For the week, he averaged 17.0 points per game and 8.0 rebounds per game, while dishing out three assists, recording seven steals and blocking one shot. It is Miller's second PAC weekly honor this season.

Also nominated was junior F **British Alexander** of Bethany, sophomore F **Max Hoster** of Washington & Jefferson, junior F **Jeff Young** of Waynesburg, and sophomore G **Doug Smith** of Westminster.



PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2010-11 - Week 9 Conference Notes

SVC HANDS THIEL FIRST PAC LOSS: The race for the top spot in the PAC standings got a bit tighter Saturday, as Saint Vincent handed league-leader Thiel its first conference defeat of the season with a 56-55 win in Latrobe ... The Tomcats remain in first place with a 7-1 league mark, however, both Bethany and Thomas More moved within a game of the leaders at 6-2 following wins by the Bison at Westminster and by the Saints at Grove City on Saturday.

NEWS & NOTES: Tauvon Pettiford hit the game-winner for Saint Vincent vs. Thiel on a coast-to-coast driving layup with 4.8 seconds to play ... Geneva continued one of its best starts in school history with a 2-0 week, led by senior G **Bryan Hill** (PAC-high 54 treys) ... Westminster earned its first PAC win of the season over Grove City Wednesday behind a team-high 22 points from sophomore G **Doug Smith** ... Junior C **Colt Stafford** posted a 15-point, 12-rebound double-double for Thomas More at Grove City.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Thiel held PS-Beaver to 44 points Monday, the lowest single-game defensive effort by a Tomcat team since the 1992-93 season ... Bethany junior F **British Alexander** averaged 14.5 ppg and 8.0 rpg for the 2-0 Bison last week ... **Brett Matson** averaged 16.5 ppg last week for 0-2 Grove City ... Sophomore F Max Hoster of W&J averaged 11.5 ppg in an 0-2 week ... Junior F Jeff Young posted team-high totals of 12 points and nine rebounds for Waynesburg in a loss to Geneva.

The Bison used a stingy defense to pace a 68-49 win at Westminster, the fewest points allowed by Bethany this year ... BC didn't allow a field goal for more than nine minutes in the second half, as they used a 12-0 run to secure the win ... Wilcox tossed in a game-high 21, James Barton hit for 14 off the bench and Alexander totaled 10 points, eight boards and five blocks.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (12-6, 5-3 PAC)



The Bearcats went 1-1 on the week in two games decided

by a combined three points ... Wednesday, Thomas More scored the game-winning shot with one second left in the second half to beat SVC 67-65, before the Bearcats upset PAC leader Thiel on Saturday 56-55, on a **Tauvon Petiford** coast-to-coast layup with 4.8 seconds left ... Against Thomas More, **Dennis Bassich** led SVC with 16 points, while Petiford added 13 ... **BJ McGill** added a game-high seven assists ... In the Thiel game, the Bearcats limited the Tomcats to just 34 percent shooting from the floor, while forcing 19 turnovers ... McGill scored 19 points with four steals, while **Grant Latus** scored 14 points with eight rebounds.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (6-12, 3-4 PAC)



W&J dropped two games last week ... Bethany outscored W&J 20-6 in the first 10 min-

utes of the second half in a 71-58 victory Wednesday ... Senior G Brian Felker scored 16 points ... Sophomore G Zach Bellhy recorded 14 points ... Sophomore F Max Hoster set a career mark with 10 points ... Senior G EJ Morascyzk matched a career-high with eight points ... The Presidents dropped a 77-69 home loss to Geneva Saturday ... Felker extended his double-figure scoring streak to six games, scoring a team-high 19 points and grabbing six rebounds ... He also became just the 10th player in school history to reach 1,200 career points ... Sophomore Ben Cecchini notched his first career double-double with 14 points and 11 boards ... Hoster scored a career high (13) for a second-straight game.

Richard Colick scored a team best 19 points at W&J including a perfect 6-6 from the foul line ... Geneva connected on ten consecutive free throws down the stretch to ice the game away.

Thiel Tomcats (12-5, 7-1 PAC)

The Thiel College men's basketball team split a pair

of games last week ... In the first game of the week, the Tomcats defeated Penn State-Beaver 69-44 in a non-conference matchup ... The 44 points marked the lowest point total given up by a Thiel team since the 1992-93 season ... Sophomore F Ladell Trotty led the way for the Tomcats as he scored 14 points and added eight rebounds ... Sophomore G Blair Rozenblad was the only other Tomcat in double figures as he had a team-high 15 points on the day ... Game two of the week saw Thiel's conference win streak come to an end at seven games as they were defeated by Saint Vincent 56-55 ... Trotty once again led the way for the Tomcats as he had 12 points and nine rebounds.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (5-12, 2-5 PAC)




