PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

PAT O'CONNOR

Westminster College

6-4 Senior Forward Pittsburgh, Pa./Keystone Oaks H.S.

O'Connor led the Titans to a 2-0 PAC week by averaging 21.0 points, 8.5 rebounds, 4.5 steals and 1.0 blocks per game. He posted a season-high 32 points (one off his career-high), including eight three-pointers, in a 116-101 win over W&J. O'Connor then talleid a double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds in a 113-98 win at Waynesburg.

Also nominated was junior G/F **Matt Drahos** of Bethany, senior C **Phil Bushre** of Grove City, sophomore G **Jon Koch** of Washington & Jefferson, and sophomore F **Shawn Coleman** of Waynesburg.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

Bethany has now won three straight games, all against conference foes ... Thanks to the win streak, Bethany now enjoys a share of the first-place in the PAC ... The Bison defeated Grove City 72-67 behind the Drahos brothers' offense and a season-best performance for Scott Mezyk ... Mike and Matt Drahos earned 20 and 14 points, respectively, while Mezyk canned 6-of-8 shots to down the formerly PAC-undefeated Grove City Wolverines ... Matt Drahos also grabbed a game-best 13 rebounds ... Against Waynesburg, Matt Drahos exploded for 24 points and 11 rebounds in the 86-61 victory ... Brother Mike notched 10 points and 12 rebounds, which was enough to give the junior his 1,000th career point.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J closed the first half of its PAC schedule with a dramatic 72-70 victory over Thiel Saturday ... Freshman G Tyler Trutza hit an off-balanced runner with 0.4 seconds remaining to lift the Presidents to victory ... Sophomore G Jon Koch led the Presidents with 19 points, five rebounds and five assists, while sophomore F Matt Vorndran and freshman C Tony Lewis added 14 and 12 points, respectively ... W&J shot 55 percent and out-rebounded Westminster, 49-37, Wednesday, but could not overcome 26 turnovers in a 116-101 loss ... The Presidents led most of the first half, but a late first half run and an early second half spurt proved to be the difference for the Titans ... Koch had 28 points and six assists for W&J.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City posted several milestones Wednesday night in its 65-50 win over Thiel ... It was the 2000th game in Grove City men's basketball history and head coach Steve Lamie earned his 100th career win ... Grove City also won its 100th all-time game against Thiel and remained unbeaten in conference play ... Phil Bushre had a game-high 21 points while Ryan Eller added 13 ... Matt Phillips had 10 boards and eight assists ... Saturday, Grove City's six-game win streak ended at Bethany, 72-67 ... Grove City trailed by as many as 15 in the first half ... J.D. Collar led the Wolverines with 15 points while Bushre had 14 ... The Wolverines fell into a tie for first place in the PAC at the halfway mark.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg was swept in a pair of PAC contests this week - losing 86-61 to Bethany and 113-98 to Westminster ... Sophomore F Shawn Coleman posted game- and career-highs against the Titans with 22 points and 13 rebounds for his first double-double of the season and second of his career ... Senior G Ray Gillespie also posted a career-high in the loss to the Titans, scoring 18 points, while backcourt mate Beau Wilson also bucked 18 ... The Yellow Jackets shot a season-best 56 percent from the field (42 of 75) ... Against the Bison, Waynesburg struggled from the field making just 18of-60 attempts (30 percent) ... Freshman F Josh Parisi led Waynesburg with 14 points off the bench, while G Marc Lodovico added 10 points in the loss.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel saw its winless streak extend to 11 last week after dropping a pair of PAC road contests ... The Tomcats shot just 19.2 percent from the field in the opening half against Grove City Wednesday, falling 65-50 ... Junior F Stephen Laird totaled 13 points and four assists while freshman F Joe Herrmann and senior G Daryl Moore each finished with 11 ... W&J's Tyler Trutza hit a jumper with 0.4 seconds remaining to lead the Presidents to a 72-70 victory over the Tomcats Saturday ... Herrmann led all scorers with 24 points and 10 rebounds ... Moore added 18 points and two assists, while freshman G Ross Watson collected 10 points and four boards.

Westminster Titans

The Titans posted a pair of PAC wins last week, topping W&J at home 116-101 on Wednesday before winning at Waynesburg 113-98 Saturday ... Senior F Pat O'Connor blistered the nets for a season-high 32 points, including eight threepointers, in the W&J win ... Four other Titans scored in double figures: senior G Ed Pagley with 14, junior G Mark DeMonaco with 13, freshman G Craig Hannon with 12, and junior G Brian Fadden with 10 while also snaring a team- and season-high 10 rebounds for his first double-double of the campaign ... Three Titans - DeMonaco, junior F Dom Joseph and Hannon - led a balanced scoring attack with 14 points each at Waynesburg, as seven Titans scored in double figures.

The Bison play Lake Erie Tuesday before returning to conference action Saturday at Thiel ... The Bison lead in the all-time series with Lake Erie 2-1 and ride a three-game win streak into the matchup with the Storm ... Bethany took its first conference match-up of the season over Thiel College, winning by a score of 86-66 ... Bethany has won two out of the last three contests with the Tomcats, with their last lost coming at Thiel last season, 64-63.
