PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

TIM DRAKELEY Waynesburg University

5-6 Senior Guard Washington, Pa. Trinity H.S.

Drakeley captured PAC weekly honors for the third time this season after averaging 32.5 points per game while adding three rebounds, three assists and a



steal for the 1-1 Yellow Jackets last week. He scored 30 points in a 78-59 non-league road win at Franciscan Wednesday, then poured in a game-high 35 markers in an 80-75 PAC loss to Thiel on Saturday. For the week, Drakeley shot 61 percent (20-of-33) from the field, including an incredible 73 percent (16-of-22) from three-point range.

Also nominated was senior G Brody Jackson of Bethany, senior G Shawn Carr of Grove City, freshman F Tommy Hall of Thiel, junior C Josip Lucic-Jozak of Washington & Jefferson, and sophomore F Ryne Murray of Westminster.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison



Bethany ran its win streak to five and slid into sole possession of first place in the PAC with a pair of narrow victories ... After losing a

12-point lead in regulation, BC outscored W&J 11-3 in the final 1:44 of overtime to come away with an 86-83 win ... Brody Jackson (27) and Marcus Adams (23) combined to pour in 50 points, including all 13 in the extra session ... In the 77-76 victory at Thomas More, Bethany didn't take the lead for good until Petre Petkovski's offensive rebound and putback with 11 seconds to play ... Tyler Morando led all scorers with 17 points, including five three-pointers, with Jackson chipping in 13 and Jonas Ankrom delivering 12 off the bench.

Saint Vincent Bearcats



Saint Vincent picked up a pair of home wins, extending its win steak to six ... In Wednesday's 72-56 win over Thomas More. four Bearcats scored in double figures, led by lan

McCollough and Joey Butler, who each scored 18 ... The pair also added four assists and three steals apiece ... SVC used 57 percent accuracy from the field to take a 38-23 halftime lead ... Saturday, the Bearcats defeated Westminster for the first time since joining the PAC ... McCollough enjoyed a monster night, scoring 31 points and becoming the 27th player in Saint Vincent history to score over 1.000 career points ... He also added 10 rebounds for his sixth doubledouble of the season.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents



W&J dropped a pair of close contests last week, including an overtime setback against Bethany Wednesday ... The Presidents held a five-point lead in overtime, but the Bison

fought back to earn the win ... Seven of the Presidents' 11 defeats have been by 10 points or less, including each of their last four ... Sophomore G Albert Varacallo led W&J with 23 points, while juniors Wahab Owolabi (22p, 6r) and Josip Lucic-Jozak (18p, 12r) both scored in double figures ... The Presidents rallied from two double-digit deficits Saturday at NDC and held a late one-point advantage, but Notre Dame sealed the win from the foul line ... Lucic-Jozak posted 27 points and 12 rebounds.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes



GOLDEN TORNADOES

After an emotional victory against long-time rival Westminster on Wednesday night, Geneva saw its modest two-game winning

streak come to an end with a seven-point loss at Grove City on Saturday afternoon ... The Golden Tornadoes were seeking their first three-game win streak of the season ... Mike Ross enjoyed a solid week with 14 points at Grove City and nine points at Westminster ... Ross canned a pair of huge three-point field goals in the second half to seal the victory over the Titans ... Head coach Jeff Santarsiero recorded his 200th victory at Geneva with the decision over Westminster.

Thiel Tomcats



Thiel went 1-1 last week. suffering a 72-54 home loss to Grove City on Wednesday before outlasting Waynesburg 80-75 on the road Saturday ... In

the loss to Grove City, freshman F Tommy Hall led the Tomcats with 18 points, six rebounds and three blocks ... The Tomcats were led by senior F Joe Herrmann in the win at Waynesburg, finishing with 31 points and nine rebounds ... They finished with a 40-21 advantage on the boards, including 14 offensive rebounds, and shot 58.2 percent (32-55) from the field ... Hall scored 19 points on 8-of-9 shooting, while sophomore G Nick Sefcsik chipped in with 10.

Grove City Wolverines



Grove City began the second half of PAC play with a 67-60 home win over Geneva ... The Wolverines completed their first season sweep of

Geneva in 19 years ... Ryan Gibson scored 15 points while Joe Capotosta added 12 ... Capotosta averaged 13 points per game against Geneva this year ... Against all other foes, he is averaging 3.2 per game ... Wednesday, the Wolverines wrapped up the first half of the PAC schedule with a 72-54 victory at Thiel ... Shawn Carr became the program's 22nd all-time 1,000-point scorer in the second half of the victory ... He led Grove City with 19 points ... Luke Tomaselli added 11, including a season-high three three-pointers ... GCC shot 11-of-19 behind the three-point line.

Thomas More Saints



Thomas More dropped both games this week, including a heartbreaking onepoint loss to PAC leader Bethany ...

Freshman Johnny Bovard recorded his fourth double-figure scoring performance of the season with 14 points in the loss, and finished the week with a team-high 9.5 points per game ... Junior Mark Tinklenberg added his fourth double-double of the season with 14 points and 10 rebounds.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets



Behind the scoring outburst of senior G Tim Drakeley, the Yellow Jackets finished last week with a 1-1 record ... In a 78-59 victory over

Franciscan, Drakeley netted 30 points on the strength of eight three-pointers, one shy of tying the single-game school record ... Senior G Jered Gamble and senior F Josh Parisi finished with 10 points each against the Barons, while Parisi collected nine rebounds and Gamble added six assists and four steals ... Saturday against Thiel, Drakeley set a career high with 35 points on 10-of-15 attempts, including eight threepointers ... Parisi finished with 18 points and six rebounds in the loss to the Tomcats.

Westminster Titans



Westminster dropped two games against D-III provisional members last week. losing at home to Geneva, 67-62, Wednes-

day and at Saint Vincent, 87-60, Saturday ... Sophomore F Ryne Murray posted teamhigh averages of 18.5 points, 6.5 rebounds, 2.5 steals and 2.5 assists during the week, including 21 points by making 5-of-6 3pointers vs. Geneva ... Senior G Craig Hannon averaged 15.5 points, including 19 vs. Geneva ... Against Geneva, the Titans went on a 7-0 run and drew within one point with under four minutes to go before losing by five ... In the loss to Saint Vincent, Murray scored 16, senior G/F Chauncey Whitlow bucketed 14 and Hannon had 12 as Westminster shot just 35 percent.

Bethany Bison

Bethany will try to stay in sole possession of

first place in the PAC Wednesday when they host Waynesburg ... The Bison beat the Yellow Jackets 100-78 on Dec. 5 for their 11th straight win over Waynesburg and now lead the all-time series 54-38 ... **Brody Jackson** had 21 and **Tyler Morando** scored 16 ... Bethany's first meeting with Geneva Dec. 8 resulted in a 96-81 BC win, the 100th in head coach **Aaron Huffman**'s tenure ... Geneva still leads the series 53-22 ... Jackson, who scored a team-high 18 in the Geneva win, has 950 career points and needs 50 more to become the 21st player in BC history to surpass 1,000 for his career.

Saint Vincent Bearcats

State-Fayette, as the Bearcats downed the Lions 105-61 to open the season November 16th ... Six players scored in double-figures in the win, led by **Tre'sor Kalambay's** 17 points ... The Bearcats shot 54 percent from the field in the win, and forced 27 PSU-Fayette turnovers ... Saturday, SVC will travel to Waynesburg and go for another season sweep, as the Bearcats defeated the Yellow Jackets 89-66 on December 8th ... Saint Vincent led 38-37 at halftime, but outscored the Yellow Jackets 51-29 in the second half.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents

... The two schools will meet for the first time in Washington since the 1987-88 season, when W&J earned a 67-58 victory ... That win marks the last victory in the series for the Presidents ... **Albert Varacallo** led four Presidents in double figures with 22 points in a 79-69 loss at Geneva on Dec. 5th ... Saturday's game at Grove City marks the 100th in history between the two local rivals (Grove City leads 52-47) ... The Wolverines have won 17 of the last 20 meetings.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes

Geneva is facing W&J this year the first time since the 1989-90

The Golden Tornadoes will look for revenge against Bethany on Saturday night when they attempt to avenge a 96-81 loss back on December 8th ... Geneva leads the series by the count of 28-21.

Waynesburg hosts Saint Vincent Saturday after suffering an 89-66 loss to the Bearcats earlier this year ... Senior G Tim Drakeley has scored 30-plus points four times this season, including the last two games ... He is the first Yellow Jacket player to score 30 points in back-to-back since G Ray Robinson did in three-straight games in the 2002-03 season.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City won the first meeting this year in overtime, 102-98, at the GCC Arena Dec. 5 ... Grove City last swept both Geneva and Westminster in the same season 25 years ago in the 1982-83 season ... Saturday, Grove City hosts W&J ... Shawn Carr's three-pointer at the buzzer Dec. 8 gave GCC a 58-55 win at W&J ... Carr became Grove City's all-time leader in three-pointers on that basket.

Thomas More Saints

The Saints return to the road, where they are 2-7 on the season, for two PAC

games this week ... Thomas More leads the series with Thiel, 5-0, including a 96-84 victory earlier this season ... Five players reached double figures in the victory, including Mark Tinklenberg who led the Saints with 19 points and 10 rebounds ... Junior Daniel Ellis added a career-high 17 points ... TMC defeated Westminster, 78-67, earlier this season for its first win in six attempts against the Titans ... Sophomore Romell Salone scored a career-high 17 points with five assists, while Tinklenberg had 13 points and 13 rebounds.

Westminster Titans

Westminster lost at Thomas More, 78-67, on Dec. 8, with Craig Hannon scoring a game-high 21 points.
