wins last week by averaging 24.0 points, 5.0 assists, 3.5 rebounds and 2.0 steals per game, while shooting 56 percent (10-of-18) from three-point range. He posted a team-high 22 points as the Tomcats rolled past PAC foe Geneva 93-69, then recorded a game-high 26 markers as Thiel won at Washington & Jefferson 78-68, snapping a 10-game losing streak to the Presidents. With the wins, Thiel has now won four consecutive contests.

Also nominated was senior G **Jay Lyonett** of Bethany, senior C **Andy O'Keefe** of Grove City, senior PF **Daniel McKeegan** of Thomas More, junior G **Brian Felker** of Washington & Jefferson, junior F **Jeff Young** of Waynesburg, and senior F **Ryne Murray** of Westminster.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2009-10 - Week 11 Conference Notes

THREE WEEKS TO GO: With three weeks to play in the 2009-10 regular season, the race for the PAC men's basketball regular season title and the top seed for the 2010 PAC Tournament remains tight. With wins over W&J and Waynesburg last week, Grove City is 7-2 in league play and has taken a half-game lead over defending PAC champion Thomas More and Bethany, both at 6-2. W&J and Thiel are battling for the fourth seed at 4-4 and 3-4 in PAC play, respectively.

NEWS & NOTES: Thiel has won four consecutive games and six of its last eight contests to move over .500 for the first time this season at 10-9 overall ... Senior C **Andy O'Keefe** of Grove City averaged 20.0 ppg for 2-0 Grove City, shooting 85 percent (17-of-20) from the field for the week ... Senior G **Jay Lyonett** led Bethany to a pair of PAC wins after averaging 13.5 ppg, 9.0 rpg, and 2.0 spg ... Senior F **Ryne Murray** averaged 17.0 ppg and 5.5 rpg last week for 1-1 Westminster.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: **Rich Colick** posted 29 points for Geneva in a PAC loss to Bethany ... Senior PF **Daniel McKeegan** posted 17 points and seven rebounds for Thomas More in a PAC win over Westminster ... **Stephon Berry** posted his second career double-double for Saint Vincent with 10 points and 10 boards in a loss to Westminster ... W&J's **Brian Felker** scored 23 points, all in the second half, in a loss to Thiel ... Junior F **Jeff Young** averaged 9.0 ppg and 6.0 rpg for 0-2 Waynesburg.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (14-5, 6-2 PAC)



Bethany stayed in the thick of the PAC race and improved their win streak to five with two more victories last week ... BC trailed Waynesburg by 11 in the first half, but rallied to post a 67-57 triumph, their 16th straight over the Yellow Jackets ... **Nick Wilcox** had 13 points and five steals, while **Joe Testa** scored 12 and **Jay Lyonett** and **Jonas Ankrom** both had 11 ... The Bison totaled 31 second-chance points off 18 offensive rebounds, as they recovered from a one-point halftime deficit to win at Geneva, 75-67 ... Despite 2nd half foul trouble, Testa tallied a team-high 19 points, while Lyonett recorded his first career double-double with 16 markers and 10 boards, including seven offensive ... Ankrom and **Dustin Opalka** each added 12 points apiece.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (11-9)



The good times had to come to an end at some point for Geneva and that time was last week ... Taking a six game winning streak into the week, the Golden Tornadoes dropped games to Thiel and Bethany to fall to 11-9 ... Holding on to the hopes of finishing with an overall record of over .500 to be eligible for the NCCAA post-season, the GTs must win two of their final five games to qualify ... Geneva could not contain an overpowering offensive effort from Thiel Wednesday and then watched Bethany bounce back for a second half rally that left Geneva on the short end for only the second home loss of the season ... **Rich Colick** scored 29 points in the loss to Bethany, while senior **Nate Reep** scored a career-high 13 points off the bench for Geneva.

Grove City Wolverines (13-7, 7-2 PAC)



Grove City continued its second-half surge last week by holding a pair of opponents to under 50 points in two conference wins ... Wednesday night, Grove City held W&J to six second-half field goals in a 62-49 win ... **Andy O'Keefe** poured in 20 points on 8-of-8 shooting while **Luke Tomaselli** fired in 15 ... **Joe McCoy** and **Brett Matson** both tallied 10 points ... Saturday, the Wolverines celebrated Hall of Fame Day by rolling Waynesburg 65-48 ... The Wolverines never trailed in the game and led 38-23 at the half ... O'Keefe again scored 20 points and Matson contributed a dozen ... Grove City held the Yellow Jackets to nine field goals over the final 20 minutes ... Grove City has held six straight opponents to 54 points or less in the GCC Arena ... The Wolverines are 7-1 at home.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (5-14)



The Bearcats saw their losing streak reach seven games after being defeated 69-44 at Westminster in their only action of the week Wednesday ... The Titans jumped out to a 33-8 lead midway through the first half, before taking a 44-18 halftime advantage ... **BJ McGill** scored 16 points to lead SVC, and the junior has now scored at least 11 points in all 19 games of the '09-10 campaign ... **Stephon Berry** recorded the second double-double of his career, with 10 points and 10 rebounds, while **Armani Fountain** added 10 boards to go with three blocks for the Bearcats ... SVC shot just 28 percent from the floor (17-of-60), including a 2-of-10 showing from behind the arc, while the Titans hit 12-of-24 three-pointers ... The seven-game losing skid is the team's longest since the 1991-92 team lost nine straight.

Thiel Tomcats (10-9, 3-4 PAC)



Thiel won its fourth game in a row and sixth in the last eight games Saturday when it defeated Washington & Jefferson, 78-68, to move above .500 for the first time this season ... Thiel never trailed in the contest as it snapped the Presidents' 10-game stranglehold on the series ... Junior **Devon Adams** led the way with a team-high 22 points ... W&J was unable to pull within nine points in the second half while trailing by as many as 19 ... Wednesday, Thiel administered a sound 93-69 drubbing of visiting Geneva that moved its record at Beeghly Gymnasium to 5-1 on the season ... Thiel has won it past four home contests by a combined 89-point margin... Adams paced the Tomcats' 53.3% shooting night from beyond the arc with a 5-of-9 performance which racked up 15 of his game-high 26 points.

Thomas More Saints (14-5, 6-2 PAC)



Thomas More defeated Westminster, 82-65, in its lone game last week ... In the win the Saints forced 30 turnovers and had 10 different players record at least one steal ... Senior PF **Daniel McKeehan** led the Saints in scoring and rebounding with 17 points and seven rebounds, while dishing out three assists and recording four steals ... After 19 games, three Saints average in double-figure scoring as McKeehan averages 15.3 points per game, junior F **Aaron Miller** averages 13.0 ppg., and sophomore SG **Daniel Neeley** averages 10.9 ppg. ... Miller leads the team in rebounding with 5.8 rebounds per game, while McKeehan leads the team in assists with 43 and Neeley leads the team in steals with 40.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (8-12, 4-4 PAC)



Washington & Jefferson dropped the No. 4 spot in the league standings after suffering defeats to Grove City and Thiel ... The Wolverines broke open a close game midway through the second half on Wednesday ... The Presidents were led by senior **Albert Varacallo's** 16 points ... Thiel opened Saturday's game on a 15-4 run and never trailed, while earning its first in over W&J in 11 tries ... Junior **Brian Felker** fired in 23 points, all of which came in the second half ... 46 of the Presidents' 68 points came from their reserves.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (2-15, 0-8 PAC)



The Waynesburg men dropped a pair of road PAC contests this past week ... Junior F **Jeff Young** and freshman PG **Ben Altmeyer** each averaged a team-high nine points per game ... Young also led the team in rebounds (six per game) and tied with junior G **Steven Iser** with two assists per game.

Westminster Titans (6-14, 2-6 PAC)



After posting its largest margin of victory of the season in a 69-44 home win over Saint Vincent Wednesday, Westminster traveled to Thomas More Saturday and lost 82-65 ... Senior F **Ryne Murray** was the only Titan to average double figures in scoring with 17.0 points per game to go with a team-best 5.5 rebounds per game ... Murray came off the bench and scored a game-high 20 points, including 14 in the first half, in the win over Saint Vincent ... He bucketed 14 points vs. Thomas More to lead the Titans in scoring for the 11th time in 12 games ... Other notables for the week included freshman G **Liam Halferty** scoring 13 points vs. Saint Vincent, one shy of a career high, and sophomore G **Anthony DeFelice** scoring in double figures for the second time this season with 13 points vs. Thomas More.
