PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL CO-PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Nate Maurer - Grove City College 6-6 Sophomore Guard/Forward Pittsburgh, Pa./Linsly School (W.Va.)

Brian Fadden - Westminster College 6-1 Freshman Guard New Castle, Pa./Mohawk H.S.)

Maurer led the league-leading Wolverines to a 2-0 week by averaging 22.5 points and 6.0 rebounds in PAC wins over Waynesburg (79-77) and Washington & Jefferson (76-70). He posted 24 points and six boards in the Waynesburg win, then tallied 21 points, six rebounds, and four assists against W&J. For the week, he shot 14-of-26 from the field (53.8%) and 16-of-17 from the line (94.1%).

Fadden posted nearly perfect shooting last week, as he led the Titans to a 2-0 week with PAC wins over W&J (90-74) and Bethany (84-82). He averaged 13.0 points, 4.5 rebounds, and 3.5 assists for the week while shooting 88.9% from the field (8-of-9) and 100% from the line (12-of-12). He was perfect against W&J, hitting 3-of-3 field goals and 10-of-10 free throws for a team-high 16 points.

Also nominated was senior C **Derek Hoffman** of Bethany, senior G **Shane Manley** of Thiel, sophomore F Chris Houser of Washington & Jefferson, and senior C **Jake Marcoux** of Waynesburg.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bison dropped a pair of PAC games last week and have now lost three straight ... Bethany shot just 33 percent from the floor, including just 6-of-22 from behind the arc, in the loss at Thiel ... PG Josh Polantz hit five of the Bison's six threes for a team-high 15 points... The Bison came back from a nine-point halftime deficit to take a 77-73 lead with 6:42 to play, but couldn't hold on in a loss to Westminster... The tandem of Derek Hoffman (28 pts., 13-22 shooting) and Matt Drahos (24 pts., 10-14 shooting) combined for 52 points on 64 percent shooting, while the rest of the team hit just 11-of-39 (28%) ... Saturday's effort was a career-best for Hoffman, who averaged 19.5 ppg and 10.5 rpg last week.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Presidents had their two-game winning streak snapped this week with losses at Westminster and Grove City ... W&J trailed Westminster 61-56 with 12 minutes left in the game, but could not get any closer ... Sophomore F Steve Button led the Presidents with gamehighs in points (19) and rebounds (8) ... Junior C Tony Franz added 14 points and six boards, while sophomore F Chris Houser scored 13 points on 5-of-7 shooting ... Grove City and W&J were tied 11 times on Saturday, before the Wolverines pulled out the win in the final two minutes ... The win was the ninth-straight home victory for GCC over the Presidents ... Franz and Nolan Larry both recorded 15 points for the Presidents, while Larry also dished out seven assists.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City continued to set the pace in the PAC, reaching the halfway pole with a one-game lead ... The Wolverines picked up two victories last week, including a 79-77 triumph at Waynesburg ... Nate Maurer tossed in 24 points while Tanner Prosser added 18 on 7-of-7 accuracy from the floor ... Andy Vlajkovich and Ryan Eller both scored 11 ... Against W&J, the Wolverines warded off the upstart Presidents as four players scored in double figures ... Maurer led the way with 21, while point guard Mike Lukcic threw in a career-high 14 points ... Prosser (13) and Phil Bushre (12) also reached doubles ... Grove City's rebound margin of +9.6 rpg will likely place them in this week's NCAA rankings again.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg was a possession away from first place in the PAC ... The Jackets lost at home to Grove City, 79-77, in Wednesday's battle for the early lead in the conference, before Saturday's 84-68 rout of visiting Thiel ... Waynesburg now clinches its ninth-straight 10-win season and its 31st under 34th-year head coach Rudy Marisa ... Ray Robinson scored a season-high 34 points in Waynesburg's win over the Tomcats, after scoring 21 vs. Grove City ... Jake Marcoux had a breakthrough week ... Coming into the week, he averaged 10 minutes and 4.1 rebounds and 3.3 points per game ... In this week's two games, he averaged 28.5 minutes, 12.5 rebounds, and 13 points, including a team season-high 16 rebounds and 14 points against Thiel.

Thiel Tomcats

After evening out their PAC at 2-2 with an 82-63 win over Bethany on Wednesday, the Tomcats dropped to 2-3 in the conference as they fell at Waynesburg 84-68 on Saturday ... Senior G Shane Manley had 24 points and 13 rebounds against Bethany, both game and career highs ... Freshman F Matt Dracup hit for career highs in both points (19) and rebounds (six) in 21 minutes of action ... Junior F Dennis Bott added 11 markers and seven boards in the win ... Despite finishing with three double-digit scorers against Waynesburg, the Tomcats fell 84-68 ... Manley paced the Tomcats with 14 points and six caroms, while senior F's Eddie Mathews and A.H. Davis added 12 and 11 points.

Westminster Titans

Westminster won both of its PAC contests last week, toppling W&J at home 90-74 on Wednesday and winning at Bethany 84-82 on Saturday ... Against the Presidents, freshman G Brian Fadden had a perfect shooting night, going 3-for-3 from the field and 10-for-10 from the line for a team-high 16 points, while also dishing out three assists ... Sophomore G Chris Hatch hit a gamewinning three-pointer with 52 seconds left against Bethany, breaking an 81-81 tie ... Senior C Greg Foster posted teamhigh totals of 18 points and 10 rebounds to record his 12th "double-double" in 19 games this season ... Hatch finished with 16 points in the win ... Six Titans scored in double figures versus Bethany, with a seventh finishing with eight points.

Upcoming Game Notes: Frostburg State leads the series with Bethany 13-4... The Bobcats have taken the last three meetings, including a 99-83 victory in the ECAC Tournament in 2001 and an 89-80 triumph in Bethany last year... Grove City holds a 43-21 lead over the Green and White and snapped a five-game losing streak to Bethany with a 77-71 win Jan. 16... The Bison chopped a 17-point deficit to two with three minutes to play but could not complete the comeback... Guards **Josh Polantz** and **Jacob Dailer** hit for 20 and 19 points respectively.
