with 17 points while Ryan Gibson added a dozen ... Andy O'Keefe and Kris Verderber both had 11 points ... O'Keefe corralled 12 rebounds ... Grove City went 30-of-43 at the foul line ... Saturday, McCoy popped in 13 points in an 81-70 setback at Saint Vincent ... Freshman G Brett Matson matched a career high with 10 points ... Grove City shot 53 percent (27-of-51) from the field, but turned the ball over 21 times ... A dozen GCC players scored in the game ... The Wolverines conclude the first half of the PAC schedule Wednesday night against Mercer County rival Thiel.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (13-3)

The Bearcats split a pair of games against PAC foes on

the week ... On Wednesday, SVC shot a season-low 29 percent from the field, connecting on just four of 34 tries from behind the arc, in a 70-59 loss at W&J ... Joey Butler led the Bearcats with 16 points, while Mike Medved notched his sixth double-double of the year with 14 points and 11 rebounds, while adding a pair of blocks ... The Bearcats regrouped with an 81-70 home win over Grove City on Saturday, Saint Vincent's 22nd straight victory at home ... All five starters scored in double-figures, led by Butler's 18 points and Billy Bains' 13 ... Butler also added seven assists and three steals ... SVC connected on a season-high 10 three-pointers, and owned a 37-27 edge in re-

Thiel **Tomcats** (1-14, 0-5 PAC)

Westminster never trailed as it shot its way to an 80-

63 PAC victory over Thiel Wednesday ... The host Titans shot 50 percent from the field ... Senior PG Brandon Mirizio paced Thiel with 16 points, while junior transfer Sean Devinney continued his recent hot streak with an 11point performance... Saturday, Geneva's Justin and Emilio Nardi teamed up for 36 points, as the Golden Tornadoes dropped Thiel 88-71 ... Thiel operated efficiently on offense, shooting close to 60 percent from the floor, including a 13-for-20 second half ... Four Tomcats reached double figures in scoring, paced by Devinney who racked up 18 ... Cory Chaffee tallied 16, while Keebo Dowe and Mirizio registered 14 and 12, respectively... Devinney's 18 represented a season-high and his fourthconsecutive double-figure scoring game.

Thomas More Saints (9-6, 4-2 PAC)

Thomas More defeated Geneva, 92-74, in its

only game last week ... Sophomore wing Daniel McKeehan scored a game-high 18 points to lead four Saints in double-figures Also scoring in double figures was senior forward Mark Tinklenberg and sophomore guard Kurt Bovard with 14 points each and sophomore wing Eddie Brown with 10 points ... McKeehan and Tinklenberg each had eight rebounds to lead the Saints on the boards ... McKeehan is leading the Saints in scoring through the first 15 games with 12.5 points per game, and he and Tinklenberg lead the team on the boards as they both average 4.9 rebounds per game.

Washington & Jefferson **Presidents** (11-5, 3-2 PAC)



W&J men's basketball has won six of its last seven games, including a 78-60 victory over

Waynesburg Saturday to get above the .500 mark in PAC play ... The Presidents currently sit in a three-way tie for third place in the PAC with Bethany and Grove City, and sit just a half a game outside of first-place ... W&J senior post players, Josip Lucic-Jozak and Wahab Owolabi have turned it on as of late, averaging 21.5 ppg and 15.8 ppg, respectively, during the Presidents' current four-game win streak ... The Presidents currently sit atop the PAC in two statistical categories, including free throw percentage (.729) and rebounding margin (+5.8) ... W&J returns to action Wednesday evening, traveling to PAC rival Bethany for a 8 p.m. tip-off in Hummel Field House.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (5-10, 2-4 PAC)



Waynesburg dropped a pair of PAC contests this past week ... The first loss was an 80-68 decision at Grove City on Wednesday, followed by a 78-60 home defeat at the hands of Washington & Jefferson Saturday ... Against the Wolverines, the Jackets got an outstanding effort from Jason Clark ... The senior guard poured in a game-high 18 points on 7-of-19 shooting ... Fellow senior G Dan Happe chipped in 16 points, while shooting 6of-11 from the floor and 4-of-8 from three-point range ... Sophomore F Jeff Young recorded his first collegiate double-double with 10 points and 14 rebounds ... Against the Presidents, Waynesburg was led by senior G Zack Engel, who dropped in a team-best 13 points.

Westminster **Titans** (4-12, 4-2 PAC)



Westminster won a pair of PAC home games last week, beating Thiel, 80-63, on Wednesday and Bethany, 80-78, in a thriller Saturday ... The Titans move into a first-place tie with Thomas More, a team they beat earlier this year ... Junior Ryne Murray averaged 19.5 points, 11.0 rebounds, 4.0 steals, 3.5 assists, and 2.0 blocks - all team highs - in the two wins last week. Murray scored 11 of the team's final 13 points to finish with 29 points and 14 rebounds in the win over Bethany, including the go-ahead 3-pointer after Westminster went on a 14-0 run late in the second half ... Murray scored nine points vs. Thiel, but it was freshman Mike Pratkanis with his career-high 17 points and junior Steve Bielich and his 16 points leading Westminster. Bielich averaged 16.5 points, while senior G David Richards averaged 10.5 points.
