THREE WEEKS TO GO: With three weeks to play in the 2009-10 regular season, the race for the PAC men's basketball regular season title and the top seed for the 2010 PAC Tournament remains tight. With wins over W&J and Waynesburg last week, Grove City is 7-2 in league play and has taken a half-game lead over defending PAC champion Thomas More and bethany, both at 6-2. W&J and Thiel are battling for the fourth seed at 4-4 and 3-4 in PAC play, respectively.

NEWS & NOTES: Thiel has won four consecutive games and six of its last eight contests to move over .500 for the first time this season at 10-9 overall ... Senior C Andy O'Keefe of Grove City averaged 20.0 ppg for 2-0 Grove City, shooting 85 percent (17-of-20) from the field for the week ... Senior G Jay Lyonett led Bethany to a pair of PAC wins after averaging 13.5 ppg, 9.0 rpg, and 2.0 spg ... Senior F Ryne Murray averaged 17.0 ppg and 5.5 rpg last week for 1-1 Westminster.


