

Also nominated was senior F Joe Testa of Bethany, sophomore G Brett Matson of Grove City, junior G Brian Felker of Washington & Jefferson, sophomore G Ben Altmeyer of Waynesburg, and senior F Ryne Murray of Westminster.

#### PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2009-10 - Week 9 Conference Notes

PAC NEARS HALFWAY POINT: The midway point of the 2009-10 PAC men's basketball season comes at the conclusion of Wednesday's games ... After losing its PAC opener to Grove City in December, defending conference champion Thomas More has rolled off five consecutive league wins to take over first place in the PAC standings ... Three of the Saint wins were by three points or less ... TMC hosts Grove City Saturday to open the second half of the league schedule.

NEWS & NOTES: Both the W&J men's and women's basketball teams were ranked fourth in the nation in NCAA D-III in free throw percentage last week ... Geneva has won four straight games, as Rich Colick averaged 15.5 ppg in a pair of GT wins last week ... Thiel freshman Blair Rozenblad averaged 26.0 ppg in two Tomcat losses ... Saint Vincent junior G BJ McGill averaged 25.0 points per game in a pair of losses ... Junior F Aaron Miller averaged 16.0 ppg last week for 2-0 Thomas More.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Senior F Ryne Murray averaged 14.5 ppg and 5.0 rpg for 1-1 Westminster ... Sophomore G Brett Matson averaged 13.5 ppg, 6.5 rpg and 4.0 apg for 1-1 Grove City ... Senior F Joe Testa posted 22 points and eight rebounds for Bethany in a 93-60 non-league win at Franciscan ... Sophomore G Ben Altmeyer scored 13 points to help Waynesburg snap a four-game skid with a 58-56 win over Saint Vincent.

#### Bethany Bison (10-5, 3-2 PAC)

Bethany bounced back from a crushing loss at the buzzer to Thomas



More by hammering Franciscan on the road ... The Bison led Thomas More by 21 points early in the second half, but the Saints slowly climbed back in the game and took their only lead when **Daniel McKeehan** scored on a putback as time expired ... **Joe Testa** scored a careerhigh 26 and grabbed nine rebounds in the defeat ... Testa again led the way in the 93-60 rout over Franciscan with 22 points and 8 boards, as BC shot 58 percent (35-of-60) in the game ... Others reaching double digits included **Jay Lyonett** with 12 and freshmen **James Barton** (11) and **Brady Pacific** (10) both setting career-highs.

#### Geneva Golden Tornadoes (9-7)

The streaking Golden
Tornadoes continued to GOLDEN TORNADOES
roll with a pair of victo-

ries over rivals Grove City and Westminster .. Geneva is riding its second four-game win streak of the season, sandwiched around a four-game slide in December and early January ... The GTs will seek their first five-game win streak since 2005 when they host Waynesburg on Wednesday ... Geneva used a lock-down defense to pick up its first victory in six tries against Grove City last Wednesday ... The Golden Tornadoes held off the Wolverines' late charge thanks to a 13-point, 13-rebound effort from Rich Colick ... Saturday afternoon, the GTs made 11 three-point field goals and were clicking on all cylinders in a 75-57 victory over Westminster to erase last year's season sweep by the Titans.

#### Grove City Wolverines (9-7, 3-2 PAC)

Grove City broke out of a monthlong offensive funk Saturday

night in a 79-66 win at Saint Vincent ... The Wolverines had not surpassed 65 points since December 15 ... Andy O'Keefe paced Grove City with 16 points while Brett Matson (13), Joe McCoy (11) and Drew Vandermeer (11) also reached double figures ... The Wolverines never trailed in the game ... It's the first time since a 75-68 win over Thiel January 21, 2008 that Grove City did not trail in a game ... O'Keefe entered the week as the nation's leader in field goal percentage ... Grove City opened the week with a 53-50 home setback against Geneva ... Matson led Grove City with 14 points while O'Keefe and Cody Fleeger both had 11 points ... It marked the third straight home game that Grove City has held a foe to 54 points or fewer.

#### Saint Vincent Bearcats (5-11)

The Bearcats saw their losing streak reach four, with

losses on the week to Waynesburg (Wed) and Grove City (Sat) ... In Wednesday's 58-56 setback to the Yellow Jackets, SVC shot just 35 percent from the field, including a 3-for-16 showing from behind the three-point line ... BJ McGill led all scorers with 26 points, adding game-highs of nine rebounds and three steals. while Henry Utku grabbed eight boards ... Saturday, the Bearcats fell 79-66 to Grove City, despite shooting a season-high 51 percent from the floor ... McGill again led both sides on the scoresheet, with 24 points along with six assists, while Stephon Berry scored a career-high 13 ... SVC was unable to overcome Grove City's 37-23 advantage on the glass, while the Wolverines also scored 22 points off of 18 Bearcat turnovers.

#### Thiel Tomcats (6-9, 2-4 PAC)

Thiel lost two games by a combined five points last

week to drop to 6-9 overall and 2-4 in the PAC ... On Wednesday, Westminster College erased an early double-digit deficit to down the Thiel College men , 88-86, at Buzz Ridl Gymnasium ... Blair Rozenblad led Thiel with 27 points and 12 rebounds to earn his third double-double of the season... Junior Devon Adams scored 26 points to go along with a game-high six assists ... On Saturday, Thiel again fell just short of tasting victory, this time against defending PAC champion Thomas More, 91-88 ... Rozenblad led the Tomcats with 25 points to go along with 11 rebounds ... Thiel has now lost five games by five points or fewer this season.

#### Thomas More Saints (12-4, 5-1 PAC)

Thomas More extended its season-high winning

streak to six games with a pair of PAC wins last week ... The Saints defeated Bethany, 90-88, on the road and then returned to Kentucky to defeat Thiel, 91-88 ... Senior PF Daniel McKeehan averaged 25.0 points and 5.5 rebounds per game and had 10 steals and six assists, as he made the game-winning putback at the buzzer against Bethany and scored a career-high 33 points in the win over Thiel ... Two other Saints averaged in double-figure scoring last week as junior forward Aaron Miller averaged 16.0 ppg., and junior center Brian Muse averaged 11.5 ppg. ... For the season the Saints are shooting 46.3 percent from the field on 495-of-1,068 shooting and have PAC-best 211 steals ... McKeehan leads the team in scoring with 14.8 ppg.

#### Washington & Jefferson Presidents (8-8, 4-1 PAC)



W&J earned a hard-fought 54-50 victory against local rival Waynesburg Saturday ... Se-

nior PG Matt Drakeley, who finished the game with 11 points, sealed the victory for the Presidents after converting a three-point play with 1:11 remaining ... The Presidents, who trail league-leading Thomas More (5-1) by a half a game in the PAC standings, earned the win despite shooting a season-low 29 percent (14of-48) from the field ... W&J continues to lead the PAC in two statistical categories, including free throw percentage (79 percent) and assist/turnover ratio (0.87) ... Drakeley is the top free throw shooter in the conference (63-of-74; 85%), while senior Albert Varacallo (34of-41; 83%) is third, and juniors Brian Felker (69-of-85; 81%) and Paul Matthews (47-of-58; 81%) are fifth and sixth, respectively.

#### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (2-12, 0-6 PAC)



The Waynesburg men's

basketball team came a few points shy of a two-game sweep this past ... After winning a thrilling 58-56 contest against Saint Vincent, the Jackets looked poised to upset Washington & Jefferson, which sits a half game out of first place in the PAC ... Unfortunately, the Yellow Jackets lost a second-half lead to the Presidents and couldn't regain it as time slipped away ... During the Jackets' victory over Saint Vincent, freshman PG Ben Altmeyer tallied a team-high 13 points ... Over the week, he tied for the team lead in points per game (9.0) and dished out a team-best 3.5 assists per contest.

#### Westminster Titans (5-11, 2-3 PAC)



Westminster split a pair

of home games last week, beating Thiel, 88-86, on Wednesday before losing to Geneva, 75-57, on Saturday ... Only the game vs. Thiel counted toward the PAC standings, as the Tomcats have now lost seven straight in New Wilmington dating back to 2003 ... Four Titans averaged double figures last week, led by senior F Ryne Murray with 14.5 per game, including 22 in the win over Thiel ... Murray's seven points vs. Geneva marked the third-lowest scoring output of his 72-game collegiate career ... Also in the win over Thiel, junior G Max Spinner bucketed 16 points, followed by senior F Steve Bielich with 12 and sophomore F Steve Cress with 12 ... Sophomore F Rob Briggs was the lone Titan in double figures in the loss to Geneva with 12 points and six rebounds.
