O'Keefe averaged 27.0 points, 7.5 rebounds and 4.5 assists per game last week, as he helped

Grove City move into a first-place tie for the PAC lead following wins over Westminster (64-53) and defending PAC champion Thomas More (96-85). He posted 21 points and eight boards in the win over the Titans, then recorded a career-best 33 points, seven rebounds and seven assists to complete a season-sweep of the Saints. Also in the TMC win, O'Keefe became the 24th 1,000-point scorer in Wolverine men's basketball history. For the week, he shot 59 percent (17-of-29) from the field.

Also nominated was senior G Jay Lyonett of Bethany, freshman G Blair Rozenblad of Thiel, junior G Paul Matthews of Washington & Jefferson, junior F Jeff Young of Waynesburg, and senior F Ryne Murray of Westminster.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2009-10 - Week 10 Conference Notes

KNOTTED AT THE TOP: The race for the 2009-10 PAC men's basketball regular season title has never byeen closer, as three teams are tied for first and another is one-half game behind as the conference moves into the second half of the league schedule. Grove City completed a season sweep of Thomas More Saturday, which coupled with Bethany's win over Westminster left the Wolverines, Saints and Bison tied at 5-2, just ahead of Washington & Jefferson at 4-2.

NEWS & NOTES: Geneva has now won six consecutive games after Bryan Hill's game-winning three-pointer with 2.1 seconds to play in a 70-69 win over W&J Saturday ... Freshman G Blair Rozenblad averaged 27.5 ppg and 11.5 rpg for 2-0 Thiel ... Senior F Ryne Murray averaged 29.5 points and 8.0 rebounds for 0-2 Westminster last week, including a game-high 33 points at Bethany ... Junior G BJ McGill averaged 24.0 ppg for 0-2 Saint Vincent, including 30 points in a loss at Thomas More.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Grove City shot 69 percent (35-of-51) as a team from the field in the win at Thomas More, the best single game percentage by a PAC team this season ... Bethany senior G Jay Lyonett averaged 18.0 ppg, 5.5 rpg and 3.0 apg for the 2-0 Bison ... Senior F Daniel McKeehan averaged 18.0 ppg last week for 1-1 Thomas More ... Junior F Jeff Young scored 18 points for Waynesburg in a loss at Geneva ... Paul Matthews averaged 17.5 ppg and 5.0 rpg for 0-2 W&J.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

(12-5, 5-2 PAC) With a pair of wins last

week, Bethany moved into a three-way tie for

first place in the PAC ... Jonas Ankrom scored 15 of his 18 points in the first half and Joe Testa tallied 11 of his 20 in the second to pace BC to an 82-66 victory at W&J ... Jay Lyonett hit five three-pointers and finished with 16 as well ... Lyonett sparked an 85-73 victory over Westminster on Saturday as well with six more treys and a team-high 20 points ... Testa had 17 and Dustin Opalka finished with 14 markers and career-highs of seven boards and six assists for the Bison, who set a season-high with 16 three-pointers ... The Bison also out-rebounded Westminster 36-26 and committed just seven turnovers.

Geneva Golden **Tornadoes** (11-7)

For the first time during Geneva's six game win GOLDEN TORNADOES streak, an opponent

scored over 60 points ... But the Golden Tornadoes prevailed against W&J 70-69 when Bryan Hill nailed a 28-footer with 2.1 seconds remaining ... Despite eight missed free throws in the second half. Geneva managed to hold off the Presidents to push its win streak to six, the longest in seven years ... The GTs defeated Waynesburg earlier in the week as Rich Colick led Geneva in scoring in both games ... Colick leads Geneva with 17.4 ppg ... During the first five games of the streak, Geneva held opponents under 60 points, the first time a Geneva team had pulled off that feat since the 1936 season ... Geneva's 11-7 record marks the first time since 2004 that the GTs have been four games over .500.

Grove City Wolverines (11-7, 5-2 PAC)

Grove City surged into first place in the PAC with a pair of wins

last week ... Saturday, senior C Andy O'Keefe poured in a career-high 33 points in a 96-85 win at Thomas More ... O'Keefe became Grove City's 24th all-time 1,000-point scorer in the win ... He entered the game with 967 career points ... O'Keefe also had seven assists ... Joe McCoy (18), Drew Vandermeer (12) and Brett Matson (10) all scored in double figures ... Matson also had eight assists ... GCC shot 69 percent (35-of-51) from the field ... Grove City and Thomas More have never split their regular season series ... The Wolverines opened the week with a 64-53 home win over Westminster ... Grove City's ironclad defense held the Titans to just one field goal over the final 8:30 of the game ... O'Keefe chalked up 21 points while McCoy had 16.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (5-13)

The Bearcats' losing skid reached six games, after suf-

fering defeats to Thomas More (Wed) and Thiel (Sat) ... In Wednesday's 84-72 loss to Thomas More, BJ McGill turned in his third 30-point performance of the season in the losing effort, while adding six rebounds and five steals ... Maurice Hawkins was the only other Bearcat scorer in double-digits, scoring 10 ... Despite outscoring Thomas More 45-31 over the second half, the Bearcats couldn't shake a first half in which the Saints connected on 63 percent from the field ... Saturday at Thiel, the Tomcats were victorious 72-50, as SVC shot just 35 percent from the field and was outrebounded 44-24 ... McGill scored a team-leading 18 points, and Stephon Berry a career-

Thiel **Tomcats** (8-9, 2-4 PAC)

Thiel won two games last week to up its season record to 8-9 as it begins its second round of conference play ... Wednesday, Thiel played its non-conference finale, downing Penn State Beaver, 93-89 ... Freshman Blair Rozenblad scored a season-high 30 points with a 13-of-19 shooting night from the floor ... Junior Devon Adams was close behind with 24 points ... Rozenblad scored a game-high 25 points and pulled down 10 rebounds Saturday afternoon as Thiel eased past Saint Vincent, 70-52, at Beeghly Gymnasium ... The Tomcats started the second half with an 8-2 run and led by as many as 26 points with less than five minutes to go in the game ... Thiel out-rebounded the Bearcats to the tune of 44-24, including 17 on the offensive glass which led to 23 second-chance points.

Thomas More Saints (13-5, 5-2 PAC)



The Thomas More split a pair of PAC games last week as they defeated Saint Vincent College, 84-72, but fell to Grove City College, 96-85 ... Senior PF Daniel McKeehan led the Saints against Saint Vincent with 18 points ... Against Grove City, McKeehan and junior F Aaron Miller each scored 18 points to lead Thomas More ... After 18 games, three Saints average in double-figure scoring as McKeehan averages 15.2 points per game, Miller averages 12.9 ppg., and sophomore SG Daniel Neeley averages 10.9 ppg. ... Miller leads the team in rebounding with 5.9 rebounds per game, while McKeehan leads the team in assists with 40 and Neeley leads the team in steals with 36.

Washington & Jefferson **Presidents** (8-10, 4-2 PAC)



W&J dropped a pair of PAC contests last week against local rival Bethany (82-66) and

Geneva (70-69) ... In the Presidents' last six games, they hold a 2-4 record, but three of those losses have come by three points or less ... In Saturday's one-point loss against Geneva, W&J held a two-point edge (69-67) after junior Paul Matthews hit a three-pointer with seven seconds remaining; however, Geneva's **Bryan Hill** took the ensuing inbounds pass and drilled a three-pointer at the buzzer to give GC the one-point victory ...
