PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

GREG ROSATELLIWestminster College

5-10 Senior Guard Clinton, Pa. Hopewell H.S.

Rosatelli led Westminster to a 1-1 week by averaging 21.0 points, 7.0 assists, 5.0 rebounds and 5.0 steals per game. He



recorded team-high totals of 19 points, seven assists and four steals in a 101-91 PAC loss to Grove City. Rosatelli then led the Titans to a 96-82 win at conference leader Bethany (breaking the Bison's PAC-record 29-game league winning streak) by posting a career-high 23 points along with eight rebounds, seven assists and six steals.

Also nominated was senior F **James Wallace** of Bethany, sophomore G **Ryan Gibson** of Grove City, sophomore F **Wahab Owolabi** of Washington & Jefferson, and senior G **Beau Wilson** of Waynesburg.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES



Bethany Bison

The Bison ran their PAC-record conference win streak to 29 games with a win at Waynesburg but then had it snapped Saturday with a 96-82 loss to visiting Westminster ... The 102-80 victory over Waynesburg saw the Bison drill 11

three-pointers in the first half en route to a 63-34 halftime lead ... James Wallace totaled 26 points, while Brody Jackson and Ryan Besancon each had 15 and Chris Stephens dropped in 14 in a win that made Stephens and Wallace the winningest class in Bethany history (77-23) ... Against the Titans, Westminster became the first PAC team since W&J on Jan. 19, 2005 to knock off BC ... Wallace again led the Bison with 26 points and Besancon notched his fourth double-double of the year with 12 points and 10 boards.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City moved over the .500 mark for the first time this year after a 3-0 week, including a pair of hard-fought road wins in PAC play ... **Mark Smith**'s jumper at the buzzer gave Grove City a 49-48 win at Thomas More Sat-

urday for the Wolverines' fourth straight win ... It is the first time since Feb. 3, 1998 that Grove City scored less than 50 points in a win (48-47 vs. W&J) ... **Ryan Gibson** paced the Wolverines with a dozen points ... Wednesday, the Wolverines rolled to a 101-91 win over Westminster for their first win in New Wilmington in four years ... Gibson had 24 points and 11 assists while **Ryan Gerber** rifled in 23 ... Grove City shot 76 percent (16 of 21) in the second half ... Monday, Grove City earned a 68-58 win over Penn State Beaver.



Thiel Tomcats

Thiel dropped a pair of PAC contests last week, falling Wednesday to Saint Vincent, 72-55, before dropping a 82-74 decision Saturday at W&J ... Against Saint Vincent, freshman G Cory Chafee led the Tomcats with 16 points and four rebounds ... Junior F Joe Herrmann added 14

points and four rebounds ... Against W&J, the Tomcats were paced by sophomore G **Brandon Mirizio**'s career-high 24 points, including 17 in the first half ... Chafee added 15 points while Herrmann chipped in with 14 points and a game-high 11 rebounds ... Freshman F **Greg Hawes** finished with 11 points, four rebounds and four blocks ... Thiel shot 54.2 percent (26-48) from the field and held a 30-25 rebound margin, but W&J converted 34-of-43 free throws.



Thomas More Saints

Thomas More came to within seconds of winning its season straight home contest, but a Grove City buzzer beater

ended those chances as the Saints dropped matchups at W&J (69-53) and at home against the Wolverines (49-48) ... Freshman **Aaron Miller**, in his second career start, tied his career-high of 14 points ... Miller finished the week averaging 10.5 points and 2.5 rebounds ... In the loss to the Presidents, freshman **Romell Salone** scored a career-high 12 points before leaving with an injury ... Sophomore **Matt Tierney** led the team with 4.5 boards per game this week.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J has won five of its last six games, including a pair of PAC contests last week ... Wednesday, sophomore F **Wahab Owolabi** made all seven of his field goal attempts and posted his fourth double-double of the season with 17 points and 14 rebounds in a 69-53 win over Thomas More ... Senior G **Brandon Studer** dropped in four

three-pointers and finished with 17 points, while classmate **Jon Koch** added 16 points and four assists ... Sophomore C **Josip Lucic-Jozak** led four Presidents in double figures Saturday with 19 markers ... W&J canned 34-of-43 free throw attempts and shot 47 percent from the floor ... Koch nailed 10-of-12 foul shots en route to 18 points, while Studer and Owolabi collected 14 and 11 points, respectively ... W&J improved its record to 6-3 at home.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets continued their busy schedule, playing their seventh game in 11 days Saturday at Saint Vincent ... Waynesburg was 1-3 last week, including losses to Bethany and Saint Vincent ... Against Hood

Monday, senior G **Beau Wilson** was the only WC player in double-figures with a season-high 26 points ... The four-year starter tied his career-best of seven steals in the loss and also added five rebounds ... The Yellow Jackets could not slow the hot-shooting Bison Wednesday, as Bethany shot over 50 percent and made 11 first-half treys ... Waynesburg topped Franciscan Friday when four players scored in double figures, including 21 from Wilson ... In the loss against the Bearcats, Wilson and senior F **Jeff Nero** each tallied 22 points, with Nero adding a team-high eight boards.



Westminster Titans

Westminster went 1-1 last week and is currently 1/2 game out of first place behind Bethany ... The Titans lost at home to last-place Grove City, 101-91, before beating first-place Bethany on the road, 96-82 ... The difference was the Titans long-range shooting: just 29.3 percent (12-of-41) from three-point range against GCC and a season-high 55.2 percent (16-of-29) from behind the arc at Bethany ... Senior G **Nick Adams** had the hot hand vs. the Bison with a career-high 27 points ... Adams shot 8-of-11 from the floor, including a siz-

zling 6-of-8 from three-point range ... Senior G **Greg Rosatelli** set a new career-high with 23 points. to go with seven assists, a season-high six steals and eight rebounds ... Rosatelli led the Titans with 19 points against GCC, while junior F **Chauncey Whitlow** scored 18.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

Senior **Javille Brooks** was named to the ECAC Division II Honor Roll for the week ending January 14 ... He continued his hot streak this week, averaging 19.3 points and 9.6 rebounds for the week, including 25 points and 13 boards against Waynesburg ... **Billy Bains** scored 18

points in the win against PSU-Dubois, all in the second half ... He followed it up with 19 points in the victory against Thiel ... **Roscoe Biggers** dished out 11 assists in the win over Waynesburg ... Also against Waynesburg, **Jonny Hasson** had 15 points on 5-of-7 shooting from outside the arc ... **Marc Duncan** had 12 steals in the three Bearcat games last week.

The Bison are on the road for a pair of games this week, heading to Saint Vincent Wednesday before starting round two of PAC play Saturday at Thiel ... The match-up with the Bearcats will be the seventh all-time between the schools, with the series being tied 3-3, and the first game since the 1949-50 season ... In their second game of the week, BC will be trying to win their seventh straight over Thiel and extend their lead in the series to 99-41 ... The Bison held on for a 78-76 victory over the Tomcats Dec. 9 behind 20 points and 11 rebounds from **Ryan Besancon**.

W&J and Grove City meet for the 96th time

Wednesday, with the Wolverines leading the series 49-46 ... The Wolverines have dominated the series with W&J of late, winning 14 of the last 16 meetings, including 13-of-14 at the GCC Arena ... Grove City has claimed the past 13 regular-season meetings at GCC, as W&J's lone win came in the semifinals of the 2005 PAC Tournament ... Westminster holds a 46-19 edge in the all-time series with the Presidents ... Since Westminster joined the PAC seven seasons ago, the Titans own a 10-4 advantage against W&J.

with W&J but lost (108-86) during its last trip to Washington ... In the last meeting, the Titans won 88-73 on Dec. 9 behind **Dom Joseph**'s 26 points ... **Chauncey Whitlow** scored a career-high 28 points in a Feb. 4, 2006, game the Titans won 107-103.
