PAC Men's Basketball Player of the Week

KEITH SCHUBERT

Bethany College

6-4 Senior Forward Girard, Ohio/Girard H.S.

Schubert earned PAC Player of the Week honors for the second straight week and the third time this season after averaging 24.0 points and 8.5 rebounds per game for the 2-0 Bison. Bethany remained unbeaten (3-0) and in sole possession of first place in the PAC with wins over Waynesburg (82-71) and Thiel (83-73). Schubert posted 17 points in the win over the Yellow Jackets on Wednesday, then came back with 31 points and 11 rebounds on Saturday as Bethany handed the Tomcats their first PAC loss of the season. He was also a perfect 12-of-12 from the free throw line this week. With 1,821 career points, Schubert is just 70 points shy of surpassing **Rudy Yaksich** (1,891 points from 1954-58) as the all-time leading scorer at Bethany.

Also nominated was senior forward **Pat Roberts** of Grove City, sophomore center **Tony Franz** of Washington & Jefferson, and junior guard **Ray Robinson** of Waynesburg.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bison used big second half runs to pull away in both PAC victories last week ... A Todd McGuinness heave from three-quarters court beat the halftime buzzer to give the Bison a three-point halftime lead against Waynesburg ... A 27-7 run midway through the second half pushed Bethany's lead to 24 and the Bison held off a late rally for the victory ... Forward Keith Schubert led four scorers in double figures with 17 ... At Thiel, a 19-4 spurt in the second half erased a two-point Tomcat lead and allowed the Bison to take over sole possession of first place in the PAC ... Bethany went 15-15 from the foul line in the second half and 19-20 for the game ... Schubert again led with 31 points and 11 rebounds.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J claimed its first PAC win of the year on Saturday by defeating Waynesburg at home, 86-79 ... The Presidents were led by sophomore center Tony Franz, who netted a career-high 27 points and grabbed 11 rebounds, and junior guard Nolan Larry, who scored 24 of his 26 points in the second half ... Larry also scored his 1,000th career point in the second half during a stretch where he hit three straight three-point field goals ... W&J shot 69 percent in the second half and 57 percent for the game in winning its first PAC contest ... Grove City outrebounded W&J, 44-25, and shot 48 percent from the field on Wednesday ... Sophomore forward Scott Chodor and Larry each scored 18 points ... Larry also added seven assists.

Grove City Wolverines

The Wolverines improved to 14-5 with a dramatic and historic 111-101 four-overtime victory at Westminster on Saturday ... A school-record seven players reached double figures in the win, led by sophomore Tanner Prosser's 23 points ... Prosser sent the game to overtime with a tip-in as regulation time expired ... The Wolverines trailed by 16 points in the second half before taking the lead with a 20-2 run ... Senior Pat Roberts played a school-record 49 minutes in the win, amassing 17 points, 14 rebounds and eight assists ... Sophomore Phil Bushre returned from a concussion to post 17 points and seven boards ... Freshman Nate Maurer collected 13 points and 10 boards in Wednesday's 74-59 win at W&J

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg went 1-2 last week, posting a non-conference 76-61 win over Penn State-Altoona before dropping PAC contests to Bethany (82-71) and Washington & Jefferson (86-79) ... Junior guard **Ray Robinson** led Waynesburg in scoring in all three games, averaging 19.7 points, 5.0 rebounds and 2.1 steals per game for the week ... The Jackets look to rebound in PAC play when they host the Thiel Tomcats on Wednesday night at the Rudy Marisa Field house.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel went 1-1 last week, downing Westminster 71-63 on Jan. 23 and falling to Bethany 83-73 on Jan. 26 ... The Tomcats finished the Westminster game 28-of-63 (44.4%) from the floor ... Junior A.H. Davis posted a game-high 23 points and seven rebounds in the 10point win ... On Saturday, the Tomcats trailed 37-36 at the half against the Bison, but Thiel was outscored 21-14 in the first 10 minutes of the second half ... The Tomcats finished the game with four players in double digits, led by senior Erik Hemsing's 14 markers ... Junior Eddie Mathews finished with 13 points, 11 of which came in the first half...Bethany held a 19-8 advantage from the free throw line over the Tomcats.

Westminster Titans

Westminster fell to 0-4 against PAC opponents last week, as the Titans fell at Thiel 71-63 on Wednesday before suffering a heartbreaking 111-101 fourovertime defeat to Grove City at Buzz Ridl Gymnasium on Saturday ... The fourovertime contest was the longest game in history for both schools ... Junior center Greg Foster posted an impressive line against the Tomcats, recording a team-high 14 points to go along with career-high totals of 17 rebounds and six blocked shots ... Sophomore point quard Mike Hill recorded a career-best 28 points, including five three-pointers, against the Wolverines ... Sophomore forward Andy Podbielski posted a "double-double" off the bench with 13 points and 10 boards on Saturday.

Upcoming Game Notes: It'll be a battle for first place at Grove City Wednesday night when Bethany faces the Wolverines ... The Bison swept both meetings last season with GCC, winning on the road 75-54 behind a career-high 32 points from Nevada Smith, and taking the rematch in Bethany 86-78 ... Grove City leads the series 42-18 ... Bethany will try to sweep the season series from Westminster on Saturday ... The Bison rallied from a 15-point second half deficit and on a short jumper by Derek Hoffman with six seconds left, claimed a 78-77 win against the Titans ... Westminster still leads the series 57-10.
