### PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2010-11 - Week 10 Conference Notes

TIGHT AT THE TOP: With just three weeks remaining in the 2010-11 PAC men's basket-ball regular season, the battle at the top of the league standings remains tight ... Thiel remains in first place at 8-1 overall following a home win over W&J last week, while both Bethany and Thomas More are a game behind at 7-2 and Saint Vincent is two back at 6-3 ... The league-leading Tomcats travel to Bethany to face the Bison in a key conference contest this Wednesday at 8 p.m.

NEWS & NOTES: Geneva knocked off PAC leader Thiel Wednesday behind a 30-point effort (including 10-10 FTs) by senior Rich Colick ... Reece Mabery set a new Bethany single-game record with 12 steals in a win at Waynesburg ... Junior G Dennis Bassich led Saint Vincent with 18 points, including the game-winning trey with 18 seconds left, in a come-from-behind 62-60 win vs. Westminster ... Seniors Brian Felker and Paul Matthews each scored 19 points for W&J in a PAC win over Grove City.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Grove City limited Waynesburg to 39 points Saturday, the fewest by a PAC opponent vs. GCC since 1999 (59-35 vs. W&J) ... Five Thomas More players scored in double figures at Westminster, led by senior SG Brian Muse with 15 ... Thiel senior G Lance Randall averaged 15.0 ppg for the 1-1 Tomcats ... Westminster junior F Rob Briggs averaged a double-double (13.5 ppg, 11.0 rpg) during an 0-2 week for the Titans ... Junior F Jeff Young averaged 11.0 ppg on the week for 0-2 Waynesburg.

Saturday, the Bison held Geneva, the highest scoring team in the PAC, to their second-lowest total of the year in a 75-63 win ... Five Bison scored in double digits, led by Alexander, Wilcox and James Barton with 15 each and Mabery and Brady Pacific with 10 apiece ... Alexander also grabbed 10 boards for his fourth double-double

### Geneva Golden Tornadoes (14-5)

Geneva's men rolled past PAC leader Thiel GOLDEN TORNADOES Wednesday to improve

its winning streak to a season long five straight ... In the 80-77 victory, Richard Colick posted his second 30-point performance of the season including a perfect 10-of-10 from the foul line ... The winning came to a halt Saturday when the Golden Tornadoes dropped a 75-63 decision to Bethany in West Virginia ... One of the positives to come out of Saturday's loss was the play of sophomore Matt Lorello ... Lorello scored 10 points off the bench and was a perfect 3-of-3 from the field and 4-of-4 from the line ... Bryan Hill continues to lead the PAC in three-point shooting and put up six more treys in two games last week ... Geneva is 14-5 and will travel to Thomas More Wednesday before hosting Saint Vincent Saturday.

### **Grove City** Wolverines (5-14, 2-8 PAC)

Grove City earned its first road win of the season Saturday by

pulling out a 46-39 win at Waynesburg as GCC earned a season split ... Kris Verderber led Grove City with 12 points ... Bryn Moran added nine points in a career-high 35 minutes ... Nate Rambacher played a career-high 38 minutes . Defensively, the Wolverines held Waynesburg to 33 percent (15-of-46) percent shooting from the field ... Grove City held Waynesburg to just 12 first-half points, the lowest one-half total by a GCC foe since D'Youville scored nine points against the Wolverines on Feb. 17, 1999 ... The 36 points are the fewest allowed vs. a PAC opponent since Feb. 3, 1999, when Grove City downed W&J 59-35 ... Grove City opened last week with a 72-56 loss at W&J ... Brett Matson paced the Wolverines with 21 points.

### Saint Vincent Bearcats (13-6, 6-3 PAC)

The Bearcats improved to 6-3 in PAC play with a dramatic

62-60 home win over Westminster on Wednesday night ... Trailing 56-45 with just over four minutes left in the second half, Saint Vincent surged down the stretch, ending the game on a 17-4 run, capped off with a Dennis Bassich three-pointer that closed the scoring with 18 seconds left ... Bassich and BJ McGill shared the SVC lead with 13 points apiece, with McGill adding a team-high six assists ... Though shooting only 36 percent from the floor for the game, including a 4-for-26 showing from behind the arc, Saint Vincent out-rebounded the Titans 48-34, led by eight from Dillon Stith.

### Thiel **Tomcats** (13-6, 8-1 PAC)


