# PAC Men's Basketball Player of the Week

# KEITH SCHUBERT

**Bethany College** 

6-4 Senior Forward Girard, Ohio/Girard H.S.

Schubert earned PAC Player of the Week honors for the third straight week and the fourth time this season after averaging 21.5 points and 8.5 rebounds per game for the 2-0 Bison. Bethany remained unbeaten (4-0) and in sole possession of first place in the PAC with a win at Grove City (58-50) while also posting a home win over Westminster (85-68). Schubert posted 31 points on 12-of-19 shooting (3-of-4 from behind the three-point arc) and grabbed 10 rebounds in the win over the Titans. With 1,863 career points, Schubert is just 28 points shy of surpassing **Rudy Yaksich** (1,891 points from 1954-58) as the all-time leading scorer at Bethany.

Also nominated was freshman forward **Ryan Eller** of Grove City, junior forward **A.H. Davis** of Thiel, junior guard **Nolan Larry** of Washington & Jefferson, and junior guard **Ray Robinson** of Waynesburg.

# PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

### **Bethany Bison**

The Bison moved its winning streak to seven games and moved two games ahead of the pack in the PAC this week ... Despite shooting 29 percent at Grove City, the Bison pulled out an eight-point win after forcing 28 Wolverine turnovers, including 19 in the second half ... Guard Mike Majzun led Bethany with a dozen points ... Against Westminster, the Bison held the Titans to 31 percent shooting in the second half as they broke a halftime tie to pull away for an 85-68 triumph ... Forward Keith Schubert scored 31 points and pulled down 10 rebounds in the victory ... Majzun tossed in 18 and point quard Scott Johnson had 12 points, eight assists and four steals.

### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J finished the week with a record of 1-2 after defeating LaRoche, 83-73, and falling to PAC opponents, Westminster (66-48) and Thiel (88-81) ... In the win over LaRoche, Scott Chodor netted a career-high 27 points, connecting on 12of-16 shots ... Nolan Larry and Tony Franz also each collected double-doubles with Larry scoring 17 points and dishing out a career-high 10 assists, while Franz added 18 points and 13 rebounds ... The Presidents were limited to just 34 percent shooting in the loss at Westminster ... In the loss at Thiel, W&J shot 59 percent but committed 16 turnovers ... Larry scored 21 points and added 10 assists for the second time in a week ... Graig Marx also added a season-high 18 points, going 8-of-10 from the field.

## **Grove City Wolverines**

The Wolverines split a pair of conference games last week, losing at home to firstplace Bethany, 58-50, and winning at Waynesburg's Rudy Marisa Field House, 75-64 ... The win over Waynesburg completed Grove City's second sweep over the Yellow Jackets in three years ... Sophomore Jim Fetzner led four Wolverines in double figures at Waynesburg with 20 points, while senior Pat Roberts had 10 rebounds and three blocked shots ... Freshman Ryan Eller came off the bench and scored a team-high 14 points on 6-for-8 shooting in the Bethany loss ... The Bison held the Wolverines to just 18 second-half points.

### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg went 1-1 last week, topping Thiel 68-56 before falling to Grove City 75-64 ... Ray Robinson posted 45 points, eight rebounds, three steals and two assists in the two games.

### Thiel Tomcats

Thiel improved to 3-2 against PAC opposition last week, going 1-1 with a loss at Waynesburg on Jan. 30 and a victory over visiting W&J on Feb. 2 ... Junior forward A.H. Davis led the Tomcats with 12 points and nine rebounds against the Yellow Jackets...Thiel shot just 33 percent from the field in the loss...Davis led the Tomcats with 23 points (16 in the second half) and six rebounds in the victory over W&J ... Senior guard Erik Hemsing and sophomore forward D.J. Gambridge each had 11 markers in the Tomcats win ... Junior forward Durrell Hackett tallied seven points and eight rebounds in 21 minutes of action for the Tomcats.

#### Westminster Titans

The Titans went 1-1 last week, topping W&J 66-48 for their first win against a PAC opponent before falling at league leader Bethany 85-68 ... Sophomore point guard Mike Hill led the Titans against W&J with 18 points, while junior shooting guard Jeff Simmons tallied a team-high 15 points in the loss at Bethany ... Junior center Greg Foster grabbed 32 rebounds in the two contests this week (16.0 rpg), including a careerbest 18 boards at Bethany ... Foster has posted double-figure rebound totals in each of the past four games, hauling in 60 boards total in that span (15.0 rpg).

Bethany will try to complete season sweeps of W&J and Waynesburg ... BC used a 22-0 second half run to blow open a close game and record a 90-66 victory against the Presidents Jan. 19 ... Schubert tallied 26 in the victory ... The Bison shot 50 percent from the field in the second half to pull away from the Yellow Jackets for an 82-71 win Jan. 19 ... Schubert had 17 and Nevada Smith tossed in 16.
