who posted PAC wins over Geneva (84-82) and Grove City (75-41). He posted the gamewinning points against Geneva with a pair of free throws with 5.2 seconds to play. With 20 points against GCC, he moved into seventh place on the all-time W&J scoring list with 1,295 career points. For the week, Lucic-Jozak shot 56 percent from the field (9-of-16) and a perfect 100 percent from the line (19of-19).

Also nominated was freshman G Lance Beckwith of Bethany, senior F Mark Tinklenberg of Thomas More, senior G Dan Happe of Waynesburg, and junior F Ryne Murray of Westminster.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2008-09 - Week 9 Conference Notes

SAINTS SOLIDIFY LEAD: Thomas More and Westminster met in Kentucky Saturday with sole possession of first place in the PAC on the line. After a second half comeback by the Titans sent the game to overtime, the Saints prevailed 83-78 to take control of the race for the top seed and home court advantage throughout the PAC Tournament. Westminster and Bethany are each 1 1/2 games behind TMC at 5-3 in league play, followed by Washington & Jefferson two games back at 4-3. WHO'S HOT: Saint Vincent senior PG Joey Butler set a new school record for assist with 16 while adding team-high totals in points (21), rebounds (nine) and steals (four) in a 106-73 win over Waynesburg ... Westminster junior F Ryan Murray grabbed 22 rebounds in a win over Grove City, the third-highest total in program history ... Freshman G Lance Beckwith averaged 21.5 points and 6.5 rebounds for 1-1 Bethany ... Geneva freshman Dave Phillips scored 27 points on eight treys in an 84-82 loss to W&J. AROUND THE LEAGUE: Mark Tinklenberg paced Thomas More with 16 points and 10 rebounds in the 83-78 OT win over Westminster which put the Saints alone in first place in the PAC ... Senior Bobby Glass scored a gamehigh 18 points for Westminster in a 78-57 win at Grove City ... Senior G Dan Happe scored 20 points for Waynesburg in a 77-67 loss to Bethany ... Brandon Mirizio scored 15 points for Thiel in an 88-64 road loss at Thomas More ... Andy O'Keefe averaged 12.0 ppg for 0-2 Grove City.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (11-9, 5-3 PAC)

Bethany started the week by claiming a 77-67 victory at Waynes-

burg, their 14th straight over the Yellow Jackets ... BC's 12-2 run over the final 2:12 broke a 65-65 tie and gave the Bison their first road win of the season ... The triumph was led by Petre Petkovski's 21 points and 13 rebounds, his fourth double-double of the year, and Lance Beckwith's 16 points, seven rebounds and four assists ... Against Geneva Saturday, Bethany cut a 15-point deficit to one on three occasions but couldn't quite complete the comeback in falling 78-74 ... Beckwith, who also had five steals, led the way with 27 points, including 14of-17 shooting from the foul line, the fifth-most free throws in a game in BC history ... Dakota Matz added 13 and Joe Testa chipped in with 10 in the defeat.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (16-3)



The Bearcats were victorious in their only contest of the

week, extending their home winning streak to 23 with a 106-73 win over Waynesburg on Saturday... Senior PG **Joey Butler** enjoyed a monster game, setting a new school record with 16 assists, while adding game-highs in points (21), rebounds (nine), and steals (four) ... Five other players joined Butler in doublefigures, including **Mike Medved** (20 points), **Billy Bains** (19), **Tre'sor Kalambay** (12), **Jordan Cleary** (11), and **BJ McGill** (10) ... Medved finished 8-of-10 from the floor, and added eight boards and four blocks ... SVC shot 55 percent from the floor, and connected on a total of 12 three-pointers, with Cleary finishing 3-of-4 from behind the arc.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (13-6, 4-3 PAC)



The Washington & Jefferson men's basketball program posted its fourth PAC victory

of the season on Saturday afternoon, defeating Grove City 75-41 ... With the victory, the Presidents now sit in sole possession of fourth place in the PAC men's standings and only trail league-leading Thomas More (7-2) by just one game in the loss column Saturday was a big day for senior C **Josip Lucic-Jozak** as he moved into seventh place on the all-time scoring list after scoring a game-high 20 points ...

Lucic-Jozak surpassed **Cy Godfrey** (1952-55) who scored 1,276 points in his four year career at W&J ... The Presidents remain at the top of two key categories in the PAC, shooting 74 percent (325-of-437) from the charity stripe and out-rebounding their opponents by an average margin of plus 6.8 per game. put together back-to-back victories away from Metheny Fieldhouse ... Saturday, Geneva put together an impressive 78-74 victory at Bethany ... In a place where the Bison had lost just one home game all season, the Golden Tornadoes pretty much led from the start to finish despite watching a 15-point second half lead dwindle to just one ... Brandon Harvey and Rich Colick each made a pair of free throws in the final ten seconds to ice the victory ... Wednesday, Geneva dropped an 84-82 decision to W&J ... Despite 27 points and an 8-11 effort from behind the three-point arc from Dave Phillips, Geneva was unable to hold off the Presidents who got two free throws from Josip Lucic-Jozak in the final seconds.
