Mabery led the Bison to a pair of double-digit PAC wins by averaging 20.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 2.0 steals per game, including going a perfect 13-for-13 at the free throw line. He tallied a game-high 27 points (including 9-for-9 at the line and 4-for-6 from three-point range) as Bethany solidified its hold on second place with a 77-63 home win over Saint Vincent. Mabery then tallied 14 points, six boards and three assists in a 78-57 home Bison win over Grove City.

Also nominated was sophomore F **Dillon Stith** of Saint Vincent, junior G **Blair Rozenblad** of Thiel, junior SF **Phil Feinberg** of Thomas More, junior PG **Ben Altmeyer** of Waynesburg, and junior G **Doug Smith** of Westminster.



PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2011-12 - Week 9 Conference Notes

SECOND HALF UNDERWAY: The second half of the 2011-12 PAC men's basketball schedule opened on Saturday following the first half conclusion on Wednesday ... Thiel remains in the driver's seat, as the unbeaten Tomcats won their 17th straight regular season home game Saturday vs. Waynesburg ... Bethany, at 16-2 overall, strengthened its hold on second place with a home win over third place Saint Vincent, knocking the Bearcats into a third-place tie with Thomas More.

NEWS & NOTES: Making his first start in two years due to injury, Waynesburg junior PG **Ben Altmeyer** posted 25 points and five boards as WU posted its first PAC win at W&J ... Westminster junior G **Doug Smith** scored 29 points on seven treys (both career-highs) in Westminster's OT win over Geneva ... Junior F **Blair Rozenblad** averaged a double-double with 12.5 ppg and 14.0 rpg for 2-0 Thiel ... **James Barton** bucketed a game-high 20 points on four three-pointers for Bethany vs. Grove City.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Sophomore F **Dillon Stith** averaged 18.5 ppg and 5.5 rpg for 1-1 Saint Vincent, including a career-high 24 at Bethany ... Junior SF **Phil Feinberg** averaged 17.5 points and 7.5 rebounds per game for 1-1 Thomas More ... **David Phillips** bucketed 29 points for Geneva in a loss at Thomas More ... **Christian Durbin** averaged 11.5 ppg for 0-2 Grove City ... Freshman G **Andy Carter** posted 19 points and six boards for Washington & Jefferson in a loss to Waynesburg.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (16-2, 8-1 PAC)



Bethany won a pair of home PAC games last week to remain in second place in the conference standings ... The Bison outscored Saint Vincent 25-12 over the final seven minutes to pull away for a 77-63 victory Wednesday ... **Reece Mabery** was 9-for-9 from the foul line and finished with a game-high 27 points, while **British Alexander** totaled 15 points, eight rebounds and four blocks ... On Saturday, BC forced 19 Grove City turnovers and held the Wolverines to 33 percent shooting in a 78-57 victory ... **James Barton** connected on four three-pointers and scored a game-high 20 and was joined in double digits by **Nick Wilcox** (15) - who also had eight rebounds and five steals - Mabery (14) and Alexander (11).

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (4-13, 3-6 PAC)



After getting back on track with a victory against W&J a week ago Saturday, the Geneva College men's basketball dropped a pair of PAC road decisions this past week ... The week opened with a heart-breaking 82-81 overtime loss to Westminster where newly acquired **F Keynon Jackson** finished with 19 points, including the final 11 points of regulation time ... **David Phillips** scored 29 points against Thomas More on Saturday but it wasn't enough to slow down the Saints in a 91-77 final ... The Golden Tornadoes begin the new week tied for sixth in the PAC with a 3-6 conference record and a mark of 4-13 overall ... They will return home on Wednesday to face Bethany before a road date with Waynesburg Saturday.

Grove City Wolverines (7-10, 3-6 PAC)



Grove City men's basketball team 0-2 against the conference pacesetters last week ... Wednesday night, the Wolverines concluded the first half of the PAC schedule with a 56-49 setback against Thiel ... GCC trailed just 49-47 with two minutes left ... **Brett Matson** led all scorers with 19 points ... The Wolverines held Thiel to 34 percent (19-of-56) shooting from the field ... **Christian Durbin** and **Kris Verderber** both had nine points ... Saturday at Bethany, Grove City dropped a 78-57 decision to the Bison to open the second half ... Durbin led Grove City with 14 points ... Verderber and **J.T. Schwartz** both posted 10 points ... Matson had five rebounds and four assists ... Grove City hosts Thomas More and Saint Vincent this week in conference play ... Four of Grove City's next six games are in the GCC Arena.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (13-5, 6-3 PAC)



SVC split two games last week, dropping a 77-63 decision at Bethany Wednesday before rebounding with a 79-47 victory over Westminster at home Saturday ... At Bethany, sophomore **F Dillon Stith** set a career-high with 24 points on 8-of-12 shooting and also pulled down eight boards and recorded two blocks ... Senior **G Tavoun Pettiford** and sophomore **G Isaac Turner** posted 12 points each, while junior **G Chris Klimchock** dished out six assists in the loss ... For the first time in his career with SVC, senior **G Dennis Bassich** was held scoreless by the Bison defense ... Saturday, Stith led the team with 13 points while Klimchock tallied 12 markers and game-highs of six assists and three steals ... Bassich and freshman **F Sean Kett** added 10 points each off the bench against Westminster.

Thiel Tomcats (12-4, 9-0 PAC)



Thiel stretched their current winning streak to five games and their regular season home win streak to 17 games with wins at Grove City (56-49) and at home against Waynesburg (66-48) ... In the contest against the Wolverines, junior **F Austin Forbes** (12 points) and freshman **G Kamran McKaskill** (11 points) were the only Tomcats to notch double figures ... However, junior **F Ladell Trotty** had his most productive game on the glass as he pulled down 19 rebounds, the most by a Thiel player since the 1989-90 season ... In the second game of the week, the Tomcats defeated the Yellow Jackets 66-48 ... For the first time since February 9, 2011, the Tomcats held their opponent without a single player in double figures ... **Blair Rozenblad** posted his sixth double-double of the season with 16 points and 17 rebounds.

Thomas More Saints (11-7, 6-3 PAC)



Thomas More went 1-1 last week as it fell to Wilmington in a non-conference game and then defeated Geneva to open the second half of its PAC schedule ... Junior SF **Phil Feinberg** led the team in scoring and rebounding last week as he averaged 17.5 points per game and 7.5 rebounds per game ... Four other Saints averaged in double-figure scoring as senior **C Colt Stafford** averaged 15.5 ppg., senior SG **Todd Krohman** averaged 14.0 ppg., freshman SF **Drew Mumford** averaged 11.5 ppg., and senior PG **Daniel Whelan** averaged 11.0 ppg. ... For the season, Feinberg leads the team in scoring and rebounding as he averages 14.8 ppg., and 7.4 rpg ... Through 16 games, the Saints have a +5.8 scoring margin as they average 76.3 points per game and hold the opposition to 70.4 points per game.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (6-11, 2-6 PAC)



Washington & Jefferson dropped its lone game of the week 69-57 to Waynesburg ... The Presidents had not lost on their home floor to the Yellow Jackets since 2005 ... Freshman **G Andy Carter** led W&J with 19 points and six rebounds ... Carter is averaging 14.0 points per game this year ... The last W&J freshman to average double figures was **Josep Lucic-Jozak** (12.3) during the 2005-06 season ... Junior **Zach Bellhy**, the conference's leading scorer at 17.9 points per game, was slowed during Wednesday's loss by an illness and was limited to only 12 minutes of action.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (4-14, 1-8 PAC)



Waynesburg split a pair of road PAC games this past week, which began with a 69-57 victory at W&J Wednesday ... With the win, Waynesburg snapped its 18-game PAC losing streak, and beat the Presidents for the first time since the 2004-05 season, a span of 14 games ... The victory also ended a four-game losing streak, overall, and the 12-point margin of victory was the widest for the Yellow Jackets in a PAC contest since beating Thiel 78-61 during the 2006-07 campaign ... The night was a rewarding one for junior PG **Ben Altmeyer** who not only made his first start in two years, but exploded for game highs in points (25), steals (two) and assists (three), while also ripping down a team-high five rebounds ... Unfortunately, the week didn't end nearly as well for the Jackets, as they suffered a 66-48 setback at Thiel on Saturday.

Westminster Titans (3-14, 2-7 PAC)



The Westminster College men's basketball team split a pair of conference games last week ... Junior **Adam Carswell**'s tip-in after a missed free throw with three seconds left in the second half forced overtime in which the Titans won 82-81 against Geneva ... A second chance layup from freshman **Ben Donlow** with 1:02 on the clock proved to be the game-winner ... Junior **Doug Smith** had a game- and career-high 29 points with a career-best seven three-pointers ... Classmate **Ron Martino** added a career-high 15 points ... The Titans fell to Saint Vincent 79-47 on Saturday ... Westminster was on the wrong end of runs of 8-0, 13-2, 7-0, and 6-0 ... Carswell led with 12 points and tied a career-best three blocks.
